LAST GAME: The Scrappers completed a three-game sweep of the Cyclones on Thursday night with a 4-2 win at Eastwood Field...RHP **Marcel Renteria** (0-1) was tagged with the loss in his professional debut after allowing two runs on three hits in lone inning of relief...Offensively, OF **Quinn Brodey** and OF **Jose Medina** each had two hits to lead the way.

START YOUR ENGINES: Brooklyn ranks second in the league with 30 stolen bases, trailing only Tri-City (33)...Cyclones OF **Jose Medina** leads the team and the league with 14 steals, three more than anyone other player in the NYPL...The franchise record for steals in a season is 30, set by OF **Angel Pagan** in 2001.

POWER SURGE: Cyclones pitchers have allowed 22 home runs this season, tops in the NYPL...No other team has allowed more than 14 HR (Batavia)...The 22 home runs match the season total from 2014, 2015 and 2016, and are more than the team allowed during the 2001 season...RHP **Tony Dibrell** leads the NYPL allowing four home runs over his 4.0 innings on the mound.

RISP NO REWARD: The Cyclones are hitting only .214 (48-224) for the season with runners in scoring position...With RISP and two-outs the team is batting just .132 (12-91)

GETS LATE EARLY: The Cyclones have been outscored outscored 77-37 from the fifth inning on.

NYPD NIGHT: Monday will be NYPD Night at MCU Park...The Cyclones will wear NYPD Caps on field that will be raffled off with proceeds to benefit the family of Officer Miosotis Familia, who was recently killed in the line of duty...The team is currently offering tickets for \$15 for the game with all proceeds going to the Familia Family.

vs. STATE COLLEGE: The Cyclones lead the all-time series against the State College Spikes 20-13...Brooklyn is 8-7 at MCU Park and 12-6 at Medlar Field at Lubrano Park...Brooklyn has not won a home game against the Spikes since 2013 thanks to a three-game sweep by the Spikes in 2015...The Cyclones are just 2-8 against the Spikes since 2014 after going 18-5 from 2006 - 2013.

RASQUIN RAKING: INF **Walter Rasquin** currently has a 13-game hitting streak and is batting .306 (15-49) over the span...The 13-game hitting streak is the longest in the NYPL this season...It is the 35th hitting streak to reach double digits in franchise history and the longest since 3B **Jhoan Ureña** had a pair of 13-game hitting streaks during the 2014 season...1B **Lucas Duda** has the franchise record with a 17-game streak in 2007.

HOME COOKIN': The Cyclones are 4-12 at MCU Park dating to the All-Star Break of the 2016 season.

THE STRUGGLE IS REAL: OF **Ricardo Cespedes** is 1-for-22 dating to his final at-bat on July 7th...He has struck out nine times in these 22 at-bats...SS **Franklin Correa** has at least one strike out in 17 consecutive games and currently leads the NYPL with 31 strikeouts on the year...INF **Reed Gamache** is 2-for-20 over his last six games with an at-bat.

THE E IN CYCLONES: The Cyclones rank 13th in the NYPL with a .950 fielding percentage...The team has been charged with 40 errors in 804 total chances...The Cyclones have at least one error in 17 of their 22 games this season...Lowell has 47 errors on the year, most in the league, with no other team having more than 31 E's.

BOTTOMING OUT: The Cyclones are currently 6-17, the worst start in franchise history, and the first time in franchise history the team has been 11 games under .500.
