## BROOKLYN CYCLONES [2-7]

### at ABERDEEN IRONBIRDS [4-5]

**LAST NIGHT:** The Aberdeen IronBirds defeated the Cyclones by the score of 9-3 on Thursday night at Ripken Stadium...RHP **Darwin Ramos** (0-2) suffered the loss after allowing four runs, earned, on seven hits with two walks and seven strikeouts over 4.0 IP...Offensively, 1B **Matt Winaker** went 2-for-3 with a pair of walks to pace the bats.

**RISP NO REWARD:** The Cyclones are batting .183 (17-93) with runners in scoring position this season, including a 7-for-50 stretch over their last four games...The .182 average ranks 13th in the 14-team NYPL behind West Virginia batting .145 (12-83) in these situations.

**LOL: LOTS OF LOSSES:** The Cyclones currently have a six-game losing streak where they have been outscored 43-20 during the span...The longest losing streak in franchise history is nine games from August 26 - September 2, 2002...The team lost eight straight games from July 10 - July 18, 2014.

**UNFRIENDLY CONFINES:** Dating to August 23rd of last year, the Cyclones are 2-9 at MCU Park and have been out scored 58-39 over the span...This year, Brooklyn is 0-4 at home and is batting .158 (19-120) while being outscored 30-14.

**THE STRUGGLE IS REAL:** Brooklyn 3B **Carl Stajduahr** is also in an 0-for-14 slump to start his professional career.

**THE E IN CYCLONES:** The Cyclones rank 13th in the NYPL with a .945 fielding percentage...The team has been charged with 19 errors in 348 total chances...The team has also allowed four passed balls, third most in the NYPL.

**vs. ABERDEEN:** The Cyclones 92-60 all-time against the Aberdeen IronBirds including 48-28 at Ripken Stadium...Brooklyn went 5-1 on the road last season and has lost the season series in Aberdeen just twice (2005 & 2013) since 2002...Brooklyn took the season series from Aberdeen in 2016 8-4...The Cyclones are 7-4 at Ripken Stadium since 2015.

**TAKE THE FIFTH:** After last night's game, the Cyclones have been outscored 17-0 in the fifth inning of games this season...After the fifth inning, Brooklyn has been outscored 45-22.

**NEW IN TOWN:** Cyclones Manager **Edgardo Alfonzo** will not be with the team this series while his son Danny graduates from Bayside High School...**Ryan Ellis**, the Short-Season Hitting Coordinator, will manage the team...Ellis last managed in 2011 with the Savannah Sand Gnats (SAL).

**STUCK AT START:** The 2-7 start to the season is the second worst start in franchise history...Brooklyn went 1-8 to start the 2006 season, but would go on to finish 41-33 and make the playoffs.

**ROCK BOTTOM:** The Cyclones are hitting .203 (59-291) as a team, 12th in the New York-Penn League...The 33 runs scored are 12th in the league with West Virginia (31) and Tri-City (33) trailing...Brooklyn is also tied for last with one home run.

**NEED FOR SPEED:** The Cyclones are currently tied for the league lead with 17 stolen bases...Brooklyn has been caught just four times...OF **Jose Miguel Medina** leads the league with five stolen bases and INF **Walter Rasquin** is third with four stolen bases.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Kines made his Cyclones debut in front of a sold-out MCU Park crowd last week against the Hudson Valley Renegades. In six innings, he struck out five and walked none, but allowed six runs on 11 hits, including two home runs.

**WELCOME TO BROOKLYN:** Signed by the Mets as a Minor League Free Agent on Tuesday, June 20th.

**MR. INDEPENDENT:** Began the season with the Schaumburg Boomers of the Independent Frontier League... Was 5-1 with a 1.30 ERA in seven starts...Allowed just six runs, earned, in 41.1 IP while scattering 30 hits and 13 walks while striking out 53...Led the Frontier League in wins and ERA and ranked second in strikeouts at the time he signed.

**BOOMER NOTES:** With Schaumburg this season, tossed 5.0 IP or more in six of his seven starts...Struck out 10 batters in two starts, May 31st at Traverese City and May 18th at Windy City...Opponents hit .203 against him this season.

**CONTROL ARTIST:** Kines did not walk a batter in his first action with the Cyclones this season. In his most recent season in affiliated baseball (2015, GCL Marlins), Kines pitched 31.1 innings, striking out 28 batters and walking just one.

**SECOND CHANCE:** Originally selected in the 25th round of the 2015 MLB Draft by the Miami Marlins, the lefthander went 3-3 with a 1.77 ERA in 16 games, two starts with the GCL Marlins and Greensboro Grasshoppers (A-) of the SAL.
