BETTER LATE THAN NEVER: Brooklyn scored four runs in the seventh inning last night and have now scored 30 of their 56 runs (54%) in the seventh inning or later.

A GRAND ENTRANCE: Last night C Brandon Brosher hit a grand slam in the top of the 7th inning...It was his second grand slam home run as a member of the Brooklyn Cyclones (July 5, 2015 vs. WPT)...Prior to his grand slam last season, the Cyclones had not hit one since 2012 when OF Brandon Nimmo hit two (June 20 vs. Aberdeen & August 17 vs. Tri-City)...Nimmo and OF Travis Taijeron, who hit two in 2011, are the only other players in franchise history with two grand slam home runs.

NO E IN BROOKLYN: The Cyclones rank fourth in the NYPL with a .974 fielding percentage...The team has just 15 errors in 587 total chances.

FRANKLY SPEAKING: On Sunday, July 3rd the Cyclones will change their name to the Coney Island Franks to celebrate the 100th Anniversary of Nathan's Famous...The team will wear special uniforms and caps during the game.

LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones rallied from a 7-2 defe-vs. STATE COLLEGE: The Cyclones lead the allcit to take an 8-7 lead in the 7th inning, but would time series against the Spikes 19-12...Brooklyn is 11-5 all-time at Medlar Field at Lubrano Park and has lost just one series played in State College (2014)... Brooklyn went 10-2 in Happy Valley from 2007-2012...The Spikes have gone 6-2 against Brooklyn over the last three years including last night's State College victory.

> **EXTRA EXTRA:** Through their first 13 contests of the season, Brooklyn has played a NYPL leading five extra inning games, going 1-4 in these contests...Brooklyn played a franchise record 13 extra inning games in 2002, going 7-6 in these contests.

> **BERRY GOOD:** After begining the season in a 0-for-20 slump, OF **Arnaldo Berrios** has hit safely in each of his last four games and is batting .375 (6-16) over the span...The switch hitter is still 0-for-10 against lefhanded pitching this season.

> **10 & 5:** The Cyclones are batting .292 (54-185) over their last five games after batting .220 (44-200) over their five games prior.

> **LEAGUE LEADERS:** SS Colby Woodmansee ranks second in the NYPL with a .394 (13-33) average... RHP Harol Gonzalez leads the league with 21 strikeouts

> MLB CYCLONES: RHP Seth Lugo, who was a member of the 2013 Brooklyn Cyclones, has been promoted to the New York Mets...Lugo will become the 58th former Cyclone to make it to the major leagues and the 39th to play for the Cyclones.


