LAST NIGHT: The Cyclone banged out a season-high 19 hits on Sunday en route to a 10-2 win over the Hudson Valley Renegades...INF **Dylan Tice** went 3-for-4 with three runs scored and two RBI while INF **Brian Sharp** went 2-for-5 with a home run and three RBI...RHP **Kyle Wilson** (3-3) tossed 5.0 solid frames, allowing just one earned run on five hits while striking out six.

HIGH WATER: The Cyclones come into today's game 34-26, eight games over .500...It marks the highpoint for Brooklyn since the final game of the 2014 season when the Cyclones finished the year 42-34.

START ME UP: Brooklyn's starting staff has enjoyed a terrific stretch...Over the past nine starts, the arms have yielded five earned runs in 46.2 innings, good for a 0.96 ERA and a 5-0 record.

CORTES IS CLICKING: INF **Carlos Cortes** has .358 in August (19-53) with three doubles, two home runs, and 12 RBIs...The third-round draft selection out of South Carolina is seventh in the New York-Penn League during the month.

RAKING RASQUIN: INF **Walter Rasquin** began his 2018 stint with Brooklyn by going 7-36 (.194) over his first nine games...Since July 22nd, the 22-year-old is batting .361 (26-72) over 20 games, which is third-best in the NYPL during that stretch...Over this span, Rasquin has 10 multi-hit games and has hit safely in 16 of 20 games.

IT GETS LATE EARLY: The Cyclones are currently 26-2 when they have the lead after seven innings.

GET AHEAD / STAY AHEAD: Brooklyn has scored first in 39 of their 60 games this season, the most in the league...The Cyclones are 27-12 when scoring first...Brooklyn has outscored their opponents 82-43 in the first two innings of a game.

vs. TRI-CITY: The Cyclones are 3-3 against Tri-City this season including 2-1 at Bruno Stadium...Brooklyn has outscored Tri-City 29-24...Brooklyn is 49-44 all-time against the ValleyCats including 24-24 at Bruno Stadium...This season **Alex McKenna** hit .409 (9-22) with five home runs and 11 RBI in six games against Brooklyn...The rest of the ValleyCats team is batting just .201 (36-179) against Brooklyn.

B SHARP: Cyclones infielder **Brian Sharp** currently has a 22-game on base streak dating to July 17th...It is the third longest streak in the New York-Penn League this season...Sharp is batting .308 (24-78) with a .385 on-base percentage.

FEELING HOT HOT HOT: C **Hayden Senger** is batting .421 (8-19) with five runs scored and six RBI over his last five games...SS **Manny Rodriguez** is batting .346 (9-26) over his last seven games.

ICE ICE BABY: 1B **Chase Chambers** is batting .219 (7-32) during the month of August to lower his batting average from .291 to .277...C **Nick Meyer** is 6-for-44 (.136) since July 25th...INF **Angel Manzanarez** is 1-for-20 since July 22nd.

FIVE & DIME: Brooklyn is batting .284 (94-331) over their last ten games and have scored 59 runs over the span...The Cyclones lead the NYPL with a .262 team average and leads the league with 287 runs.

ROAD WARRIORS: Brooklyn is currently batting .272 (282-1037) on the road...1B **Chase Chambers** is batting .348 (32-92) on the road and .198 (16-81) at MCU Park...2B **Carlos Cortes** is hitting .324 (24-74) on the road and .254 (16-63) at home...OF **Ross Adolph** is hitting .299 (29-97) on the road with seven triples and five home runs...Adolph has no home runs and just two triples at home while batting .231 (18-78).

LAST TIME OUT: Tossed five scoreless innings at Lowell on the Sunday prior to the All-Star break, lowering his ERA to 1.30 in the no-decision...Did not strike out a batter for the first time in his career, allowing four hits and a walk...Has not allowed a run in 16.2 innings to the Spinners, covering three starts.

ERA LEADER: Vilera has the lowest ERA in the NYPL, posting a 1.30 ERA...Had a league-best 0.78 ERA heading into his start at Hudson Valley before allowing four earned runs over 4.1 IP.

TRIPLE CROWN: Currently the 21-year-old righthander leads the NYPL in ERA (1.43) and strikeouts (63) and is second in the league with five wins...He is trying to become just the second pitcher since 2001 to win the pitching triple crown, joining former Cyclone RHP **Marcos Molina** who accomplished the feat in 2014.

VS. TRI-CITY: Spun seven shutout innings on July 17 in the second of four consecutive scoreless starts in his 291-inning scoreless streak.

STAY HUMBLE, SIT DOWN: Vilera ranks among NYPL leaders in ERA (1st, 1.30), strikeouts (1st, 63), winning percentage (1st, .833), opponents average (1st, .169), wins (2nd, five), WHIP (2nd, 0.89), strikeouts per nine (2nd, 10.25), and fewest baserunners (3rd, 8.78).

SUFFOCATING: Has allowed three hits with runners in scoring position...Opposing batters are 3-for 37 (.081).
