LAST GAME: The Cyclones and Yankees split a pair on Saturday night, with Brooklyn winning Game One by the score of 4-2 before falling in the night cap 7-2...3B **Carl Stajduhar** had four hits in the two games after starting his pro career with just three hits through his first nine games

WHAT A RELIEF: LHP **Marty Anderson** became the 47th pitcher in franchise history to strike out double digit batters, but just the second to do it in relief when he struck out 10 on Friday night...RHP **Nabil Crismatt** struck out 11 over 5.0 innings of relief on July 23, 2016 vs. Aberdeen.

STRANDED: The Cyclones rank second in the NYPL with 153 runners left on base this season...Batavia leads the way with 159 runners stranded...

RECENT CYCLONES: Brooklyn has lost 13 of their last 16 games since starting the season 2-1.

UNFRIENDLY CONFINES: Dating to August 23rd of last year, the Cyclones are 3-12 at MCU Park and have been out scored 81-54 over the span...This year, Brooklyn is 1-7 at home and is batting .207 (50-242) while being outscored 53-29...Cyclones pitchers have a 5.79 ERA (45 ER / 70.0 IP)

POWER SURGE: Cyclones pitchers have allowed 19 home runs this season, tops in the New York-Penn League.

NEW KID: The Mets have signed their first selection in the 2017 MLB Draft LHP **David Peterson**... He was assigned to Brooklyn but is not expected to pitch for several weeks.

FULLY LOADED : The Cyclones are batting .154 (4-26) with the bases loaded, with 8 k's.

vs. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones lead the all-time series 105-103...Brooklyn is 55-49 all-time at MCU Park and 50-54 at Staten Island...Brooklyn has more wins against Staten Island than any other team...The Yankees won the season series in 2015 7-5, including going 6-0 at MCU Park...The 2016 season series ended with Staten Island going 6-4, including 4-1 at Richmond County Bank Ballpark.

RISP NO REWARD: The Cyclones are 4-for-21 with RISP during Saturday's doubleheader and are hitting .206 (39-189) for the season...With RISP and two-outs the team is batting just .122 (9-74)

THE E IN CYCLONES: The Cyclones rank 13th in the NYPL with a .952 fielding percentage...The team has been charged with 33 errors in 689 total chances...The Cyclones have at least one error in 14 of their 19 games this season...Cyclones third baseman have combined for seven errors and have a .846 (8/52) fielding percentage...3B **Carl Stajduhar** has five errors in 29 total chances.

GETS LATE EARLY: The Cyclones have been outscored 68-34 from the fifth inning on.

END OF AN E.R.A: The Cyclones currently have a 5.64 team ERA, last in the NYPL...Coming into this season, the highest team ERA in franchise history was a 3.41 team ERA in 2005.

STUCK AT START: The 5-14 start to the season is the worst start in franchise history...Brooklyn went 6-13 to start the season in 2006 but would go on to finish the year 41-33 and win the Wild Card.

NOT SO BULLISH IN THE PEN: The Cyclones bullpen has a 6.38 ERA (48 ER / 67.2 IP) so far this season.
