## BROOKLYN CYCLONES (33-26) vs. HUDSON VALLEY RENEGADES (34-25)

**LAST NIGHT:** For the fourth time in five games, the Cyclones suffered a walk-off loss at Dutchess Stadium in 2018, dropping a 4-3 decision in eight-innings...**Ryley Gilliam** and **Yeudy Colon** allowed late runs in relief as Brooklyn blew a 3-1 lead...The Cyclones won the first game of the series, beating Hudson Valley 9-2 in the completion of a suspended game from Friday night.

**ROSS IS BOSS:** OF **Ross Adolph** has blasted three home runs over the first two games of the series, including his first multi-homer game as a professional in game two...Adolph earned NYPL All-Star Game MVP honors Tuesday at State College, blasting a home run and collecting a triple.

**STREAK SNAPPED:** The Cyclones snapped their seven-game winning streak last night...Since August 4, Brooklyn is 7-0 against the league and 1-4 against Hudson Valley.

**START ME UP:** Brooklyn's starting staff has enjoyed a terrific stretch...Over the past eight starts, the arms have yielded four earned runs in 41.2 innings, good for a 0.86 ERA and a 4-0 record.

**CORTES IS CLICKING:** INF **Carlos Cortes** has .333 in August (16-48) with three doubles, two home runs, and 11 RBIs...The third-round draft selection out of South Carolina has been solid in the field, committing just one error in his past 12 games.

**RAKING RASQUIN:** INF **Walter Rasquin** began his 2018 stint with Brooklyn by going 7-36 (.194) over his first nine games...Since July 22nd, the 22-year-old is batting .358 (24-67) over 19 games, which is third-best in the NYPL during that stretch...Over this span, Rasquin has nine multi-hit games and has hit safely in 15 of 19 games.

**IT GETS LATE EARLY:** The Cyclones are currently 25-2 when they have the lead after seven innings.

**vs. HUDSON VALLEY:** The Cyclones meet the Renegades for the second time this month, trailing the season series with a 3-5 record against Hudson Valley...Brooklyn has lost to Hudson Valley on four walk offs in five contests at Dutchess Stadium...The Cyclones have a .301 team batting average versus Hudson Valley, with three home runs from Ross Adolph and one each for Chase Chambers and Carlos Cortes...The arms have a 4.78 ERA.

**GET AHEAD / STAY AHEAD:** Brooklyn has scored first in 38 of their 59 games this season, the most in the league...The Cyclones are 26-12 when scoring first.

**THE NEED FOR SPEED:** The Cyclones stole seven bases Wednesday against Vermont, tied for the second-most in franchise history...The record is eight steals, set on August 2, 2017...It marked the third time in franchise history that the team has stolen seven bags in a game...The seven steals in a game are tied with Vermont and West Virginia for the most by any team in the NYPL this season.

**FORGET THE RED PEN:** Brooklyn has committed just 47 errors in 59 games, tied for fewest in the league with Staten Island, and good for a league-best .978 fielding percentage...Vermont leads the league with 83 errors.

**IN THE NICK OF TIME:** C **Nick Meyer** currently ranks second in the NYPL with a .319 (15-47) caught stealing percentage...Vermont C Jose Rivas leads the NYPL with a .356 (16-45) percentage...As a team, Brooklyn ranks second in the league with 28 caught stealing, behind only Mahoning Valley with 30 caught stealing.

**ROAD KILL:** Brooklyn is currently enjoying a .264

**CROWDER COLLEGE:** Wilson played his collegiate ball at Crowder College in Missouri, leading his team to a NJCAA World Series in 2017...Posted a 3-1 record and 2.27 ERA that season for the Roughriders.

**HIGH SCHOOL DRAFTEE:** The Minnesota Twins selected Wilson in the 19th round of the 2015 draft out of Raymore-Peculiar High School before maintaining his college commitment.

**MORE ON RAYMORE:** Wilson grew up in Raymore, Missouri, a town of more than 20,000 people...According to the city’s 2015 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report, the Raymore-Peculiar School District employees the most people in town (344). Rounding out the top 10 employers in Raymore are Golden Corral (#9, 80 employees) and Minsky’s Pizza (#10, 26).

**LIKE LEO:** Wilson’s favorite movie is Shutter Island starring Leonardo DiCaprio, the actor Wilson believes would play him in a movie about his life.
