LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones fell to the Staten Island Yankees by the score of 7-4 on Opening Day at MCU Park...RHP **Joe Napolitano** (0-1) was tagged with the loss after allowing four runs, earned, over his 2.0 innings of relief...C **Carlos Sanchez** had a two-RBI double to pace the Brooklyn bats who managed just four hits on the night.

HAPPY DAYS IN BK: Manager **Edgardo Alfonzo** begins his first season as Cyclones manager after serving as a coach on **Tom Gamboa's** staff each of the last three seasons...Edgardo's brother Edgar managed the Cyclones in 2001, 2007 and 2008 and leads the franchise with 146 managerial victories...His nephew Edgar also pitched for the team in 2004 and 2005...Alfonzo played for the Pittsfield Mets, of the New York-Penn League, in 1992 and hit .356 (106-298) with 41 runs scored, 13 doubles, five triples, one home run and 44 RBI in 74 games at just 18-years-old.

IN KINES: LHP **Gunnar Kines** joined the Cyclones on Tuesday after signing as a Minor League free agent...The southpaw was originally selected in the 36th round of the 2015 MLB Draft by the Miami Marlins and went 3-3 with a 1.77 ERA in 16 games, two starts, with the GCL Marlins and Greensboro (SAL)...Spent the 2016 season, and the start of the 2017 season with the Schaumburg (IL) Boomers of the Independent Frontier League...Through seven starts this season, Kines was 5-1 with a 1.31 ERA and 53 strikeouts over 41.1 IP...His five wins and 1.31 ERA were tops in the Frontier League and his 53 strikeouts ranked second.

HE GONE: After last night's game, OF **Jacob Zanon** finished his MiLB Rehabilitation Assignment and was transferred to Columbia (A) of the South Atlantic League.

vs. VERMONT: The Cyclones are 58-27 all-time against the Vermont Lake Monsters including a 29-13 record at Centennial Field...The Cyclones went 3-0 in Vermont last season and are 11-4 in Burlington since 2012...From 2006 - 2008 the Cyclones went 9-0 in Vermont...At MCU Park the Cyclones are 29-14 against the Lake Monsters / Expos including 11-4 since 2012.

SOMETHING NEW: On Sunday, the Mets announced the signing of 20 recent draft picks... Of that bunch, RHP **Marcel Renteria** (6th Round), RHP **Connor O'Neil** (7th Round), RHP **Trey Cobb** (8th Round), RHP **Cannon Chadwick** (9th Round), INF **Dylan Snydes** (15th Round), and INF **Carl Stajduhar** (18th Round) joined the Cyclones following last night's game.

SOLD OUT : Last night the Cyclones and Yankees played in front of 7,271 fans at MCU Park, the 308th sellout in franchise history...For Opening Day 2016 the 7,011 fans were in attendance to see Brooklyn and Staten Island play a 20-inning marathon.

VS. CANCER: The Cyclones and Hudson Valley Renegades will meet for Paw Patrol Night on Sunday for Kids Opening Day, presented by Nick Jr...As part of the festivities the team will wear special Marshall (The Fire Pup) Jerseys that will be auctioned off to benefit Vs. Cancer a foundation focused on raising funds in the fight against Pediatric Cancer... After the game, Cyclones General Manager Kevin Mahoney and Director of Communications will get their heads shaved on the field during a special dash for cash where fans will be encouraged to donate whatever they can in the fight for kids helping kids with cancer.
