LAST GAME: The Cyclones dropped the final game of a three-game set against the Aberdeen Ironbirds 4-3... Brooklyn led 2-0 after three frames, but Aberdeen scored four unanswered runs between the fourth and fifth innings... RHP Connor O'Neil, RHP Marcel Renteria, and RHP Keaton Aldrige pitched a combined 4.2 innings of scoreless relief, allowing just one hit. C/1B Jose Maria and OF Ricardo Cespedes both hit solo home runs... It was the first time this season that Brooklyn hit two home runs in one game.

RAKING RASQUIN: Cyclones INF Walter Rasquin currently ranks third in the NYPL with a .346 (37-107) average...The 21-year-old has hit safely in 24 of 26 games he has played and currently has a 10-game hitting streak, during which he is batting .487 (19-37)... With his current 10-game hitting streak, Rasquin becomes the fourth Cyclone in franchise history with multiple 10 or more game hitting streaks (OF Joe Holden, 3B Jhoan Ureña & 1B Jeff Diehl) and just the second to have multiple 10 or more game hitting streaks in the same season (Ureña - 2014).

JOSE! JOSE! JOSE!: OF Jose M. Medina has hit safely in 11 of his last 12 games with an at-bat and is batting .370 (17-46) over the span.

BYRD WATCHING: INF Leon Byrd ranks eighth in the NYPL with a .393 on-base percentage and is tied for sixth in the league with 17 base-on-balls...In 16 games during July, he has reached base safely in 14 of the contests.

THE SHOW: Former Brooklyn Cyclones RHP Chris Flexen (2015) will make his Major League debut tonight... getting the start for the New York Mets against the San Diego Padres at Petco Park... This season, Flexen is 6-1 with a 1.66 ERA for the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (AA)... He becomes the 45th former Cyclones player to make his debut with the Mets, and 66th former Cyclones player to make it to The Show.

vs. LOWELL: This is the first meeting in 2017 between the Spinners and the Cyclones... Last year, Brooklyn and Lowell met six times, three times at MCU Park and three times at LeLacheur Park... The Spinners won each of the six meetings... Brooklyn was outscored 33-11, including being shut out twice.

TOP PROSPECTS: Current Cyclones LHP David Peterson (#3) and OF Ricardo Cespedes (#22) are listed among the New York Mets top-30 prospects, according to MLB.com... Former and current Cyclones hold eight of the top ten spots, including SS Amed Rosario (#1), LHP David Peterson (#3), RHP Justin Dunn (#4), LHP Thomas Szapucki (#6), OF Desmond Lindsay (#7), RHP Marcos Molina (#8), RHP Merandy Gonzalez (#9), SS/2B Gavin Cecchini (#10).

NEED FOR SPEED: Cyclones OF Jose M. Medina leads the team and is tied for the New York-Penn League lead with 17 stolen bases...The franchise record for steals in a single season is 30, set by OF Angel Pagan in 2001.

HOMECOMING: C Scott Manea and RHP Joe Napolitano are both Massachusetts natives... Manea is from Shrewsbury, Mass., which is approximately 38 miles southwest of LeLacheur Park.... Napolitano hails from Concord, Mass., which is approximately 17 miles south of LeLacheur Park... Former Cyclones OF Ian Strom, who was promoted to Low-A Columbia earlier this season, played at LeLacheur Park when he played for the UMass-Lowell River Hawks from 2014-2016.

ROAD, SWEET ROAD: OF Quinn Brodey is batting .327 (17-52) in 13 away games this season, compared to a .176 (9-51) mark in 14 games at MCU Park.

MOVING ON UP: RHP Keaton Aldrige was promoted to Low-A Columbia on July 26th... The right-hander appeared nine times for Brooklyn, allowing runs in just two of his outings.

BOUNCING AROUND: The right-hander pitched for three different teams within the Mets organization last season... He began 2016 with the DSL Mets, moved to the GCL Mets, and made four appearances at the end of 2016 for the Columbia Fireflies.

DOWN IN THE GCL: De Los Santos spent most of his 2016 with the GCL Mets, where he went 3-4 with a 2.62 ERA in 10 games, seven starts... His 2.62 ERA ranked ninth in the Gulf Coast League.

ZEROES IN RELIEF: Pitched 16.0 innings in relief with the GCL Mets and did not allow an earned run.

DOMINICAN ROOTS: De Los Santos is one of seven players on the current Cyclones roster (Cecilio Aybar, Franklin Correa, Nicolas Debora, Gregorix Estevez, Jose Maria, Jose Miguel Medina) to hail from the Dominican Republic.
