LAST GAME: The Cyclones offense erupted for 10 runs on 17 hits on Wednesday night as they defeated the ValleyCats 10-1...All nine batters in the starting lineup collected at least one hit and OF **Quinn Brodey** went 3-for-5, while OF **Ricardo Cespedes** and OF **Jose M. Medina** each had three RBI to pace the Brooklyn bats...LHP **Gunnar Kines** (1-2) got the win in relief after tossing 4.1 inning out of the bullpen, allowing one run on three hits.

NOTES FROM LAST NIGHT: The 17 hits from the Cyclones last night were tied for the most hits in a single game since July 21, 2011 with the Cyclones collected 20 hits against the Aberdeen IronBirds.

STRANDED: The Cyclones rank second in the NYPL with 127 runners left on base this season...Batavia leads the way with 135 runners stranded...The Cyclones are hitting .218 (34-156) with RISP.

RECENT CYCLONES: Brooklyn has lost 10 of their last 12 games since starting the season 2-1.

UNFRIENDLY CONFINES: Dating to August 23rd of last year, the Cyclones are 3-11 at MCU Park and have been out scored 77-51 over the span...This year, Brooklyn is 1-6 at home and is batting .218 (36-177) while being outscored 52-26...Cyclones pitchers have a 6.49 ERA (44 ER / 61.0 IP)

THE E IN CYCLONES: The Cyclones rank 13th in the NYPL with a .952 fielding percentage...The team has been charged with 27 errors in 560 total chances...The Cyclones have at least one error in 11 of their 15 games this season including 10 of their last 12 contests...Cyclones third baseman have combined for seven errors and have a .848 (7/46) fielding percentage...3B **Carl Stajduhar** has four errors in 23 total chances this season.

vs. TRI-CITY: The Cyclones are 45-35 all-time against the ValleyCats including a 22-19 mark at Bruno Stadium in Troy, NY...Since 2011 the ValleyCats lead the series 20-15, including a 15-5 advantage at home...The Cyclones have not won the season series since 2010 and have not won a series at Bruno Stadium since that year as well.

FIVE ALIVE: The Cyclones are batting .310 (52-168) over their last five games, after batting .148 (23-155) over their previous five contests.

TAKE THE FIFTH: The Cyclones have been outscored 17-4 in the fifth inning of games this season...After the fifth inning, Brooklyn has been outscored 59-28.

END OF AN E.R.A: The Cyclones currently have a 5.41 team ERA, 13th in the NYPL...Coming into this season, the highest team ERA in franchise history was a 3.41 team ERA in 2005.

POWER SURGE: Cyclones pitchers have allowed 13 home runs this season, tops in the New York-Penn League.

STUCK AT START: The 4-11 start to the season is the worst start in franchise history...Brooklyn went 5-9 to start the 2006 season, but would go on to finish 41-33 and make the playoffs.

SPEED RACER: Brooklyn currently leads the NYPL with 22 stolen bases including OF **Jose Medina's** league leading eight steals.

NOT SO BULLISH IN THE PEN: The Cyclones bullpen has a 6.30 ERA (42 ER / 60.0 IP) so far this season.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Made the Opening Day start for the Cyclones but did not factor in the decision...Struggled with his control early, issuing four walks, but limited the damage to just three runs on two hits.

SCORING CHANCE: Opponents are batting .333 (4-12) against the southpaw with runners in scoring position with the Cyclones.

START ME UP: Made two starts for Columbia of the South Atlantic League prior to joining the Cyclones...He went 1-1 with a 7.71 ERA, nine strikeouts, and six walks.

IN 2016: Made 12 starts last season with Kingsport (Rookie). Finished the season 2-5 with a 4.83 ERA. In 63.1 IP, he struck out 66 and walked 31.

AWESOME AWAY: Simon has yet to allow a run in an away game this season. He's thrown 8.1 scoreless innings on the road in 2017.

SIGNED: Prior to signing with the Mets after being selected in the 11th round of the 2015 MLB Draft, Simon had committed to Rice University.
