LAST GAME: The Brooklyn Cyclones defeated the Yankees by a score of 3-1 Wednesday night, winning two of the three games in the series... The Cyclones scored twice in the sixth inning after putting runners on second and third with two outs... C Scott Manea and 2B Edgardo Fermin came through with back-to-back RBI singles... RHP Marcel Renteria pitched two scoreless frames, striking out four of the six batters he faced, to earn his first professional win... RHP Cannon Chadwick pitched two scoreless frames out of the bullpen to notch his first professional save.

NEED FOR SPEED: Cyclones OF Jose M. Medina leads the team and the league with 16 steals and has been caught just once this season... The franchise record for steals in a season is 30, set by OF Angel Pagan in 2001.

BACK-TO-BACK: Brooklyn has won back-to-back games for just the second time this season, after defeating Staten Island two nights in a row... The only other time the Cyclones have won back-to-back games was on June 21 and 22 against the Vermont Lake Monsters.

DEFENSE WINS GAMES: Brooklyn has made just one error in the last four games, after racking up 44 errors in the first 25 games of the season... The Cyclones are now 5-2 when turning in an errorless ballgame.

RAKING RASQUIN: Cyclones INF Walter Rasquin went 3-4 with two double yesterday to raise his average to .301... He is the only Cyclone to currently have a batting average over .300, and has now hit safely in 18 of the 20 games he has played this season, including hitting safely in four-straight contests.

THE MAGIC NUMBER: The Cyclones are 3-15 when they score three runs or less this season... They are 6-5 when they score four runs or more.

vs. CONNECTICUT: Brooklyn is 1-2 this season against Connecticut after the two teams met in a three-game series from 7/1-7/3..... The Cyclones won the first game 7-6, then the Tigers won the second game 3-2 and the series finale 10-3... This is the first meeting between the two teams at Dodd Stadium in 2017... Last year, Brooklyn was 2-4 overall against Connecticut, going 1-2 at MCU Park and 1-2 at Dodd Stadium.

NYPL AWARDS: LHP Gunnar Kines and OF Jose M. Medina were named the NYPL Pitcher and Player of the Week for the period of July 10th - 16th...Kines tossed 10.0 shutout innings over the span, allowing just two hits with three walks and nine strikeouts...He is the 27th Cyclones pitcher to be named Pitcher of the Week and the first since RHP Gary Cornish for the period of August 29th - September 4th...Jose M. Medina hit .400 (10-25) including a game winning hit against State College on July 16th...Medina is the first position player to win the award since 1B Cole Frenzel for the period running from June 25 - July 1, 2012...The last time the Cyclones won Pitcher / Player of the Week in the same week was June 25 - July 1, 2012 when Frenzel and RHP Luis Mateo were honored.

FANTASTIC FERMIN: Since being called up from the Kingsport Mets, INF Edgardo Fermin is 4-15 (.267) with two RBIs and three walks in his five games as a member of the Brooklyn Cyclones... He has also not committed an error in 45.0 innings between shortstop and second base.

LIGHTS OUT FROM THE 'PEN: Over the last four games, the Brooklyn bullpen has allowed just two earned runs in 17.2 innings—good for a 1.02 ERA—striking out 21 and walking 10.

ROAD, SWEET ROAD: OF Quinn Brodey has been a much better hitter on the road... in 10 away contests, Brodey is batting .325 (13-40)... At MCU Park, the 2017 3rd-Round pick is hitting just .158 (6-38) in 11 games.

LAST TIME OUT: Struggled out of the bullpen against the State-College Spikes, allowing season-high eight runs (six earned) on six hits... In his first inning of work in that appearance, the Spikes sent 11 batters to the plate against Johnson, with the first seven reaching base and subsequently scoring.

WALK THIS WAY: The right-hander's outing against State College marked just the second time in his professional career that he logged more walks than strikeouts in a single appearance.

TURN OF THE CALENDAR: Johnson has struggled in the month of July... in three appearances (one start), the right-hander has a 13.09 ERA in 11 innings... In June, Johnson made two appearances, both starts, and went 1-1 with a 2.45 ERA in 11 innings.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Collected his first professional win on June 22 at Vermont...Tossed 5.0 innings, allowing one run on four hits with one walk and four strikeouts.

STARTING FRESH: This season marks his first year as a starter... Pitched in 14 games out of the bullpen for the Kingsport Mets. Struck out 14 in 16.1 innings pitched.

GOING THE DISTANCE: Never pitched more than 2.0 innings last season...Pitched 2.0 innings on four separate occasions...Was limited due to an innings restriction following his collegiate career.

THE OLD COLLEGE TRY: Went 8-2 with a 2.20 ERA in 98.1 innings during his sophomore season at Santa Fe...Struck out 89 batters and walked 21.
