LAST GAME: The Cyclones dropped the rubber match of a three-game series to the Tri-City ValleyCats by the score of 13-0 on Thursday night in Troy, NY...Cyclones pitchers allowed 15 hits, including five home runs, while walking seven...LHP **Jake Simon** (0-2) was tagged with the loss after allowing seven runs, earned, on nine hits over 4.1 IP...The Cyclones managed just three hits with two of them coming from 1B **Matt Winaker**

NOTES FROM LAST NIGHT: The five home runs allowed by Cyclones pitchers were a franchise record...It was the second time this season that Brooklyn has allowed four or more home runs in a game after allowing four home run in a game just twice through the first 16 seasons in franchise history...The five home runs allowed were the most by any team in the New York-Penn League since June 22, 2014 when Batavia surrendered six home runs to the State College Spikes.

STRANDED: The Cyclones rank third in the NYPL with 134 runners left on base this season...Batavia leads the way with 144 runners stranded...The Cyclones are hitting .210 (34-162) with RISP.

RECENT CYCLONES: Brooklyn has lost 11 of their last 13 games since starting the season 2-1.

UNFRIENDLY CONFINES: Dating to August 23rd of last year, the Cyclones are 3-11 at MCU Park and have been out scored 77-51 over the span...This year, Brooklyn is 1-6 at home and is batting .218 (36-177) while being outscored 52-26...Cyclones pitchers have a 6.49 ERA (44 ER / 61.0 IP)

POWER SURGE: Cyclones pitchers have allowed 18 home runs this season, tops in the New York-Penn League.

vs. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones lead the all-time series 104-101...Brooklyn is 55-48 all-time at MCU Park and 49-53 at Staten Island...Brooklyn has more wins against Staten Island than any other team...The Yankees won the season series in 2015 7-5, including going 6-0 at MCU Park...The 2016 season series ended with Staten Island going 6-4, including 4-1 at Richmond County Bank Ballpark.

THE E IN CYCLONES: The Cyclones rank 13th in the NYPL with a .950 fielding percentage...The team has been charged with 30 errors in 595 total chances...The Cyclones have at least one error in 12 of their 16 games this season including 11 of their last 13 contests...Cyclones third baseman have combined for seven errors and have a .830 (8/47) fielding percentage...3B **Carl Stajduhar** has five errors in 24 total chances this season.

TAKE THE FIFTH: The Cyclones have been outscored 19-4 in the fifth inning of games this season... After the fifth inning, Brooklyn has been outscored 67-30.

END OF AN E.R.A: The Cyclones currently have a 5.89 team ERA, last in the NYPL...Coming into this season, the highest team ERA in franchise history was a 3.41 team ERA in 2005.

STUCK AT START: The 4-12 start to the season is the worst start in franchise history...Brooklyn went 6-10 to start the 2006 and 2013 seasons.

NOT SO BULLISH IN THE PEN: The Cyclones bullpen has a 6.79 ERA (48 ER / 63.2 IP) so far this season.

FULLY LOADED : The Cyclones are batting .160 (4-25) with the bases loaded, with 8 k's.
