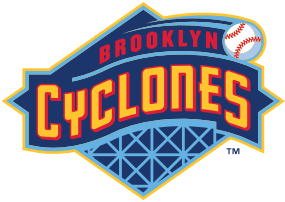

LAST GAME: Brooklyn dropped the middle game of three with the Tri-City ValleyCats by the score of 4-3 on Tuesday afternoon at MCU Park...RHP **Taylor Megill** (0-1) was tagged with the loss after allowing three runs, all earned, on three hits - including two home runs - over 3.2 innings.

RISP NO REWARD: The Cyclones are batting just .155 (7-45) with runners in scoring position over their last four games, including 4-for-18 during this series with the ValleyCats...For the season, the Cyclones are batting .251 (113-450) with RISP.

POWER SURGE: Brooklyn pitchers have allowed a New York-Penn League-leading 25 home runs this season...The 25 home runs allowed through 44 games are more than the Cyclones have allowed in five full seasons in franchise history...Cyclones pitchers have allowed 15 of the round-trippers here at MCU Park, just four shy of the record of 19 set in 2004 and tied in 2009.

B-SHARP: Brooklyn infielder **Brian Sharp** is batting .400 (12-30) over his last eight games, including five multi-hit contests, to raise his batting average from .214 to .275...Since July 17th, Sharp has hit safely in eight of nine games, but has also struck out 19 times...Sharp is hitting .650 (13-20) when he puts the ball in play over this recent hot stretch.

HIT THE ROAD JACK: Brooklyn is currently 10-11 at MCU Park and is the only team in the NYPL with a winning record that has a losing mark at home.

RETURN OF THE MAC: Tri-City's **Alex McKenna** is batting .400 (8-20) in five games against the Cyclones this season...The 20-year-old has four home runs and nine RBI as well...In 20 games against the rest of the NYPL, McKenna has no home runs and just seven RBI while batting .267 (19-71).

vs. TRI-CITY: The Cyclones are 48-44 all-time against the ValleyCats, including 24-20 at MCU Park...Brooklyn has already faced Tri-City in 2018, winning two of three games in mid-July in Troy, NY...The Cyclones have hosted the ValleyCats for a three-game set each of the last 13 seasons, winning that series nine times...Brooklyn hasn't won its season series with Tri-City since 2010, when the Cyclones went 4-2.

TURN THE PAGE: Brooklyn went 13-16 during the month of July despite outscoring their opponents 106-90...Cyclones pitchers pitched to a 2.68 ERA but allowed 20 home runs in 29 games during the month.

FRAZIER FRAZE: 3B **Todd Frazier** continues his MLB Rehab Assignment with the Cyclones this evening...He is just the 13th position player to rehab with Brooklyn since 2001...Frazier became the first big leaguer to hit a home run with the Cyclones when he did so in the 8th inning of yesterday's game.

IN THE NICK OF TIME: Brooklyn backstop **Nick Meyer** ranks sixth in the NYPL among qualifying catchers with a .219 (7-32) caught stealing percentage...Auburn's Israel Pineda leads the NYPL with a .381 (8-21) caught stealing percentage.

GET AHEAD: Brooklyn is 19-7 in games when they score the first run of the game.

STAY AHEAD: The Cyclones are 16-1 when leading after seven innings this season.

EARLY AND OFTEN: The Cyclones have outscored their opponents 54-36 (+18) over the first two innings of the game.

FOUR SCORE: Brooklyn is 19-5 in games when it scores four or more runs.

LAST TIME OUT: Tossed a career-high 3.2 scoreless innings in his first career start as a pro, scattering two hits and striking out five in a 12-4 win at Mahoning Valley on Thursday... Walked a career-high four batters.

HITTERS GO ON STRIKE: Walker has fanned 28% of the batters he's faced for his career, striking out 41 of 148 total batters faced...With Brooklyn, he's recorded a 38% K-rate, striking out 16 of 42 batters faced.

PROMOTION TIME: Walker began the season with rookie-level Kingsport, pitching three times in relief amassing nine scoreless innings...Earned a promotion to Brooklyn on July 5.

LAST SEASON: Pitched for the GCL Mets in first professional season, going 2-1 with a 9.42 ERA in 14 relief appearances...allowed seven runs on July 3 at GCL Cards and six on September 2 vs. GCL Astros...Outside of those two outings, sported a 1.35 earned run average.

SCHOOL DAYS: Selected in the 37th round of the 2017 draft out of the University of New Haven in Connecticut...19th player in school history to be drafted and the 28th to go pro...Went 3-1 with three saves and 2.40 ERA for the Blue and Gold...Struck out 32 batters in 30 innings, making 20 appearances as a senior...Spent two seasons at the University of South Florida, pitching seven times in relief in his first season.

- Removing the bullpen's five earned runs allowed July 18 at Tri-City, the relievers have combined for 19 ER in 82.1 IP (2.08 ERA) over 25 of the past 26 games.
- RHP Yeudy Colon has a team-low 0.51 ERA, having allowed one earned run over 17.2 IP. Colon snapped his team-long 14-inning scoreless streak Friday, the longest for a Cyclones reliever this season.
- RHP Ryley Gilliam has not allowed an earned run in six innings and six appearances as a professional.
- RHP Billy Oxford has recorded five victories (all in relief outings), tied with Cyclones RHP Jaison Vilera and MV's Luis Santos for most wins in the NYPL.
