LAST GAME: The Tri-City ValleyCats hit four home runs, including a walk-off grand slam from Colton Shaver, as Brooklyn fell 10-6 on Monday night... RHP **Joe Napolitano** (0-2) allowed five runs on two hits with a pair of walks in the ninth...2B **Walter Rasquin** had a pair of RBI and OF **Guillermo Granadillo** had his third straight two-hit effort.

LEAGUE LEADERS: 2B **Walter Rasquin** currently leads the New York-Penn League with 18 doubles...That is the highest total by a Cyclones since 2014 when 3B **Jhoan Ureña** had 20 doubles...The franchise record is 23 doubles set by INF **Danny Muno** and OF **Caleb Stewart**...OF **Quinn Brodey** is tied for the NYPL lead with 30 RBI, which is also the highest output for a Cyclone since 3B **Jhoan Ureña** had 47 RBI in 2014.

RECENT CYCLONES: Brooklyn is 4-23 dating to July 22nd and has been outscored 153-90.

SKID MARKS: Brooklyn has lost a franchise record 10 straight games coming into tonight...The Cyclones previous mark was a nine game losing streak to end the 2002 season...The last losing streak in the New York-Penn League to last longer than 10 games came in 2008 when the State College Spikes lost 11 straight from August 9 - 22.

RISP-ECT: The Cyclones are batting .213 (119-560) with runners in scoring position...During the current 10-game losing streak, Brooklyn is batting .178 (21-118).

HOMER HAPPY: Cyclones pitchers surrendered four home runs last night, matching the franchise record for home runs allowed, set in 2006 (June 20, 2016 @ Staten Island), matched in 2015 (August 30, 2015 @ Tri-City, L 13-4) and earlier this season (June 24 vs. Hudson Valley, 10-4).

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones are 0-6 against the Hudson Valley Renegades this season and 92-76 all-time against the 'Gades...Brooklyn has been outscored 35-14 in the six games against Hudson Valley this season...As a team, the Cyclones are batting .186 (33-177) against the Renegades...Brooklyn is 52-32 all-time at MCU Park, but 0-3 this season.

POWER SURGE: Brooklyn has allowed 29 home runs in 32 road games this season...The 29 road home runs allowed one the road is more than nine NYPL teams have allowed combined home and road...Brooklyn has allowed less than 29 home runs total in each of the last four seasons...The franchise record for home runs allowed is 41, set in 2004...This season Brooklyn has allowed 37 home runs overall.

15 WINS: Brooklyn currently has 15 wins...Since 2001 only three teams have finished with less than 24 wins: Vermont (19-56, 2003), State College (18-56, 2008) and Batavia (22-53, 2016)...The GCL Tigers East (11-36), AZL Indians (11-35), and Bristol Pirates (12-44) are the only affiliated team in the country with less than 15 wins.

AT A LOSS: With 18 games remaining, the Cyclones are currently tied for the franchise record with 43 losses - originally set in 2015... Brooklyn finished .500 or better from 2001-1014.

STOP & START: Cyclones starting pitchers are 4-28 this season...The players currently on the Cyclones roster are 1-16 in 28 starts with their lone win coming from RHP **Trent Johnson** on June 22nd at Vermont...Brooklyn's first two wins of the season were credited to starting pitchers, (6/21 - McIlraith @ Vermont & 6/22 - Johnson @ Vermont) so since June 23rd, Brooklyn starting pitchers have gone 2-28.

START ME UP: Is 0-3 with a 9.15 ERA in six starts with Brooklyn this season...His last start came on July 17th...Opponents are batting .333 (28-84) against him as a starting pitcher...Is 1-0 with a 5.91 ERA in five relief appearances.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Made the Opening Day start for the Cyclones but did not factor in the decision...Struggled with his control early, issuing four walks, but limited the damage to just three runs on two hits.

SCORING CHANCE: Opponents are batting .364 (16-44) against the southpaw with runners in scoring position with the Cyclones.

FIREFLIES: Made two starts for Columbia of the South Atlantic League prior to joining the Cyclones...He went 1-1 with a 7.71 ERA, nine strikeouts, and six walks.

IN 2016: Made 12 starts last season with Kingsport (Rookie). Finished the season 2-5 with a 4.83 ERA. In 63.1 IP, he struck out 66 and walked 31.

SIGNED: Prior to signing with the Mets after being selected in the 11th round of the 2015 MLB Draft, Simon had committed to Rice University.
