FRIDAY: RHP **Kyle Wilson** struck out 10 over 5.0 near-perfect innings and INF **Carlos Cortes** had four RBI as Brooklyn completed a three-game sweep of the Tigers thanks to a 9-2 win

BIG FLIES, BIG WOES: Brooklyn pitchers have allowed a NYPL-leading 32 home runs this season...The 32 home runs allowed through 54 games are more than the Cyclones have allowed in seven full seasons in franchise history...The all-time record for home runs allowed is 44, set last season.

CORTES IS CLICKING: Brooklyn INF **Carlos Cortes** has hit safely in 10 straight games dating to July 30th...The former South Carolina Gamecock is batting .400 (16-40) over this span with 12 RBI and five extra base hits...OF **Jose Medina** had an 11 game hitting streak to start the year, the longest by a Cyclone this season.

RISP IT FOR THE BISCUIT: INF **Carlos Cortes** is batting .441 (15-34) with runners in scoring position...DH **Walter Rasquin** is hitting .357 (10-28).

RAKING RASQUIN: INF **Walter Rasquin** began his 2018 stint with Brooklyn going 7-36 (.194) over his first nine games...Since July 22nd, the 22-year-old is batting .400 (22-55) over 16 games which is third best in the NYPL...Rasquin has eight multi-hit games over this span and has hit safely in 14 of 16 games over this span....Rasquin currently has an eight game winning streak where he is batting .429 (12-28).

SIX MAKE ALL-STAR TEAM: Six Cyclones, including three position players and three pitchers, have made the 2018 NY-Penn League All-Star Game: IF **Carlos Cortes**, OF **Ross Adolph**, OF **Wagner La-grange**, RHP **Jaison Vilera**, RHP **Billy Oxford**, and RHP **Yeady Colon**...The game will take place at State College's Medlar Field at Lubrano Park on Tuesday, August 14 at 7:05 p.m.

vs. LOWELL: The Cyclones have won four of six games against the Boston Red Sox affiliated Lowell Spinners this season, with all of the games coming at MCU Park...OF **Ross Adolph** has six hits in four games, hitting .375 with a double and a triple and two stolen bases...The offense has hit just .220 against Lowell, while the arms have combined for a 3.29 ERA.

J-ACE-ON: RHP **Jaison Vilera** will take the mound for Brooklyn today....Currently the 21-year-old righthander leads the NYPL in ERA and strikeouts and is tied for the league lead with five wins...He is trying to become just the second pitcher since 2001 to win the pitching triple crown, joining former Cyclone RHP **Marcos Molina** who accomplished the feat in 2014...Vilera is 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA in two starts against Lowell this season, tossing 11.2 shut-out innings, scattering just seven hits.

CHANDLER DING: INF **Chandler Avant** connected on his first home run as a professional Friday...The former Alabama Crimson Tide is batting .333 (7-21) over his last eight games.

IT GETS LATE EARLY: The Cyclones are currently 22-5 when they have the lead after six innings.

GET AHEAD / STAY AHEAD: Brooklyn has scored first in 23 of their 54 games this season, tied with Auburn for the most in the league...The Cyclones are 23-11 when scoring first.

WIDE LOAD: Friday was Brooklyn's league leading 16th win by 3 + runs...Brooklyn is 7-12 in one run games and 5-5 in games decided by two runs.

GREAT IN MONTH 8: The Cyclones currently rank second in the NYPL with a .288 (95-33) batting average during the month of August.

LAST TIME OUT: Allowed a first-inning run against Hudson Valley, snapping his scoreless streak at 29.1 consecutive innings...Yielded a season-high four earned runs in his shortest outing since June 30, throwing just 76 pitches.

ERA LEADER: Vilera has the lowest ERA in the NYPL, posting a 1.43 ERA...Had a league-best 0.78 ERA heading into his most recent start at Hudson Valley before allowing four earned runs over 4.1 IP.

TRIPLE CROWN: Currently the 21-year-old righthander leads the NYPL in ERA (1.43) and strikeouts (63) and is tied for the league lead with five wins...He is trying to become just the second pitcher since 2001 to win the pitching triple crown, joining former Cyclone RHP **Marcos Molina** who accomplished the feat in 2014.

VS. LOWELL: Vilera is 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA in two starts against Lowell this season, tossing 11.2 shutout innings, scattering just seven hits.

STAY HUMBLE, SIT DOWN: Vilera ranks among NYPL leaders in wins (T1st, 5), opp. batting average (1st, .164), strikeouts/nine among starters (2nd, 11.26/9), WHIP (2nd, 0.87), strikeouts (1st, 63), and fewest baserunners/9 among starters (3rd, 8.76).

SUFFOCATING: Has allowed three hits with runners in scoring position...Opposing batters are 3-for 30 (.100).

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: Was promoted from the Kingsport Mets (R) on July 30...Joins Josh Walker, Anthony Dirocie, Hayden Senger, and Andrew Mitchell as current Cyclones who were on Kingsport’s 2018 Opening Day roster.

LEADING THE WAY: Led the K-Mets in wins (3), ERA (1.93), innings pitched (32.2), and WHIP (1.16) at the time of his call-up...Tied for the team lead in starts (6) and ranked second in strikeouts (32)... Among qualifiers, led the Appalachian League in both ERA and WHIP.

LEFT ON BASE: Led all Appalachian League qualifiers in Left on Base Percentage, having stranded 92.4 percent of the runners who have reached base on him this season.

I’M THE WINNER: Collected a victory in each of his last three outings with Kingsport, two of which were quality starts.

NEW TO THE U.S.A.: The Venezuelan-born pitcher is making his stateside debut in 2018 after spending all of 2017 in the Dominican Summer League...With the DSL Mets2, went 1-1 with a save and a 1.44 ERA last year...Tossed 50 innings over 15 appearances (8 starts), allowing just 8 earned runs and striking out 41 batters.
