LAST NIGHT: The Hudson Valley Renegades completed a three-game sweep of the Cyclones on Monday night with a 8-3 win at MCU Park...The Cyclones managed just three hits on the night, including just one extra base hit...LHP **Jose C. Medina** was the hard-luck loser, allowing just one earned run on five hits over 5.2 innings...SS **Leon Byrd** went 1-for-2 with a run scored and three walks to pace the Brooklyn offense.

PITCHERS WHO HIT: INF **Franklin Correa** tossed 1.2 innings of relief on Monday night...It marked the third time over the last two seasons that Correa has been called into duty as a pitcher...In the first 12 seasons in franchise history there were three occasions that position players called into pitch, over the last four seasons there have been 12 times that a fielder took the mound in relief.

RISP NO REWARD: The Cyclones are batting .182 (14-77) with runners in scoring position this season, including a 4-for-34 performance in the recently completed series with Hudson Valley...The .182 average ranks 12th in the 14-team NYPL behind Aberdeen (8-46) and West Virginia batting .143 (9-63) in these situations.

UNFRIENDLY CONFINES: Dating to August 23rd of last year, the Cyclones are 2-9 at MCU Park and have been out scored 58-39 over the span...This year, Brooklyn is 0-4 at home and is batting .158 (19-120) while being outscored 30-14.

LET'S GET IT STARTED: The Cyclones are batting .286 (14-49) to lead off an inning...That means that 29.1% (14-48) of their hits on the season have come from leadoff batters.

vs. ABERDEEN: The Cyclones 92-58 all-time against the Aberdeen IronBirds including 48-26 at Ripken Stadium...Brooklyn went 5-1 on the road last season and has lost the season series in Aberdeen just twice (2005 & 2013) since 2002...Brooklyn took the season series from Aberdeen in 2016 8-4...The Cyclones are 7-2 at Ripken Stadium over the last two seasons.

NEW IN TOWN: Cyclones Manager **Edgardo Alfonzo** will not be with the team this series while his son Danny graduates from Bayside High School...**Ryan Ellis**, the Short-Season Hitting Coordinator, will manage the team...Ellis last managed in 2011 with the Savannah Sand Gnats (SAL).

STUCK AT START: The 2-5 start to the season is tied with the 2016 Cyclones for the second worst start in franchise history...Brooklyn went 0-7 to start the 2006 season, but would go on to finish 41-33 and make the playoffs.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Cyclones have had 10 bases loaded opportunities this season and are batting .200 (2-10) in these spots...Brooklyn has grounded into four double plays with the bags full, with all four coming off the bat of C **Jose Maria**.

NEED FOR SPEED: The Cyclones currently rank second in the New York-Penn League with 12 stolen bases...Tri-City leads the league with 13 swipes...Brooklyn has been caught just three times...INF **Walter Rasquin** is currently tied for the league lead with three stolen bases.

PALO ALTO EAST: OF **Matt Winaker** (5th round) and OF **Quinn Brodey** (3rd Round) both from Stanford University have joined RHP **Chris Viall** and Hitting Coach **Sean Ratliff** as former Cardinal to suit up for the Cyclones this season.
