LAST GAME: Staten Island jumped out to an early 5-0 lead and never looked back as they defeated Brooklyn 5-3 on Monday night...LHP **Jake Simon** (0-3) was tagged with the loss after allowing five runs, earned, on four hits with four walks in 1.1 IP... OF **Ricardo Cespedes** and OF **Quinn Brodey** each had a pair of hits to pace the Brooklyn offense.

NEED FOR SPEED: Cyclones OF **Jose M. Medina** leads the team and the league with 16 steals and has been caught just once this season...The franchise record for steals in a season is 30, set by OF **Angel Pagan** in 2001.

RISP NO REWARD: The Cyclones are hitting .213 (54-254) for the season with runners in scoring position...With RISP and two-outs the team is batting just .136 (14-103)...They are batting .129 (4-31) with the bases loaded.

GETS LATE EARLY: The Cyclones have been outscored 90-43 from the fifth inning on.

THE MAGIC NUMBER: The Cyclones are 1-15 when they score three runs or less this season... They are 6-5 when they score four runs or more.

POWER OUTAGE: The Cyclones are last in the NYPL with four home runs this season...The team has not hit a home run since July 8th when **Carl Stajduar** hit a solo shot in the fourth inning at Staten Island...As a team, Brooklyn has gone 310 at-bats without a homer coming into Tuesday's game.

THE HOUSE THAT DOM BUILT: Staten Island OF **Dom Thompson-Williams** is batting .455 (10-22) in six games against the Cyclones this season with four RBI and a .520 on-base percentage...The Baby Bomber is batting .238 (15-63) against the rest of the New York-Penn League

vs. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones lead the all-time series 106-104...Brooklyn is 56-50 all-time at MCU Park and 50-54 at Staten Island...Brooklyn has more wins against Staten Island than any other team...The Yankees lead the 2017 series 4-2 with Brooklyn going 1-3 at home and 1-1 at Richmond County Bank Ballpark.

GETTING 'MIGGY WITH IT: OF **Jose Miguel Medina** has hit safely in seven straight games and is batting .393 (11-28) over the stretch with three doubles, a triple and two RBI.

RAKING RASQUIN: Cyclones INF **Walter Rasquin** has hit safely in 16 of 18 games this year and is batting .328 (19-58) against righthanders.

NEW ADDITION: RHP **Michael Gibbons** ended his rehab assignment with the Cyclones...RHP **Luis De Los Santos** joined the Cyclones from Kingsport where he was 0-0 with a 4.50 ERA in three games, one start...The righthander struck out nine batters in 6.0 IP with the K-Mets.

THE STRUGGLE IS REAL: SS **Franklin Correa** has at least one strike out in his last 18 games with an at-bat and is currently 3rd in the NYPL with 33 k's.

THE E IN CYCLONES: The Cyclones rank 13th in the NYPL with a .957 fielding percentage...The team has been charged with 43 errors in 989 total chances...The Cyclones have at least one error in 20 of their 27 games this season...The Cyclones are 4-3 in games when they do not commit an error.

BOTTOMING OUT: The Cyclones are currently 7-20, the worst start in franchise history, and the first time in franchise history the team has ever been more than 10 games under .500.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor in the decision on July 13th at Mahoning Valley...Allowed two runs, earned, on six hits with one walk and three strikeouts over his 6.0 IP...The Cyclones lost the game 4-2 after RHP Marcel Renteria allowed two runs in the bottom of the seventh.

YOU COMPLETE ME: Tossed a complete-game on July 2nd in a 3-2 loss to the Connecticut Tigers...Game was 7 innings as the second half of a suspended game...It is the only complete game by a Cyclones pitcher this season.

ONCE A YEAR: Walked his first batter in 367 days during his start against the Yankees on July 7th... It was his first walk of the season, compared to 13 strikeouts... Had not walked a batter since 7/5/16, a streak that spanned 32.2 innings.

IN THE ZONE: In 158.2 IP over his four plus seasons with the Mets organization has allowed just 19 walks.

IN 2016: Went 3-2 with a 3.86 ERA in 15 games, all in relief, for the Kingsport Mets...Allowed 10 ER in 23.1 IP while scattering 28 hits and three walks...Struck out 21.

SEEING DOUBLE: Is not the only member of the 2017 Brooklyn Cyclones named "Jose Medina." Jose Miguel Medina (no relation) is the regular right-fielder for the Cyclones.
