LAST NIGHT: Brooklyn defeated the Vermont Lake Monsters by the score of 5-3 to clinch a series win on the road. RHP Trent Johnson made his first professional start, tossing five innings of one-ball and picking up his first professional win. RHP Yiezo Campos pitched 3.2 innings in relief, striking out six and walking none, and RHP Keaton Aldrige picked up the save—his first. OF Jeremy Wolf and INF Franklin Correa notched RBI hits for the second straight day.

HAPPY DAYS IN BK: Manager **Edgardo Alfonzo** begins his first season as Cyclones manager after serving as a coach on **Tom Gamboa's** staff each of the last three seasons...Edgardo's brother Edgar managed the Cyclones in 2001, 2007 and 2008 and leads the franchise with 146 managerial victories...His nephew Edgar also pitched for the team in 2004 and 2005...Alfonzo played for the Pittsfield Mets, of the New York-Penn League, in 1992 and hit .356 (106-298) with 41 runs scored, 13 doubles, five triples, one home run and 44 RBI in 74 games at just 18-years-old.

TAKE A WALK: The Cyclones drew six walks in last night's ballgame, compared to just five strikeouts. Brooklyn has struck out just 20 times in three games, and only 10 times in the last two games. The Cyclones' 20 strikeouts are the second-fewest in the league.

NEED FOR SPEED: The Cyclones currently lead the New York-Penn League with eight stolen bases through their first three games.

NEW ADDITION: RHP **Yeizo Campos** joined the Cyclones on Wednesday...He was assigned from the GCL Mets.

vs. VERMONT: The Cyclones are 60-27 all-time against the Vermont Lake Monsters including a 31-13 record at Centennial Field...The Cyclones went 3-0 in Vermont last season and are 13-4 in Burlington since 2012...From 2006 - 2008 the Cyclones went 9-0 in Vermont...At MCU Park the Cyclones are 29-14 against the Lake Monsters / Expos including 11-4 since 2012.

SOMETHING NEW: On Sunday, the Mets announced the signing of 20 recent draft picks... Of that bunch, RHP **Tony Dibrrell** (4th Round) RHP **Marcel Renteria** (6th Round), RHP **Connor O' Neil** (7th Round), RHP **Trey Cobb** (8th Round), RHP **Cannon Chadwick** (9th Round), INF **Dylan Snyper** (15th Round), and INF **Carl Stajduhar** (18th Round) joined the Cyclones following Tuesday's game.

VS. CANCER: The Cyclones and Hudson Valley Renegades will meet for Paw Patrol Night on Sunday for Kids Opening Day, presented by Nick Jr...As part of the festivities the team will wear special Marshall (The Fire Pup) Jerseys that will be auctioned off to benefit Vs. Cancer a foundation focused on raising funds in the fight against Pediatric Cancer... After the game, Cyclones General Manager Kevin Mahoney and Director of Communications will get their heads shaved on the field during a special dash for cash where fans will be encouraged to donate whatever they can in the fight for kids helping kids with cancer.

WIN THE LOTTERY: Last night, **Donovan Mitchell** was selected 13th overall in the NBA Draft by the Denver Nuggets and later traded to the Utah Jazz... Donovan served as a Brooklyn Cyclones bat boy in 2004 and 2005 when his father **Donovan Mitchell Sr.** was the team's hitting coach.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: Ramos will be making his first career start for the Cyclones after spending the last two seasons with the Kingsport Mets in the Appalachian League.

GETTING THE BALL: The right-hander spent time with both the St. Lucie Mets (A+) and Columbia Fireflies (A-) this season, appearing in 12 games, all in relief. This is Ramos' first start in 2017.

LIMITING LEFTIES: In 2016, Ramos limited left-handed hitters to just a .182 average in his 39 innings with the K-Mets.

STRUGGLING IN STARTS: In five starts last season with the Kingsport Mets, Ramos went 0-2 with a 8.38 ERA.

CONTROLLING THE GAME: In his career, Ramos has tallied 153 strikeouts and only 53 walks, giving him a strikeout-to-walk ratio of 2.88.

VENEZUELAN BORN: Ramos is one of three Venezuelan players on the 2017 Brooklyn Cyclones roster. The other two are INF Walter Rasquin (Caucagua, Venezuela) and C Carlos Sanchez (Distrito Zamora, Venezuela). Ramos is the only pitcher to hail from the South American country.
