LAST GAME: The IronBirds defeated Brooklyn by the score of 5-0 on Thursday night...The Cyclones never got a runner past second base and collected just four hits in the game...RHP **Chris Viall** (0-1) was the hard luck loser, allowing just one run on two hits over 4.0 frames...OF **Jose Medina** went 2-for-2 with a walk to pace the Brooklyn offense.

SHUT IT DOWN: Last night marked the fourth time the Cyclones have been shutout this season, and the first time they have been shutout at home...Since 2015, Brooklyn has been shutout 19 times, with 14 coming at MCU Park...In 100 home games dating back to the start of 2015, Brooklyn is averaging 3.2 runs per game.

RECENT CYCLONES: Brooklyn is 4-19 dating to July 22nd and has been outscored 116-69.

DEUCES WILD: The Cyclones have scored two runs or less in 10 of their 14 games during the month of August and in 22 of their 54 games this season.

FIVE-L GOES WEST: Brooklyn is currently in the midst of their fourth losing streak of at least five games this season...From 2009 - 2016, the Cyclones had five losing streaks of five games or more including a stretch from 2009-2012 when the team never lost five consecutive games.

A CASE OF THE RUNS: The Cyclones have scored 182 runs this season, fewest in the New York-Penn League...Connecticut ranks 13th in the league with 204 runs scored and State College leads the league with 269 runs scored...The franchise record for fewest runs scored in a season is 251 set by the 2006 Cyclones.

HOME COOKIN': 2B **Walter Rasquin** is batting .333 (28-84) at MCU Park and .250 (22-88) on the road...Rasquin has at least one hit in 17 of 21 home games this season.

vs. ABERDEEN: The Cyclones are 2-9 against the IronBirds this season and have been outscored 65-31 in these games...All-time Brooklyn is 94-67 against Aberdeen including 45-35 record at MCU Park...Cyclones pitchers have a 5.53 ERA (59 ER / 96.0 IP) against the IronBirds this season...C Ben Breazeale is batting .447 (17-38) with 10 RBI in nine games against Brooklyn this season, and the team is 19-for-22 in stolen base attempts.

THE MIGHTY QUINN: OF **Quinn Brodey** ranks fourth in the NYPL with 26 RBI this season...18 of those 26 RBI have come on the road...Brodey is batting just .179 (14-78) at home with four extra base hits at home...The former Stanford Cardinal is hitting .296 (29-98) on the road with six extra base hits, including both of his home runs.

ROCK BOTTOM: The Cyclones are currently 24 games under .500, the lowest point in franchise history...Prior to this season, the team had never been worse than 10 games under .500 which came after the final game of the 2015 season...Brooklyn currently has 15 wins...Since 2001 only three teams have finished with less than 24 wins: Vermont (19-56, 2003), State College (18-56, 2008) and Batavia (22-53, 2016).

STOP & START: Cyclones starting pitchers are 4-26 this season...The players currently on the Cyclones roster are 1-14 in 25 starts with their lone win coming from RHP **Trent Johnson** on June 22nd at Vermont...Brooklyn's first two wins of the season were credited to starting pitchers, (6/21 - McIlraith @ Vermont & 6/22 - Johnson @ Vermont) so since June 23rd, Brooklyn starting pitchers have gone 2-26.

CARL WITH A K: 3B **Carl Stajduhar** is batting .089 (4-45) with 27 strikeouts in 14 games during August...Since August 3rd he is 2-for-38 (.053).

LAST TIME OUT: Tossed 2.0 shutout frames on August 11th at Hudson Valley before the game was suspended due to rain...Allowed three hits and did not factor in the decision.

RECENT TRENT: Has allowed just one run, earned, over his last 11.2 innings, spanning three appearances, dating to July 31st...Has a 1.29 ERA (1 ER / 7.0 IP) during August.

START ME UP: Is 1-3 with a 5.04 ERA in five starts this season (10 ER / 20.2 IP) and is 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA in two relief outings...Johnson allowed eight runs, six earned, in 1.2 frames on September 15th, but allowed just one run over his next 11.2 frames in relief.

ALL THAT'S LEFT: Lefthanded batters are hitting .348 (32-92) against Johnson with 11 of his 12 extra base hits surrendered coming by way of a lefthander...Righties are hitting .238 (20-84).

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Collected his first professional win on June 22 at Vermont...Tossed 5.0 innings, allowing one run on four hits with one walk and four strikeouts.

THE OLD COLLEGE TRY: Went 8-2 with a 2.20 ERA in 98.1 innings during his sophomore season at Santa Fe...Struck out 89 batters and walked 21.
