LAST GAME: The Scrappers completed a three-game sweep of the Cyclones on Thursday night with a 4-2 win at Eastwood Field...RHP **Marcel Renteria** (0-1) was tagged with the loss in his professional debut after allowing two runs on three hits in lone inning of relief...Offensively, OF **Quinn Brodey** and OF **Jose Medina** each had two hits to lead the way.

NEED FOR SPEED: Cyclones OF **Jose Medina** leads the team and the league with 14 steals, two more than anyone other player in the NYPL...The franchise record for steals in a season is 30, set by OF **Angel Pagan** in 2001.

POWER SURGE: Cyclones pitchers have allowed 22 home runs this season, tops in the NYPL...No other team has allowed more than 14 HR (Batavia)...The 22 home runs match the season total from 2014, 2015 and 2016, and are more than the team allowed during the 2001 season...RHP **Tony Dibrell** is tied for the NYPL having allowed four home runs in 4.0 IP.

RISP NO REWARD: The Cyclones are hitting only .211 (49-232) for the season with runners in scoring position...With RISP and two-outs the team is batting just .128 (12-94)

GETS LATE EARLY: The Cyclones have been outscored 79-40 from the fifth inning on.

YOU SHALL NOT PASS: Cyclones catcher **Carlos Sanchez** is tied for the NYPL lead with eight caught stealings this season...Lowell's Samuel Miranda (8-26) and Auburn's Jeyner Baez (8-12) are tied with Sanchez (8-22).

EXTRA EXTRA: The Cyclones currently have 40 extra base hits, 13th in the NYPL ahead of only Connecticut with 35...Auburn leads the league with 71.

vs. STATE COLLEGE: The Cyclones lead the all-time series against the State College Spikes 20-14...Brooklyn is 8-8 at MCU Park and 12-6 at Medlar Field at Lubrano Park...Brooklyn has not won a home game against the Spikes since 2013 thanks to a three-game sweep by the Spikes in 2015...The Cyclones are just 2-9 against the Spikes since 2014 after going 18-5 from 2006 - 2013.

RASQUIN RAKING: INF **Walter Rasquin** currently has a 14-game hitting streak and is batting .305 (18-59) over the span...The 14-game hitting streak is the longest in the NYPL this season...It is the 35th hitting streak to reach double digits in franchise history and the longest since SS **Gavin Cecchini** hit in 16-straight games in 2013...1B **Lucas Duda** has the franchise record with a 17-game streak in 2007.

ROAD SWEET ROAD: The Cyclones are 4-13 at MCU Park dating to the All-Star Break in 2016.

THE STRUGGLE IS REAL: OF **Ricardo Cespedes** is 1-for-22 dating to his final at-bat on July 7th...He has struck out nine times in these 22 at-bats...SS **Franklin Correa** has at least one strike out in 18 consecutive games and currently leads the NYPL with 32 strikeouts on the year...INF **Reed Gamache** is 2-for-24 over his last seven games with an at-bat.

THE E IN CYCLONES: The Cyclones rank 13th in the NYPL with a .952 fielding percentage...The team has been charged with 42 errors in 880 total chances...The Cyclones have at least one error in 19 of their 24 games this season...Lowell has 47 errors on the year, most in the league, with no other team having more than 36 E's.

BOTTOMING OUT: The Cyclones are currently 6-18, the worst start in franchise history, and the first time in franchise history the team has ever been more than 10 games under .500.
