LAST GAME: The Cyclones and Tigers split a pair of one-run games on Saturday afternoon with Brooklyn winning the suspended game 7-6, and the Tigers taking game two by the count of 3-2... INF **Reed Gamache** went 3-for-3 in the second game and OF **Jose M. Medina** went 2-for-3 with two runs scored, a home run and two RBI to lead the Cyclones to a come from behind win in game one.

RISP NO REWARD: The Cyclones are batting .175 (20-114) with runners in scoring position this season, including a 12-for-78 stretch during their current losing streak...The .175 average ranks 13th in the 14-team NYPL behind West Virginia batting .173 (19-10) in these situations...The team has left 92 runners on base, fifth most in the NYPL.

RECENT CYCLONES: Brooklyn has lost eight of their last nine games since starting the season 2-1.

UNFRIENDLY CONFINES: Dating to August 23rd of last year, the Cyclones are 3-10 at MCU Park and have been out scored 67-48 over the span...This year, Brooklyn is 1-5 at home and is batting .203 (36-177) while being outscored 39-23.

THE STRUGGLE IS REAL: Brooklyn 3B **Carl Stajduahr** is also in an 0-for-14 slump to start his professional career.

THE E IN CYCLONES: The Cyclones rank 13th in the NYPL with a .949 fielding percentage...The team has been charged with 23 errors in 455 total chances...The team has also allowed four passed balls, third most in the NYPL.

vs. CONNECTICUT: The Cyclones are 20-22 all-time against the Connecticut Tigers...The Tigers are the only team that Brooklyn has played more than six times, and has a losing record against... The Cyclones are 11-9 against the Tigers at MCU Park, but 9-13 against them at Dodd Stadium in Norwich...The Cyclones went 22-13 against the Oneonta Tigers before they moved to CT.

BKLYN NETS: This series marks the first games at MCU Park with the addition of the new protective netting system that extends from Section 15 on the third base side to Section 16 on the first base side... The netting is 33 feet high and uses technology that increases transparency to 97 %...On June 15th the Mets announced that Citi Field, MCU Park, First Data Field (St. Lucie), Wright Stadium (Kingsport) and NYSEG Stadium (Binghamton) would add netting.

TAKE THE FIFTH: The Cyclones have been outscored 17-2 in the fifth inning of games this season... After the fifth inning, Brooklyn has been outscored 48-24.

STUCK AT START: The 3-9 start to the season is tied for the worst start in franchise history...Brooklyn went 3-9 to start the 2006 season, but would go on to finish 41-33 and make the playoffs.

POWER OUTAGE: OF **Jose M. Medina** hit a home run in the 8th inning of yesterday's suspended game...It was only the second home run of the season for the Cyclones...The two round trippers are tied for 12th in the NYPL with West Virginia's one home run ranking last...Auburn leads the NYPL with 17 home runs.

SPEED RACER: Brooklyn currently leads the NYPL with 19 stolen bases including OF **Jose Medina's** league leading six steals.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Collected his first professional win on June 22 at Vermont...Tossed 5.0 innings, allowing one run on four hits with one walk and four strikeouts.

CALLING ALL SINGLES: Over his 11.0 IP, has allowed just one extra base hit - a two-run home run - on June 28th.

STARTING FRESH: This season marks his first year as a starter...Pitched in 14 games out of the bullpen for the King-sport Mets. Struck out 14 in 16.1 innings pitched.

CLEAN SLATE: In 2016, limited batters to a .189 (7-37) bat-ting average with the bases empty...Also struck out nine and held batters to a .231 on-base percentage.

RUNNING INTO TROUBLE: With runners on, the opposi-tion is batting .424 (14-33) with three doubles, one triple and 12 RBI...Opponents have a .462 (6-13) average with RISP.

GOING THE DISTANCE: Never pitched more than 2.0 innings last season...Pitched 2.0 innings on four seperate occasions...Was limited due to an innings restriction follow-ing his collegiate career.

THE OLD COLLEGE TRY: Went 8-2 with a 2.20 ERA in 98.1 innings during his sophomore season at Santa Fe...Struck out 89 batters and walked 21.
