YESTERDAY: RHP **Christian James** (3-1) tossed 7.0 shutout frames and INF **Carlos Cortes** had a pair of RBI as Brooklyn defeated Connecticut 2-0 on Thursday night at MCU Park.

WHAT'S IN A NAME: The Cyclones will take the field as the Brooklyn Jefes for this series with the Tigers as part of MiLB's "Copa da la Diversion"...It marks the third name change this season (Brooklyn Bagels and Brooklyn Seinclones) and sixth time in franchise history that the Cyclones have taken the field with a different moniker joining the Brooklyn Cyclones, Coney Island Franks and Brooklyn Slices...Brooklyn has gone 6-1 so far in games with a name other than the Cyclones.

LA COPA: The Cyclones will play as the Jefes for this three game series with the Connecticut Tigers as part of MiLB's Copa de la Diversion...The Copa consists of 33 teams across the country who are participating at every level from A through AAA...It is a season-long initiative specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with the local Latino communities...The Cyclones are the only team in the New York-Penn League participating in "The Copa" for 2018.

BIG FLIES, BIG WOES: Brooklyn pitchers have allowed a NYPL-leading 31 home runs this season...The 31 home runs allowed through 53 games are more than the Cyclones have allowed in five full seasons in franchise history, and are the most by a Cyclones team since 2010 when the team surrendered 31 long balls...The all-time record for home runs allowed is 41, set in 2004.

CORTES IS CLICKING: Brooklyn INF **Carlos Cortes** has hit safely in eight straight home games and is batting .406 (13-32) over the span...Overall, Cortes has hit safely in nine straight games and since July 19th is batting .333 (24-72) which is 12th best in the NYPL over that span.

vs. CONNECTICUT The Cyclones are 28-25 all-time against the Connecticut Tigers, the affiliate of the Detroit Tigers...Brooklyn swept the Tigers in a three-game set June 21-23 at Dodd Stadium earlier this season...Brooklyn is 5-0 against the Tigers this season marking just the second time that they will win the season series against CT...In 2010, they went 4-2 against the Tigers...Brooklyn plays the Tigers four more times this season.

SHUT IT DOWN: Last night marked the seventh time this season that the Cyclones have collected a shutout win, which ranks second in the NYPL behind Hudson Valley (8)...The record for shutouts in a season is 11, set by the 2003 Cyclones.

HOW SWEEP IT IS: The Cyclones will look to complete their second series sweep of the season tonight, with their previous one also coming against the Tigers, at Dodd Stadium, from June 21 -23.

RISP IT FOR THE BISCUIT: INF **Carlos Cortes** is batting .406 (13-32) with runners in scoring position...DH **Walter Rasquin** is hitting .385 (10-26).

RAKING RASQUIN: INF **Walter Rasquin** began his 2018 stint with Brooklyn going 7-36 (.194) over his first nine games...Since July 22nd, the 22-year-old is batting .412 (21-51) over 15 games which is third best in the NYPL...Rasquin has eight multi-hit games over this span.

SIX MAKE ALL-STAR TEAM: Six Cyclones, including three position players and three pitchers, have made the 2018 NY-Penn League All-Star Game: IF **Carlos Cortes**, OF **Ross Adolph**, OF **Wagner LAGRANGE**, RHP **Jaison Vilera**, RHP **Billy Oxford**, and RHP **Yeudy Colon**...The game will take place at State College's Medlar Field at Lubrano Park on Tuesday, August 14 at 7:05 p.m.

Allowed a season-low four baserunners on three singles and one walk...Only once allowed a runner to reach scoring position.

LAST SEASON: Spent his first professional season with the GCL Mets, going 1-1 with a 1.50 ERA in seven appearances...Made two starts and five relief appearances, striking out 19 batters in 18.0 innings.

CROWDER COLLEGE: Wilson played his collegiate ball at Crowder College in Missouri, leading his team to a NJCAA World Series in 2017...Posted a 3-1 record and 2.27 ERA that season for the Roughriders.

HIGH SCHOOL DRAFTEE: The Minnesota Twins selected Wilson in the 19th round of the 2015 draft out of Raymore-Peculiar High School before maintaining his college commitment.

MORE ON RAYMORE: Wilson grew up in Raymore, Missouri, a town of more than 20,000 people...According to the city's 2015 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report, the Raymore-Peculiar School District employees the most people in town (344). Rounding out the top 10 employers in Raymore are Golden Corral (#9, 80 employees) and Minsky's Pizza (#10, 26).

LIKE LEO: Wilson's favorite movie is Shutter Island starring Leonardo DiCaprio, the actor Wilson believes would play him in a movie about his life.

- RHP Yeudy Colon has suffered consecutive losses for the first time this season...Allowed go-ahead run to score on wild pitch in 10th inning 8/3 vs. Aberdeen and the winning run to score on a balk in the 9th inning Sunday at Hudson Valley...Did not allow an earned run over 15 outings before Sunday's blown save.
- RHP Ryley Gilliam allowed his first two pro runs on Monday, yielding a home run to Hudson Valley's Ford Proctor...Was also his second inning of work.
- RHP Billy Oxford has recorded five victories (all in relief outings), tied with Cyclones RHP Jaison Vilera and four others for the most wins in the NYPL.
