LAST GAME: Brooklyn and Hudson Valley had their game suspended due to rain last night in the top of the sixth inning with the game tied at 1... When the game resumes, OF Quinn Brodey will be at third base with one out and 3B Carl Stajduhar is scheduled to bat... Just before the rain delay began at 8:47 p.m., Hudson Valley made a pitching change, replacing RHP Austin Franklin with RHP Garrett Fulenchek... The Cyclones scored in the second inning, when Brodey tripled to lead off the frame and then scored on a sacrifice fly by Stajduhar... The Renegades tied the game in the third frame after CF Carl Chester tripled and scored on a groundout by 1B Brendan McKay... The two teams are a combined 0-15 with RISP thus far.

SUSPENDED SUCCESS: This is the second time this season Brooklyn has had a game suspended... On July 1st at MCU Park, the Cyclones faced the Connecticut Tigers and the game was suspended in the second inning with Brooklyn trailing 5-2... The Cyclones went on to win 7-6.

THE DARK KNIGHT REHABS: New York Mets RHP Matt Harvey is scheduled to make a rehab start with Brooklyn tonight... Harvey will start the second game of today's action, which will begin no earlier than 7:05 p.m... The right-hander has been on the Disabled List since June 17th due to a stress injury to the scapula bone in his right shoulder... With the Mets this season, Harvey is 4-3 with a 5.25 ERA.

MLB REHAB: Harvey is the first Major-Leaguer to rehab with Brooklyn since INF Jose Reyes appeared in two games (8/11/16, 8/12/16) to rehab from an intercostal strain... Harvey is the first pitcher to rehab with Brooklyn since RHP Daisuke Matsuzaka, who made a rehab start for the Cyclones on August 21st, 2014.

ROAD, SWEET ROAD: OF Quinn Brodey is batting .307 (27-88) with two home runs in 21 road games... At home, Brodey is hitting just .171 (12-70) in 19 games.

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones are 92-70 all-time against the Renegades... Brooklyn is 52-33 at MCU Park against Hudson Valley, and 40-40 on the road... In 2017, the Cyclones are 0-3 against the Renegades, with all three games occurring at MCU Park June 24-June 26... Last season, Brooklyn faced Hudson Valley 12 times and split the season series 6-6, winning three games at home at MCU Park and three games on the road at Dutchess Stadium.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL STAR: Brooklyn is sending two players to the 2017 New York-Penn League All Star Game, OF Jose M. Medina and INF Walter Rasquin... Medina is batting .274 this season and is second in the league with 20 steals... He also has six outfield assists this year... Rasquin is batting .299 and is tied for second in the league with 12 doubles... He is also third in the league with 19 stolen bases... Earlier this season, Rasquin notched multiple 10+ game hitting streaks.

NEED FOR SPEED: The Cyclones have stolen 70 bases this season, most in the NYPL... OF Jose M. Medina (20) and INF Walter Rasquin (19) have combined for 56% (39/70) of the team's steals... Both Medina and Rasquin are on pace to break Angel Pagan's single-season record of 30 steals, which he set in 2001.

FEROCIOUS FRANKLIN: Cyclones INF Franklin Correa is hitting .344 (11-32) in his last 10 games, and three-straight multi-hit games... Correa is on a six-game hitting streak... During that span, Correa is hitting .450 (9-20)... This year, Correa is batting .387 (12-31) with RISP.

CATALYST CALL-UP: 1B Jeremy Vasquez has hit safely in all five of his games since getting called up from Kingsport... He is batting .438 (7-16) with four doubles since his promotion... With Kingsport, Vasquez hit .296 with seven home runs and 30 RBIs in 36 games.

LAST TIME OUT: Has not pitched since June 14 when he faced the Chicago Cubs at Citi Field... Harvey allowed four runs on four hits—including three home runs—in four innings of work, striking out five and walking one batter on 58 pitches.

CYCLONES DEBUT: Harvey began his professional career with the St. Lucie Mets (A+) in 2011, and has never pitched for the Cyclones prior to tonight.

WELCOME TO THE CLUB: Harvey is the 21st Major-Leaguer to make a rehab appearance with Brooklyn, and ninth pitcher... He is the first to do so since INF Jose Reyes played two games with the Cyclones (8/11/16, 8/12/16) to rehab from an intercostal strain... He is the first pitcher to rehab with Brooklyn since Daisuke Matsuzaka made a start against the Staten Island Yankees on August 21, 2014...

DOWN A RIB: Underwent season-ending surgery to correct Thoracic Outlet Syndrome on July 18, 2016...

MAKING A COMEBACK: Harvey was named the Sporting News NL Comeback Player of the Year and the Player's Choice NL Comeback Player of the Year in 2015 after missing the entire 2014 season following Tommy John surgery on October 22, 2013 to repair a partial tear of the ulnar collateral ligament (UCL) in his right elbow... Harvey went 13-8 with a 2.71 ERA in 29 regular-season starts for the Mets in 2015, and went 2-0 with a 3.04 ERA in four postseason starts, which includes two starts in the 2015 World Series.
