## BROOKLYN CYCLONES (6-19) vs. STATE COLLEGE SPIKES (15-10)

**LAST GAME:** The Cyclones lost their fifth straight on Saturday night, falling the Spikes 12-1...A 2-0 deficit ballooned to 12-1 in the sixth inning when RHP **Trent Johnson** allowed the first eight batters to reach safely and eventually was tagged for seven runs in the frame...SS **Edgardo Fermin** went 2-for-4 in his Cyclones debut and 3B **Reed Gamache** added a 2-for-4 effort as well.

**NEED FOR SPEED:** Cyclones OF **Jose Medina** leads the team and the league with 14 steals, two more than anyone other player in the NYPL...The franchise record for steals in a season is 30, set by OF **Angel Pagan** in 2001.

**CLEAN UP:** Brooklyn has been swept in three different three-game series so far this season...The Cyclones were swept in a three-game series on four occasions in 2015, a franchise record.

**RISP NO REWARD:** The Cyclones are hitting only .207 (50-241) for the season with runners in scoring position...With RISP and two-outs the team is batting just .122 (12-98)

**GETS LATE EARLY:** The Cyclones have been outscored 89-41 from the fifth inning on.

**YOU SHALL NOT PASS:** Cyclones catcher **Carlos Sanchez** is tied for the NYPL lead with eight caught stealings this season...Lowell's Samuel Miranda (8-26) and Auburn's Jeyner Baez (8-12) are tied with Sanchez (8-22).

**EXTRA EXTRA:** The Cyclones currently have 40 extra base hits, 13th in the NYPL ahead of only Connecticut with 38...Auburn leads the league with 73.

**THE MAGIC NUMBER:** The Cyclones are 0-14 when they scores three runs or less this season... They are 6-5 when they score four runs or more.

**vs. STATE COLLEGE:** The Cyclones lead the all-time series against the State College Spikes 20-15...Brooklyn is 8-9 at MCU Park and 12-6 at Medlar Field at Lubrano Park...Brooklyn has not won a home game against the Spikes since 2013 thanks to a three-game sweep by the Spikes in 2015...The Cyclones are just 2-10 against the Spikes since 2014 after going 18-5 from 2006 - 2013.

**POWER OUTAGE:** The Cyclones are last in the NYPL with four home runs this season...The team has not hit a home run since July 8th when **Carl Stajduar** hit a solo shot in the fourth inning at Staten Island...As a team, Brooklyn has gone 246 at-bats without a homer coming into Sunday's game.

**RASQUIN RAKING:** INF **Walter Rasquin** had his 14-game hitting streak snapped on Saturday night with an 0-for-5 effort...The 14-game streak is tied with **Jacob Eigsti's** 2007 mark for the fifth longest in franchise history.

**NO PLACE LIKE HOME?:** The Cyclones are 2-9 at MCU Park in 2017 and have been outscored 73-39.

**THE STRUGGLE IS REAL:** SS **Franklin Correa** has at least one strike out in his last 18 games with an at-bat and is currently tied for the NYPL lead with 33 strikeouts on the year.

**THE E IN CYCLONES:** The Cyclones rank 13th in the NYPL with a .953 fielding percentage...The team has been charged with 43 errors in 920 total chances...The Cyclones have at least one error in 20 of their 25 games this season...Lowell has 49 errors on the year.

**BOTTOMING OUT:** The Cyclones are currently 6-18, the worst start in franchise history, and the first time in franchise history the team has ever been more than 10 games under .500.

**LAST OUTING:** Struck out an affiliated baseball career-high six batters on July 11th at Mahoning Valley...Tossed 4.0 near perfect inning of relief, allowing just a walk and a single in a game the Cyclones lost 4-1.

**LAST START:** Made the start on June 30th at Aberdeen... Allowed two runs, earned, on five hits with one walk and three strikeouts over 5.0 IP as Brooklyn lost 3-0.

**WELCOME TO BROOKLYN:** Signed by the Mets as a Minor League Free Agent on Tuesday, June 20th.

**MR. INDEPENDENT:** Began the season with the Schaumburg Boomers of the Independent Frontier League... Was 5-1 with a 1.30 ERA in seven starts...Allowed just six runs, earned, in 41.1 IP while scattering 30 hits and 13 walks while striking out 53...Led the Frontier League in wins and ERA and ranked second in strikeouts at the time he signed.

**BOOMER NOTES:** With Schaumburg this season, tossed 5.0 IP or more in six of his seven starts...Struck out 10 batters in two starts, May 31st at Traverese City and May 18th at Windy City...Opponents hit .203 against him this season.

**SECOND CHANCE:** Originally selected in the 25th round of the 2015 MLB Draft by the Miami Marlins, the lefthander went 3-3 with a 1.77 ERA in 16 games, two starts with the GCL Marlins and Greensboro Grasshoppers (A-) of the SAL.
