LAST NIGHT: The Hudson Valley Renegades powered past the Brooklyn Cyclones by the score of 10-4 at MCU Park...LHP **Gunnar Kines** (0-1) allowed six runs on 11 hits while striking out five in his Cyclones debut...The Renegades had seven extra-base hits including four home runs...Offensively 2B **Walter Rasquin** went 3-for-4 with a pair of RBI and OF **Jose M. Medina** went 3-for-4 with one run scored to pace the Brooklyn bats.

HAPPY DAYS IN BK: Manager **Edgardo Alfonzo** begins his first season as Cyclones manager after serving as a coach on **Tom Gamboa's** staff each of the last three seasons...Edgardo's brother Edgar managed the Cyclones in 2001, 2007 and 2008 and leads the franchise with 146 managerial victories...His nephew Edgar also pitched for the team in 2004 and 2005...Alfonzo played for the Pittsfield Mets, of the New York-Penn League, in 1992 and hit .356 (106-298) with 41 runs scored, 13 doubles, five triples, one home run and 44 RBI in 74 games at just 18-years-old.

POWER SURGE: Cyclones pitchers surrendered four home runs last night, matching the franchise record for home runs allowed, set in 2006 (June 20, 2016 @ Staten Island) and 2015 (August 30, 2015 @ Tri-City, L 13-4)...In 38 home games in 2016, Brooklyn pitchers surrendered just nine home runs all year.

RISP NO REWARD: The Cyclones are batting .196 (11-56) with runners in scoring position this season, including a 1-for-13 performance on Saturday...The .196 average ranks 12th in the 14-team NYPL with Connecticut batting .182 (8-44) and West Virginia batting .171 (7-41) in these situations.

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones are 92-71 all-time against the Hudson Valley Renegades...The teams split the 2016 series 6-6 with both teams going 3-3 at home and on the road...All-time Brooklyn is 52-31 at MCU Park and 40-40 at Dutchess Stadium...The two rivals have split the season series in each of the last three seasons and Hudson Valley has not won a season series since 2010.

SOLD OUT : Last night the Cyclones and Renegades played in front of 7,016 fans at MCU Park, the 309th sellout in franchise history...For Opening Day the Cyclones also had an above capacity crowd of 7,271...The last time Brooklyn opened the season with back-to-back sellouts since 2013...With a sellout crowd expected again on Sunday, it will mark the first time 2009 that the Cyclones will begin the season with three-consecutive sellouts.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Cyclones have had six bases loaded opportunities this season and are batting .285 (2-7) in these spots...However, Brooklyn has grounded into three double plays with the bags full.

VS. CANCER: The Cyclones and Hudson Valley Renegades will meet for Paw Patrol Night this afternoon for Kids Opening Day, presented by Nick Jr...As part of the festivities the team will wear special Marshall (The Fire Pup) Jerseys that will be auctioned off to benefit Vs. Cancer a foundation focused on raising funds in the fight against Pediatric Cancer...After the game, Cyclones General Manager Kevin Mahoney and Director of Communications will get their heads shaved on the field during a special dash for cash where fans will be encouraged to donate whatever they can in the fight for kids helping kids with cancer.

LAST TIME OUT: Made the Opening Day start for the Cyclones but did not factor in the decision...Struggled with his control early, issuing four walks, but limited the damage to just three runs on two hits.

START ME UP: Made two starts for Columbia of the South Atlantic League prior to joining the Cyclones...He went 1-1 with a 7.71 ERA, nine strikeouts, and six walks.

IN 2016: Made 12 starts last season with Kingsport (Rookie). Finished the season 2-5 with a 4.83 ERA. In 63.1 IP, he struck out 66 and walked 31.

AWESOME AWAY: Simon has yet to allow a run in an away game this season. He's thrown 8.1 scoreless innings on the road in 2017.

ALL-AMERICAN: 2017 is the second-straight season that a U.S. born pitcher will make the start in the Cyclones home opener, after California native Gabriel Llanes got the ball to start the 2016 season. RHP Gaby Almonte ('15), Octavio Acosta ('14) and John Gant ('13) have made the previous three home-opening starts.

SIGNED: Prior to signing with the Mets after being selected in the 11th round of the 2015 MLB Draft, Simon had committed to Rice University.

KEEPING IT 100: Simon has pitched 99.0 innings in his professional career, needing just one more inning-pitched to reach triple digits. He is six strike outs shy of 100 career Ks.
