LAST NIGHT: Brooklyn extended its season-long winning streak to six games with a bottom of the 10th inning, come-from-behind win over Vermont 2-1...Trailing 1-0, Brooklyn scored two runs on the a throwing error by Vermont third baseman Jonah Bride, scoring Anthony Dirocie and Nick Meyer for the Cyclones' second walk-off win of the season.

GOING STREAKING: The Cyclones are in the midst of their longest winning streak of the season, having won six straight games...The starting staff has not allowed an earned run over the past five starts, striking out 25 and walking just six.

BIG FLIES, BIG WOES: Brooklyn pitchers have allowed a NYPL-leading 32 home runs this season...The 32 home runs allowed through 57 games are more than the Cyclones have allowed in 12 full seasons in franchise history...The all-time record for home runs allowed is 44, set last season.

CORTES IS CLICKING: INF **Carlos Cortes** has .308 in August (12-39) with two doubles, two home runs, and 10 RBIs...The third-round draft selection out of South Carolina has been solid in the field, committing just one error in his past 11 games.

RAKING RASQUIN: INF **Walter Rasquin** began his 2018 stint with Brooklyn by going 7-36 (.194) over his first nine games...Since July 22nd, the 22-year-old is batting .355 (22-62) over 18 games, which is third-best in the NYPL during that stretch...Over this span, Rasquin has eight multi-hit games and has hit safely in 14 of 18 games.

IT GETS LATE EARLY: The Cyclones are currently 24-2 when they have the lead after seven innings.

GET AHEAD / STAY AHEAD: Brooklyn has scored first in 36 of their 57 games this season, the most in the league...The Cyclones are 25-11 when scoring first.

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones meet the Renegades for the second time this month, trailing the season series with a 2-4 record against Hudson Valley...Brooklyn lost to Hudson Valley on three consecutive walk offs between Aug. 5-7...The Cyclones have a .307 team batting average versus Hudson Valley, with home runs from Chase Chambers and Carlos Cortes...The arms have a 5.60 ERA.

THE NEED FOR SPEED: The Cyclones stole seven bases Wednesday, tied for the second-most in franchise history...The record is eight steals, set on August 2, 2017...It marked the third time in franchise history that the team has stolen seven bags in a game...The seven steals in a game are tied with Vermont and West Virginia for the most by any team in the NYPL this season.

FORGET THE RED PEN: Brooklyn has committed just 45 errors in 57 games, tied for fewest in the league with Auburn, and good for a league-best .978 fielding percentage...Vermont leads the league with 81 errors, including two last night in the 10th against Brooklyn.

IN THE NICK OF TIME: C **Nick Meyer** currently ranks second in the NYPL with a .319 (15-47) caught stealing percentage...Vermont C Jose Rivas leads the NYPL with a .356 (16-45) percentage...As a team, Brooklyn ranks second in the league with 28 caught stealing, behind only Mahoning Valley with 30 caught stealing.

ROAD KILL: Brooklyn is currently enjoying a .264 team batting average away from MCU Park, with seven players hitting better than .280...**Chase Chambers** leads the way, hitting .353 (30-85), while **Wagner Lagrange** is 27-87 (.310)...**Brian Sharp**, **Ross Adolph**, **Anthony Dirocie**, **Walter Rasquin**, and **Carlos Cortes** all have marks better than .280.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his first victory since his second outing on June 22 at Connecticut...Beat the Tigers with 5 2/3 innings of two-run ball, striking out seven...The most strikeouts since his second start.

ON TOP IN JUNE: Posted a 2.19 ERA in June, winning two of three starts...Struck out 11 in 12.1 innings, yielding just eight hits for an opponents batting average of .182...collected wins against Staten Island and Connecticut.

JUST NOT HIS JULY: Lost four of his five July starts (and five of his last seven overall), recording a 6.43 ERA over the month...Allowed 15 earned runs on 28 hits in 21.0 innings for an opponents' batting average of .329.

PULL NO PUNCHES: Batters have pulled 54.6% of the pitches put in play, hitting 23.5% to the opposite field and 21.9% center...Opposing batters have hit 25.0% of balls in play as line drives, the highest of Campusano's career.

DON'T WALK AWAY FROM ME: For his career, the Dominican-born righthander has a 7.2% walk rate, having allowed just 57 walks of 782 total batters faced in 186.2 career innings...Did walk a career-high five batters in his July 28 start at West Virginia.

DOWN FROM ABOVE: Made four starts this season prior to the start of the Cyclones season, pitching three times for Class-A Columbia and once with Advanced-A St. Lucie...Compiled a 1-1 record and a 3.55 ERA with Columbia...Pitched for Advanced-A St. Lucie on April 22, taking the loss...Allowed one run on two hits over four innings, strikout out four and walking three.

LAST SEASON: Went 2-6 with a 2.89 ERA over 13 games and nine starts covering four levels...Pltched for the GCL Mets, Kingsport, Brooklyn, and St. Lucie...Tossed a season-high 33.0 innings for the GCL Mets, going 2-3 with a 3.27 ERA over seven games and four starts.
