**LAST NIGHT:** Brooklyn defeated the Vermont Lake Monsters by the score of 6-1 on Wednesday night in Burlington...Brooklyn collected 14 hits, 10 of which were singles...1B **Jose Maria** went 3-for-4 with two runs scored and his first home run of the season...RF **Jose M. Medina** went 4-for-5 with a pair of runs scored and LF **Jeremy Wolf** had three RBI...RHP Chris McIlraith (1-0) tossed 5.0 shut frames before turning the ball over to LHP **Jose C. Medina** who allowed one unearned run in 4.0 IP.

**HAPPY DAYS IN BK:** Manager **Edgardo Alfonzo** begins his first season as Cyclones manager after serving as a coach on **Tom Gamboa's** staff each of the last three seasons...Edgardo's brother Edgar managed the Cyclones in 2001, 2007 and 2008 and leads the franchise with 146 managerial victories...His nephew Edgar also pitched for the team in 2004 and 2005...Alfonzo played for the Pittsfield Mets, of the New York-Penn League, in 1992 and hit .356 (106-298) with 41 runs scored, 13 doubles, five triples, one home run and 44 RBI in 74 games at just 18-years-old.

**THE ERROR OF OUR WAYS:** The Cyclones tied a franchise record with six errors in last night's game...The team also had six errors on August 22, 2016 at Lowell in a game they lost 8-1...2B **Franklin Correa** was charged with three of last night's errors, also tying a franchise record.

**NEED FOR SPEED:** The Cyclones currently lead the New York-Penn League with six stolen bases through their first two games.

**NEW ADDITION:** RHP **Yeizo Campos** joined the Cyclones on Wednesday...He was assigned from the GCL Mets.

**vs. VERMONT:** The Cyclones are 59-27 all-time against the Vermont Lake Monsters including a 30-13 record at Centennial Field...The Cyclones went 3-0 in Vermont last season and are 12-4 in Burlington since 2012...From 2006 - 2008 the Cyclones went 9-0 in Vermont...At MCU Park the Cyclones are 29-14 against the Lake Monsters / Expos including 11-4 since 2012.

**SOMETHING NEW:** On Sunday, the Mets announced the signing of 20 recent draft picks... Of that bunch, RHP **Tony Dibrrell** (4th Round) RHP **Marcel Renteria** (6th Round), RHP **Connor O'Neil** (7th Round), RHP **Trey Cobb** (8th Round), RHP **Cannon Chadwick** (9th Round), INF **Dylan Snydes** (15th Round), and INF **Carl Stajduhar** (18th Round) joined the Cyclones following last night's game.

CANCER:** The Cyclones and Hudson Valley Renegades will meet for Paw Patrol Night on Sunday for Kids Opening Day, presented by Nick Jr...As part of the festivities the team will wear special Marshall (The Fire Pup) Jerseys that will be auctioned off to benefit Vs. Cancer a foundation focused on raising funds in the fight against Pediatric Cancer... After the game, Cyclones General Manager Kevin Mahoney and Director of Communications will get their heads shaved on the field during a special dash for cash where fans will be encouraged to donate whatever they can in the fight for kids helping kids with cancer.

**ALUMNI NEWS:** Former Cyclones INF **Michael Paez**, RHP **Jordan Humphreys** and RHP **Merandy Gonzalez** were transferred to St. Lucie (A) of the Florida State League...All players were recently named to the South Atlantic League All-Star Team with Columbia (A-).
