LAST GAME: The Cyclones earned a series split with the Staten Island Yankees Sunday afternoon, winning 6-4...Brooklyn scored four runs in the third to take a 4-0 lead before the Yankees scored twice in the fourth and fifth to tie the game... In the sixth, OF **Quinn Brodey** plated two with a double to left-center... The Cyclones' bullpen allowed just two unearned runs, and RHP **Keaton Aldrige** earned his second save of the season with a clean ninth inning.

START YOUR ENGINES: Brooklyn ranks second in the league with 27 stolen bases, trailing only Tri-City (30). Cyclones OF **Jose Medina** leads the team and the league with 12 steals, four more than anyone other player in the NYPL.

UNFRIENDLY CONFINES: Dating to August 23rd of last year, the Cyclones are 4-12 at MCU Park and have been out scored 85-60 over the span...This year, Brooklyn is 2-7 at home and is batting .215 (59-274) while being outscored 57-35.

POWER SURGE: Cyclones pitchers have allowed 19 home runs this season, tops in the New York-Penn League.

RISP NO REWARD: The Cyclones are hitting only .214 (43-201) for the season with runners in scoring position...With RISP and two-outs the team is batting just .117 (9-77)

GETS LATE EARLY: The Cyclones have been outscored 70-36 from the fifth inning on.

END OF AN E.R.A: The Cyclones currently have a 5.44 team ERA, last in the NYPL...Coming into this season, the highest team ERA in franchise history was a 3.41 team ERA in 2005.

vs. MAHONING VALLEY: The Cyclones lead the all-time series against Mahoning Valley 28-22... Brooklyn is 15-11 at Eastwood Field and 13-11 at MCU Park...The Cyclones are 11-5 in Ohio dating back to 2007...Brooklyn has not visited Eastwood Field since 2015 when they went 1-2 against the Scrappers...The Cyclones and Scrappers in the first game in MCU Park history back in 2001.

THE E IN CYCLONES: The Cyclones rank 13th in the NYPL with a .951 fielding percentage...The team has been charged with 36 errors in 729 total chances...The Cyclones have at least one error in 15 of their 20 games this season...Cyclones third baseman have combined for eight errors and have a .849 (8/53) fielding percentage...3B **Carl Stajduhar** has five errors in 29 total chances.

GLIMMER OF HOPE: The 6-14 start to the season is the worst start in franchise history...Brooklyn went 7-13 to start the season in 2006 but would go on to finish the year 41-33 and win the Wild Card.

NOT SO BULLISH IN THE PEN: The Cyclones bullpen has a 5.31 ERA (46 ER / 78 IP) so far this season.

RASQUIN RAKING: INF **Walter Rasquin** currently has a 10-game hitting streak and is batting .310 (13-42) over the span...The 10-game hitting streak is tied with Jack Meggs of Vermont for the longest in the NYPL this season...It is the 35th hitting streak to reach double digits in franchise history and the first since Jeff Diehl hit in 11 straight games ending on July 3, 2015.

HANG TEN: INF **Reed Gamache** is batting .333 (11-33) over the last 10 games and OF **Quinn Brodey** is hitting .313 (10-32) over the span.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his first start as a member of the Brooklyn Cyclones... Tossed 3.2 innings of shutout baseball, striking out six and walking three. The Cyclones offense provided run support as Brooklyn won 10-1 behind seven runs in the first two frames.

ROAD WARRIOR: Debora is making his fourth appearance of the season on the road. He has not pitched at MCU Park this season.

RIGHT VS RIGHT: The right-hander has been much better against right-handed batters this season. Righties are just 4-24 against Debora with nine strikeouts and zero extra-base hits.

ELDER STATESMAN: Of the current members of the Cyclones' roster, Debora has been in the Mets' organization the longest, now in his sixth season. Only Jose Maria has been in the system as long.

STERLING IN 2015: The right-hander's best professional season came in 2015, when he was the DSL 2 Mets Sterling Award winner. Debora went 3-2 with a 1.65 ERA—a mark that ranked fifth in the DSL.
