LAST GAME: Brooklyn took the series opener from the Vermont Lake Monsters by the score of 2-1...RHP **Trent Johnson** sparkled on the mound, tossing 6.1 shutout frames but did not factor in the decision...2B **Walter Rasquin** scored a run, thanks to three wild pitches and a stolen base, and drove in the other to pace the Brooklyn bats.

THE GOOD: INF **Walter Rasquin** is tied for sixth in the NYPL with a .302 (64-212) batting average and leads the league with 20 doubles...The franchise record for doubles in a season is 23 set by INF **Danny Muno** in 2011...Rasquin also ranks second in the league in stolen bases with 27, the highest total by a Cyclone since OF **Ambiorix Concepcion** stole 28 in 2004...The franchise record for steals in a season is 30, set by OF **Angel Pagan** in 2001.

THE BAD: Brooklyn is 7-27 dating to July 22nd and has been outscored 175-105.

THE UGLY: Brooklyn currently has 18 wins...Since 1967 when the New York-Penn League became a short-season league only five teams have won less than 20 games in a season:

- 1973 - Newark Co-Pilots: 15-55
- 1977 - Auburn Phillies: 17-53
- 1981 - Batavia Trojans: 16-59
- 2003 - Vermont Expos: 19-56
- 2008 - State College Spikes: 18-56

RISP-ECT: The Cyclones are batting .207 (127-615) with runners in scoring position for the season... Brooklyn is batting .158 (29-183) with RISP over their last 17 games.

NOT SO GREAT IN MONTH #8: Brooklyn is currently 5-20 during the month of August..During any calendar month in which the team has played at least 11 games, the team has never won less than five contests.

vs. VERMONT: The Cyclones are 2-1 against Vermont this season, taking a three-game series in Burlington from June 21-23...Brooklyn is 60-28 all-time against the Lake Monsters / Expos including 29-14 at MCU Park...Brooklyn is 11-4 at home against the Lake Monsters since 2012 and has not lost a home series to Vermont since 2012 when they went 0-2 at MCU Park.

PITCHING IN: Brooklyn pitchers have allowed just two earned runs over their last 35.0 innings on the mound...Cyclones starters have not allowed a run over their last 15.1 innings on the mound.

WINNING STREAK: Brooklyn won has won three straight games for the first time since July 18-21 when they won four consecutive games.

NEW KID IN TOWN: OF **Wagner Lagrange** made his Cyclones debut yesterday with a 2-for-4 effort with a run scored and RBI...Lagrange hit .335 (62-185) with 10 doubles, four home runs, and 40 RBI in 45 games with the K-Mets.

THE STRUGGLE IS REAL: INF **Franklin Correa** is 2-30 over his last nine games...3B **Carl Stajduhar** is batting .093 (7-75) during the month of August with 42 strikeouts.

POWER SURGE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have given up 30 home runs in 33 road games this season and 38 home runs overall...The 38 home runs allowed is the second most in franchise history behind 2004 when they gave up 41 homers.

STOP & START: Cyclones starting pitchers are 4-31 this season...The players currently on the Cyclones roster are 1-18 in 40 starts with their lone win coming from RHP **Trent Johnson** on June 22nd at Vermont...Brooklyn's first two wins of the season were credited to starting pitchers, (6/21 - McIlraith @ Vermont & 6/22 - Johnson @ Vermont)

START ME UP: Is 0-2 with a 1.64 ERA in three starts this season...Has struck out 13 in 11.0 innings on the mound as a starter.

SEARCHING FOR A WIN: Viall has not collected a win during his professional career... However, he has never pitched enough innings in start to qualify... His career-high in innings-pitched is 4.1 (7/20/16 @ ELZ), when he struck out a career-high eight batters.

WALK ON THE WILD SIDE: Opponents are hitting .186 (11-59) against the righthander, but has issued 11 walks over 17.1 innings.

THE CARDINAL WAY: Viall is one of four former Stanford Cardinal with the Brooklyn Cyclones this season, including OF Quinn Brodey, 1B Matt Winaker, and hitting coach Sean Ratliff.

RIGHT BACK TO THE DUGOUT: Right-handed hitters are just 6-37 (.162) against Viall this season with 13 strikeouts and six walks.
