LAST GAME: Brooklyn scored four runs early and never looked back as they defeated the Tri-City ValleyCats 6-3 on Wednesday night...Brooklyn stole eight bases in the first three innings left by INF **Walter Masquin** and OF **Jose M. Medina** who each stole three bags...Medina and OF **Quinn Brodey** each had a pair of hits to lead the offense... RHP **Darwin Ramons** (2-3) tossed 6.0 shutout frames.

GRAND THEFT: The Cyclones stole a franchise record eight bases last night, surpassing the previous mark of seven set on August 13, 2002 at Aberdeen and tied on July 20, 2010 vs. Lowell... INF **Walter Rasquin** and OF **Jose M. Medina** each stole three bases, one shy of the franchise mark set by SS **Corey Ragsdale** on July 26, 2002 vs. SI.

PACE YOURSELF: OF **Jose M. Medina** is currently tied for the league lead with 20 stolen bases... He is also on pace to break the franchise record for steals in a season (30), set by OF **Angel Pagan** in 2001...The 20 stolen bases to this point are tied with OF **Jacob Zanon**, who swiped 20 bags in 2016, for the most by a Cyclones since OF **Joe Holden** stole 22 bases in 2005.

RECENT CYCLONES: Brooklyn is 3-8 over their last 11 games and has been outscored 60-31 over the span.

CAN'T STOP, WON'T STOP: Brooklyn ranks 11th in the NYPL with a .273 (18-66) caught stealing percentage.

HOME COOKIN': Brooklyn is batting .246 (149-606) at home and .225 (177-787) on the road...INF **Reed Gamache** is hitting .298 (17-57) at home and .229 (19-83) on the road...INF **Walter Rasquin** is batting .356 (21-59) at MCU Park and .277 (18-65) on the road.

vs. TRI-CITY: The Cyclones are 46-36 all-time against the ValleyCats including a 24-16 mark at MCU Park...Since 2011 the ValleyCats lead the series 20-17, but are 8-11 in Brooklyn...The Cyclones have won the series in Coney Island in each of the last four seasons and are 8-4 over that span here at MCU Park.

THE MIGHTY QUINN: OF **Quinn Brodey** has hit safely in six straight games and is batting .364 (8-22) over this span...The 3rd round pick from Stanford is batting .313 (15-48) dating to July 21st.

EASY THERE SLUGGER: Brooklyn's .299 slugging percentage is the lowest in the NYPL and the lowest in all of Minor League Baseball.

POWER OUTAGE: Brooklyn has three home runs in their last two home games...The team currently ranks last in the NYPL with eight home runs this season...The franchise record for fewest home runs in a season is 22 set during the 2014 season.

READY FOR LIFTOFF: The Cyclones have allowed 25 home runs, second most in the NYPL behind Vermont's 26 homers allowed...The 25 home runs allowed are more than Brooklyn allowed in the entire 2001, 2003, 2013, 2014 and 2015 seasons...The franchise record for home runs allowed is 41 during the 2004 season.

RISP-ECT: The Cyclones are batting .218 (87-399) with runners in scoring position this season and .165 (28-170) with RISP and two-outs.

YOU, IN THE BACK: Last night marked the 11th time in 14 wins that Brooklyn has played from in front...For the season, Brooklyn has been outscored 38-17 in the first inning.

GET THE LEAD OUT: Leadoff batters are batting .500 (9-18) against him with three walks...First batters of an inning have a .571 on-base percentage.
