LAST GAME: The Cyclones split a pair with the Vermont Lake Monsters on Wednesday, falling in Game One 3-1 and then taking the night cap 3-0...C **Jose Maria** hit his fifth home run of the season, a two-run shot, to give Brooklyn all the offense it would need to win Game Two.

THE GOOD: INF **Walter Rasquin** is tied for seventh in the NYPL with a .296 (64-216) batting average and leads the league with 20 doubles... The franchise record for doubles in a season is 23 set by INF **Danny Muno** in 2011...Rasquin is also tied for the league lead in stolen bases with 28, the highest total by a Cyclone since OF **Ambiorix Concepcion** stole 28 in 2004...The franchise record for steals in a season is 30, set by OF **Angel Pagan** in 2001.

THE BAD: Brooklyn is 8-28 dating to July 22nd and has been outscored 178-109.

THE UGLY: Brooklyn currently has 19 wins...Since 1967 when the New York-Penn League became a short-season league only five teams have won less than 20 games in a season:

- 1973 - Newark Co-Pilots: 15-55
- 1977 - Auburn Phillies: 17-53
- 1981 - Batavia Trojans: 16-59
- 2003 - Vermont Expos: 19-56
- 2008 - State College Spikes: 18-56

DOUBLE HEADERS: Tonight will be Brooklyn's third double header of the season with the Cyclones going 2-2 in twin bills so far this year... Brooklyn is 44-38 all-time in double headers.

POWER SURGE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have given up 30 home runs in 33 road games this season and 30 home runs overall...The 40 home runs allowed is the second most in franchise history behind 2004 when they gave up 41 homers.

vs. LOWELL The Cyclones are 47-41 all-time against the Lowell Spinners including 24-19 here at MCU Park...The Spinners have won 11 straight games against Brooklyn dating back to the start of the 2016 season...Brooklyn has not defeated Lowell since August 20, 2015 when they won 4-3 in 11 innings.

JOSE! JOSE! JOSE! C **Jose Maria** is batting .278 (15-54) with three home runs and seven RBI in 15 games during August...Has hit safely 10 of his last 12 games and is batting .400 (10-25) over the span.

PITCHING IN: Brooklyn pitchers have allowed just five earned runs over their last 49.0 innings on the mound.

GETTING HOT: Brooklyn has won back-to-back series and four of their last five games...It marks just the second time the Cyclones have won consecutive series.

NEW KID IN TOWN: RHP **Briam Campusano** will join the Cyclones today and make his debut tonight in Game Two...The 21-year-old was 0-2 with a 3.65 ERA in two starts for the K-Mets...Began the year with GCL Mets and went 2-3 with a 3.27 ERA in seven games.

THE STRUGGLE IS REAL: INF **Franklin Correa** is 2-32 over his last nine games...3B **Carl Stajduhar** is batting .111 (9-81) during the month of August with 44 strikeouts.

STOP & START: Last night, RHP **Jose Geraldo** became the first starting pitcher to win a game for the Cyclones since August 2nd (Darwin Ramos)...Cyclones starting pitchers are 5-32 this season...Players currently on the Cyclones roster are 2-19 in 41 starts...Both of Brooklyn's first two wins of the year were credited to starting pitchers, so since June 23rd, starters are 3-32.

LEFT OUT: With Brooklyn, lefties are batting .314 (27-86) against him with seven extra-base hits...Righties are hitting .237 (23-97).

TURN THE PAGE: The righthander went 0-3 with a 3.24 ERA (6 ER / 16.2 IP) during the month of July...Opponents hit .342 (25-73) against him while he struck out 20 batters in the 16.2 innings.
