WHAT HAPPENED LAST NIGHT?: The Cyclones won the finale of a three-game set with the Tri-City Valley Cats by the score of 3-2 on Wednesday night...OF **Anthony Dirocie** hit a three-run home run in the sixth to provide all the offense Brooklyn would need...RHP **Trent Johnson** (1-1) got the win in relief for Brooklyn with 2.0 shutout innings of relief, and RHP **Yeudy Colon** tossed a scoreless ninth for his third save of the year.

I'M STILL ST(r)ANDING: The Cyclones are batting just .154 (8-52) with runners in scoring position over their last five games, including 5-for-25 during their series with the ValleyCats...For the season, the Cyclones are batting .249 (114-457) with RISP.

NO GOOD IN GOODBYE: Brooklyn pitchers have allowed a New York-Penn League-leading 26 home runs this season...The 26 home runs allowed through 45 games are more than the Cyclones have allowed in five full seasons in franchise history...Cyclones pitchers have allowed 16 of the round-trippers here at MCU Park, just three shy of the record of 19 set in 2004 and tied in 2009.

THE POWER OF (g)LOVE: The Cyclones currently rank second in the NYPL with a .976 fielding percentage...Brooklyn has just 39 errors in 1642 total chances.

HIT THE ROAD JACK: Brooklyn is currently 11-11 at MCU Park and is the only team in the NYPL with a winning record overall that doesn't have a winning record at home.

GIMME THREE STEPS: Brooklyn currently ranks second in the NYPL with 17 triples on the season...Lowell leads the way with 20...The 17 triples are the most by a Brooklyn team since 2014, when they hit 19...The team record for three-baggers is 37, set in 2010...They were led by OF **Darrell Ceciliani**, who hit a single-season-record 12 triples that year.

vs. ABERDEEN The Cyclones are 96-72 all-time against the Aberdeen IronBirds, including 2-4 against them this season...Brooklyn was swept during a three game set in Brooklyn in early July, but took two of three from Aberdeen at Ripken Stadium from July 11-13...INF **Chandler Avant** is batting .462 (6-13) against the 'Birds, and Brooklyn pitchers have struck out 57 batters in 53.0 innings against Aberdeen.

FEELS LIKE THE FIRST TIME: Brooklyn is 19-7 in games when they score the first run of the game.

NEVER GONNA GIVE YOU UP: The Cyclones are 18-1 when leading after seven innings this season.

IT TAKES TWO: The Cyclones have outscored their opponents 54-38 (+16) over the first two innings of the game.

YOU'RE THE ONE FOUR ME: Brooklyn is 19-5 in games when it scores four or more runs.

DON'T ASK MY Y: RHP **Yeizo Campos** has been transferred to Brooklyn from Columbia (A) of the South Atlantic League...He will wear #11 and is active for tonight's game...In 14 games (five starts) with the Fireflies, he was 1-3 with a 3.33 ERA...In nine relief outings, he pitched to a 1.84 ERA over 29.1 innings on the mound...Campos made one appearance with Brooklyn in 2017, tossing 3.2 innings of relief on June 22nd at Vermont - allowing two earned runs on six hits with six strikeouts.

I SAW THE SEIN: On Saturday, the Cyclones will host their 5th Annual Seinfeld Night...The promotion, which was named MiLB's Promotion of the Year in 2014, has drawn fans from 40 states and 6 different countries over the years...This year, Brooklyn will become the Seinclones, with the first 2,000 fans getting a Keith Hernandez Talking Alarm Clock.

LAST TIME OUT: Threw 5.2 innings of three-run ball, allowing six hits and a career-high five walks in a 5-2 loss at West Virginia on Saturday...Allowed at least one baserunner in every frame...Tossed 104 pitches, the most for a Cyclones pitcher this season.

ON TOP IN JUNE: Posted a 2.19 ERA in June, winning two of three starts...Struck out 11 in 12.1 innings, yielding just eight hits for an opponents batting average of .182...collected wins against Staten Island and Connecticut.

JUST NOT HIS JULY: Lost four of his five July starts (and five of his last six overall), recording a 6.43 ERA over the month...Allowed 15 earned runs on 28 hits in 21.0 innings for an opponents' batting average of .329.

PULL NO PUNCHES: Batters have pulled 56.9% of the pitches put in play, hitting 21.6% to the opposite field and 21.6% center...Opposing batters have hit 28.3% of balls in play as line drives, the highest of Campusano's career.

DON'T WALK AWAY FROM ME: For his career, the Dominican-born righthander has a 7.3% walk rate, having allowed just 54 walks of 740 total batters faced in 176.2 career innings...Did walk a career-high five batters in his last start.

DOWN FROM ABOVE: Made four starts this season prior to the start of the Cyclones season, pitching three times for Class-A Columbia and once with Advanced-A St. Lucie...Compiled a 1-1 record and a 3.55 ERA with Columbia...Pitched for Advanced-A St. Lucie on April 22, taking the loss...Allowed one run on two hits over four innings, strikout out four and walking three.

LAST SEASON: Went 2-6 with a 2.89 ERA over 13 games and nine starts covering four levels...Pltched for the GCL Mets, Kingsport, Brooklyn, and St. Lucie...Tossed a season-high 33.0 innings for the GCL Mets, going 2-3 with a 3.27 ERA over seven games and four starts.
