**LAST GAME:** The Cyclones took a 5-3 lead into the bottom of the eighth, but would eventually fall to the ValleyCats by the score of 9-5...RHP Connor O'Neil (0-1) and RHP Gregorix Estevez combined to allow six runs in the eighth to turn the game upside down...OF Ricardo Cespedes went 2-for-5 in his Brooklyn debut with a run scored while 2B Reed Gamache had a pair of RBI for the Cyclones.

**RISP NO REWARD:** The Cyclones are batting .190 (26-137) with runners in scoring position this season, including a 18-for-101 stretch where they have lost 10 of 11...The .190 average is last in the New York-Penn League...The team has left 116 runners on base, third most in the league.

**RECENT CYCLONES:** Brooklyn has lost 10 of their last 11 games since starting the season 2-1.

**UNFRIENDLY CONFINES:** Dating to August 23rd of last year, the Cyclones are 3-11 at MCU Park and have been out scored 77-51 over the span...This year, Brooklyn is 1-6 at home and is batting .218 (36-177) while being outscored 52-26...Cyclones pitchers have a 6.49 ERA (44 ER / 61.0 IP)

**THE E IN CYCLONES:** The Cyclones rank 13th in the NYPL with a .949 fielding percentage...The team has been charged with 27 errors in 530 total chances...The Cyclones have at least one error in 11 of their 14 games this season including 10 of their last 11 contests...Cyclones third baseman have combined for seven errors and have a .837 (7/43) fielding percentage...3B Carl Stajduhar has four errors in 20 total chances this season.

**vs. TRI-CITY:** The Cyclones are 44-35 all-time against the ValleyCats including a 21-19 mark at Bruno Stadium in Troy, NY...Since 2011 the ValleyCats lead the series 20-14, including a 15-4 advantage at home...The Cyclones have not won the season series since 2010 and have not won a series at Bruno Stadium since that year as well.

**TAKE THE FIFTH:** The Cyclones have been outscored 17-2 in the fifth inning of games this season... After the fifth inning, Brooklyn has been outscored 58-25.

**END OF AN E.R.A:** The Cyclones currently have a 5.75 team ERA, worst in the NYPL...Coming into this season, the highest team ERA in franchise history was a 3.41 team ERA in 2005.

**POWER SURGE:** Cyclones pitchers have allowed 12 home runs this season, tops in the New York-Penn League.

**STUCK AT START:** The 3-11 start to the season is the worst start in franchise history...Brooklyn went 5-9 to start the 2006 season, but would go on to finish 41-33 and make the playoffs.

**NOT RIGHT VS. LEFT:** The Cyclones are batting .185 (12-65) against lefthanded pitching this season with 21 strikeouts.

**SPEED RACER:** Brooklyn currently leads the NYPL with 21 stolen bases including OF Jose Medina's league leading seven steals.

**NOT SO BULLISH IN THE PEN:** The Cyclones bullpen has a 6.75 ERA (41 ER / 54.2 IP) so far this season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Pitched in relief against the Aberdeen Ironbirds on 6/29. Debora allowed two runs on six hits, including a solo home run. Debora left with the bases loaded and two outs, but Gregorix Estevez was able to strand all three runners.

**TAKING THE HILL:** Debora is making his first start of 2017. He last started a game on August 30, 2016 against the GCL Astros. The right-hander tossed six shutout innings, allowing two hits, striking out four and walking one.

**ENEMY TERRITORY:** This is Debora's third appearance on the road in 2017. He has never pitched in a game at MCU Park.

**ELDER STATESMAN:** Of the current members of the Cyclones' roster, Debora has been in the Mets' organization the longest, now in his sixth season. Only Jose Maria has been in the system as long.

**STERLING IN 2015:** The right-hander's best professional season came in 2015, when he was the DSL 2 Mets Sterling Award winner. Debora went 3-2 with a 1.65 ERA—a mark that ranked fifth in the DSL.
