LAST GAME: The Brooklyn Cyclones extended their winning streak to three games thanks to a 6-4 win over the Connecticut Tigers on Thursday night...RHP **Keaton Aldridge** (1-0) allowed a two-out single in the bottom of the ninth that drove in a pair and tied the game, but tossed a flawless 10th to collect the win...INF **Dylan Snyes** reach on an error in the 11th that plated a pair and provided the winning margin.

NEED FOR SPEED: Cyclones OF **Jose M. Medina** leads the team and is tied for the league lead with 16 steals...The franchise record for steals in a season is 30, set by OF **Angel Pagan** in 2001.

THREE IN A ROW: The Cyclones have won three consecutive games for the first time in 2017... Brooklyn last won three straight games during a five game winning streak from August 8th - 12th last season.

DEFENSE WINS GAMES: Brooklyn has not been charged with an error in five straight games after being charged with an error in 20 of their first 25 contests...Brooklyn is 7-3 in games when they don't commit an error.

RAKING RASQUIN: Cyclones INF **Walter Rasquin** currently ranks ninth in the NYPL with a .302 (26-86) average...The 21-year-old has hit safely in 19 of 21 games and currently has a five-game hitting streak during which he is batting .444 (8-18)...Rasquin is batting .353 (24-68) against righties and .111 (2-18) against southpaws.

THE MAGIC NUMBER: The Cyclones are 3-15 when they score three runs or less this season... They are 7-5 when they score four runs or more.

RISP-ECT: The Cyclones are batting .204 (58-285) with RISP and .136 (16-118) with RISP and two-outs.

vs. CONNECTICUT: Brooklyn is 2-2 against the Connecticut Tigers this season and 22-24 all-time against Connecticut...Brooklyn went 22-13 against the Oneonta Tigers before they moved to Norwich for the 2010 season...The Cyclones are 10-13 all-time at Dodd Stadium and have not won a series there since 2012 when they took two for three from the Tigers.

POWER OUTAGE: The Cyclones are last in the NYPL with four home runs this season...The team has not hit a home run since July 8th when **Carl Stajduar** hit a solo shot in the fourth inning at Staten Island... There are six players in the NYPL with as many - or more - home runs as the Brooklyn team...Brooklyn has gone 407 at-bats without a homer coming into tonight.

ROAD, SWEET ROAD: OF **Quinn Brodey** is batting .302 (13-43) on the road and just .158 (6-28) at MCU Park...Conversely, C **Scott Manea** is hitting .063 (1-16) on the road and .286 (6-21) at home.

COME ALL WITHOUT: OF **Quinn Brodey** is batting just .179 (7-39) over the last 10 games...The former Stanford Cardinal has struck out eight times in his last 15 at-bats.

RUNNING ON E: OF **Ricardo Cespedes** scored a run in his first game as a Cyclone, but has gone without a run scored since.

EIGHT IS ENOUGH: Despite blowing a 3-1 lead in the ninth inning, the Cyclones rallied to win 6-4 in 11 innings...With the win, Brooklyn improved to 524-14 all-time when leading after eight innings.

ROAD WARRIOR: INF **Walter Rasquin** has hit safely in 10 straight road games, the longest streak in the NYPL this season...He is batting .262 (11-42) in these contests with just one multi-hit game.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: Joins the Cyclones after making three appearances with the Kingsport Mets... De Los Santos was 0-0 with a 4.50 ERA with 9 strikeouts and four walks in six innings-pitched.

BOUNCING AROUND: The right-hander pitched for three different teams within the Mets organization last season... He began 2016 with the DSL Mets, moved to the GCL Mets, and made four appearances at the end of 2016 for the Columbia Fireflies.

DOWN IN THE GCL: De Los Santos spent most of his 2016 with the GCL Mets, where he went 3-4 with a 2.62 ERA in 10 games, seven starts... His 2.62 ERA ranked ninth in the Gulf Coast League.

ZEROES IN RELIEF: Pitched 16.0 innings in relief with the GCL Mets and did not allow an earned run.

DOMINICAN ROOTS: De Los Santos is one of seven players on the current Cyclones roster (Cecilio Aybar, Franklin Correa, Nicolas Deborra, Gregorix Estevez, Jose Maria, Jose Miguel Medina) to hail from the Dominican Republic.
