OPENING DAY: The Cyclones are 12-4 all-time on Opening Day and 8-2 since 2007, with both of their losses coming at the hands of the Staten Island Yankees in 2013 and 2016...This season marks the 14th time that the Cyclones and Yankees will square off on Opening Day with the Cyclones holding a 10-3 advantage in these games...The Cyclones and Staten Island have opened the season against each other every year since 2005.

HAPPY DAYS IN BK: Manager **Edgardo Alfonzo** begins his first season as Cyclones manager after serving as a coach on **Tom Gamboa's** staff each of the last three seasons...Edgardo's brother Edgar managed the Cyclones in 2001, 2007 and 2008 and leads the franchise with 146 managerial victories...His nephew Edgar also pitched for the team in 2004 and 2005...Alfonzo played for the Pittsfield Mets, of the New York-Penn League, in 1992 and hit .356 (106-298) with 41 runs scored, 13 doubles, five triples, one home run and 44 RBI in 74 games at just 18-years-old.

LAST YEAR OPENER: The Cyclones and Yankees played 20 innings in the season opener in 2016 with the Cyclones falling 3-2...INF **Franklin Correa** tossed 2.0 scoreless innings of relief for Brooklyn... In Staten Island's home opener the following day, the Cyclones fell 2-1 in 10 innings and were no hit.

SINCE WE LAST MET: Since the Cyclones played their last game, MCU Park has hosted over 100 collegiate, high school and little league games, hosted the New York Empire ultimate frisbee, New York Cosmos soccer, the FDNY vs. NYPD Football game, over 40,000 runners for the Brooklyn Half Marathon and close to 10,000 students as part of our Diamond Dreams school program.

vs. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones lead the all-time series 104-100...Brooklyn is 55-47 all-time at MCU Park and 49-53 at Staten Island...Brooklyn has more wins against Staten Island than any other team...The Yankees won the season series in 2015 7-5, including going 6-0 at MCU Park...The 2016 season series ended with Staten Island going 6-4, including 4-1 at Richmond County Bank Ballpark.

SOMETHING OLD: There are three players on the Opening Day roster who played for the Cyclones during the 2016 season...That's the fewest number of returning players on Opening Day in franchise history...OF **Jacob Zanon** (44 games), INF **Franklin Correa** (7 games) and RHP **Gregorix Estevez** (2 games) played for Brooklyn last year...Zanon has joined the team as part of a rehab assignment as he recovers from a facial fracture...He began the year with Columbia, hitting .500 (4-8) before getting hit by a pitch in the face on April 10th.

SOMETHING NEW: On Sunday, the Mets announced the signing of 20 recent draft picks...Of that bunch, RHP **Marcel Renteria** (6th Round), RHP **Connor O'Neil** (7th Round), RHP **Trey Cobb** (8th Round), RHP **Cannon Chadwick** (9th Round), INF **Dylan Snydes** (15th Round), and INF **Carl Stajduhar** (18th Round) are expected to join the Cyclones.

OPENING DAY: There are two players who have been in the Opening Day starting lineup for both the Cyclones and New York Mets...**Lucas Duda** was the starting DH for the Cyclones on June 19, 2007 and has been in the Mets Opening Day lineup four times...**Mike Jacobs** was the starting catcher for the first Cyclones game in franchise history on June 19, 2001 and was the Mets Opening Day first baseman on April 5, 2010.

START ME UP: Has made two starts so far in 2017, both for Columbia of the South Atlantic League. In two starts, Simon is 1-1 with a 7.71 ERA, nine strikeouts, and six walks.

LAST TIME OUT: In his last appearance, Simon turned out the best performance of his career, tossing 5.1 innings of shutout baseball, allowing just two hits. He struck out five and walked three Lexington Legends batters.

IN 2016: Made 12 starts last season with Kingsport (Rookie). Finished the season 2-5 with a 4.83 ERA. In 63.1 IP, he struck out 66 and walked 31.

AWESOME AWAY: Simon has yet to allow a run in an away game this season. He's thrown 8.1 scoreless innings on the road in 2017.

ALL-AMERICAN: 2017 is the second-straight season that a U.S. born pitcher will make the start in the Cyclones home opener, after California native Gabriel Llanes got the ball to start the 2016 season. RHP Gaby Almonte ('15), Octavio Acosta ('14) and John Gant ('13) have made the previous three home-opening starts.

SIGNED: Prior to signing with the Mets after being selected in the 11th round of the 2015 MLB Draft, Simon had committed to Rice University.

KEEPING IT 100: Simon has pitched 95 innings in his professional career, needing just five more innings-pitched to reach triple digits. He is 10 strike outs shy of 100 career Ks.
