## BROOKLYN CYCLONES (2-2) vs. HUDSON VALLEY RENEGADES (2-2)

**LAST NIGHT:** Vermont avoided the sweep, defeating the Cyclones 5-4 on Friday night in Burlington...Vermont starter Ivan Andueza retired the first 15 Cyclones batters in a row before the Cyclones were finally able to break through in the top of the sixth...Brooklyn scored two in the sixth and two in the ninth, with **Franklin Correa** leading the charge with a 2-for-4 effort...Pinche hitter **Jeremy Wolf** struck out with the tying run at second to end the game.

**HAPPY DAYS IN BK:** Manager **Edgardo Alfonzo** begins his first season as Cyclones manager after serving as a coach on **Tom Gamboa's** staff each of the last three seasons...Edgardo's brother Edgar managed the Cyclones in 2001, 2007 and 2008 and leads the franchise with 146 managerial victories...His nephew Edgar also pitched for the team in 2004 and 2005...Alfonzo played for the Pittsfield Mets, of the New York-Penn League, in 1992 and hit .356 (106-298) with 41 runs scored, 13 doubles, five triples, one home run and 44 RBI in 74 games at just 18-years-old.

**TAKE A WALK:** The Cyclones drew six walks in last night's ballgame, compared to just five strikeouts. Brooklyn has struck out just 20 times in three games, and only 10 times in the last two games. The Cyclones' 20 strikeouts are the second-fewest in the league.

**NEED FOR SPEED:** The Cyclones currently lead rank second in the New York-Penn League with eight stolen bases...Tri-City leads the way with nine.

**WE HARDLY KNEW YA:** RHP **Yeizo Campos** joined the Cyclones on Wednesday pitched on Thursday and was transferred to the GCL Mets last night.

**vs. HUDSON VALLEY:** The Cyclones are 92-70 all-time against the Hudson Valley Renegades...The teams split the 2016 series 6-6 with both teams going 3-3 at home and on the road...All-time Brooklyn is 52-30 at MCU Park and 40-40 at Dutchess Stadium...The two rivals have split the season series in each of the last three seasons and Hudson Valley has not won a season series since 2010.

**LET'S GET IT STARTED:** Brooklyn is batting .290 (9-31) to lead off an inning with four walks for a .389 on-base percentage to start a frame.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Cyclones have had six bases loaded opportunities this season and are batting .333 (2-6) in these spots...However, Brooklyn has grounded into three double plays with the bags full.

**VS. CANCER:** The Cyclones and Hudson Valley Renegades will meet for Paw Patrol Night on Sunday for Kids Opening Day, presented by Nick Jr...As part of the festivities the team will wear special Marshall (The Fire Pup) Jerseys that will be auctioned off to benefit Vs. Cancer a foundation focused on raising funds in the fight against Pediatric Cancer... After the game, Cyclones General Manager Kevin Mahoney and Director of Communications will get their heads shaved on the field during a special dash for cash where fans will be encouraged to donate whatever they can in the fight for kids helping kids with cancer.

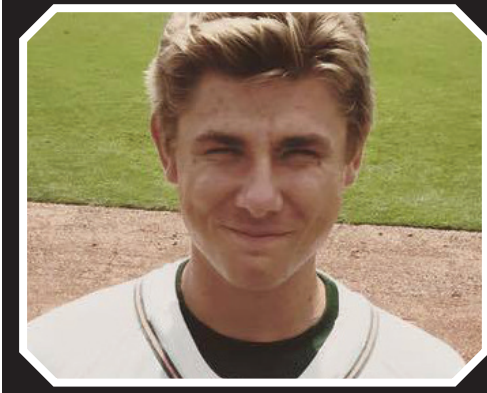

**BOOMER NOTES:** With Schaumburg this season, tossed 5.0 IP or more in six of his seven starts...Struck out 10 batters in two starts, May 31st at Traverese City and May 18th at Windy City...Opponents hit .203 against him this season.
