LAST NIGHT: Behind a 16-hit attack, the Cyclones topped the Tigers of Connecticut 10-3 on Star Wars Night...INF **Walter Rasquin**, IF **Chase Chambers**, and OF **Anthony Dirocie** collected three hits apiece in the rubber game victory...RHP **Kyle Wilson** earned his fourth consecutive triumph.

THREE'S COMPANY: OF **Ross Adolph** currently leads the NYPL with 11 triples this season...The last player in the NYPL with more than 11 triples was Cyclones OF **Darrell Ceciliani**, who had a franchise-record 12 triples in 2010...Since 2001, when the Cyclones entered the New York-Penn League, the only other player with more triples than Adolph was **Reid Gorecki** (13) of the New Jersey Cardinals in 2002.

IT GETS LATE EARLY: The Cyclones are currently 28-2 when they have the lead after seven innings.

POWER SURGE: Cyclones pitchers have allowed a New York-Penn League leading 36 home runs this season...Brooklyn allowed a franchise-record 44 home runs last season...The 36 home runs allowed rank third in franchise history...Brooklyn has allowed 21 home runs in 32 games at MCU Park.

GET AHEAD / STAY AHEAD: Brooklyn has scored first in 43 of their 65 games this season, the most in the league...The Cyclones are 29-14 when scoring first...Brooklyn has outscored their opponents 93-53 in the first two innings of a game.

B SHARP: Cyclones infielder **Brian Sharp** currently has a 26-game on base streak dating to July 17th...It is the second-longest streak in the New York-Penn League this season...Sharp is batting .293 (27-92) with a .374 on-base percentage over that span.

JUST JAISON: Tonight's starter, Jaison Vilera, owns a league-best 1.59 ERA, ranking among the league's best in strikeouts (66).

vs. VERMONT: The Cyclones have won three of the five meetings with Vermont, including a recent two-game sweep of the Oakland affiliate at MCU Park August 16-17...A total of 59 combined runs have been scored across the season series...Chase Chambers is hitting .400 (8-20) against Vermont, while Manny Rodriguez has six hits in four games (6-17, .353)...Brooklyn's pitching staff has posted a 4.50 ERA.

GETTING WAGGY WITH IT: OF **Wagner Lagrange** is batting .321 (9-28) over his last nine games and .385 (5-13) over his last five games...Lagrange is one of only four players in the NYPL with 200 plate appearances and no home runs.

DEFENSE NEVER RESTS: The Cyclones currently lead the New York-Penn League with a .978 fielding percentage...The team has just 51 errors in 2,406 chances, also fewest in the league.

TICE TICE BABY: INF **Dylan Tice** has hit safely in seven of eight games since joining the Cyclones, batting .379 (11-29) with a .500 on-base percentage...Tice is on a six-game hitting streak, has reached base safely in each of his eight games, and has scored a run in six of the eight games.

ROSS IS THE BOSS: OF **Ross Adolph** is batting .366 (26-71) in the first three innings of a game with five triples, four home runs and 16 RBI.

A CASE OF THE RUNS: Brooklyn currently leads the New York-Penn League with 322 runs scored this season...The team has scored 153 runs at home (4.6 per game) and 169 runs on the road (5.1 /game).

LAST TIME OUT: Pitched seven innings for the first time in August, allowing three runs on six hits in a no-decision at Tri-City...Has not earned a victory in three straight.

ERA LEADER: Vilera has the lowest ERA in the NYPL, posting a 1.59 ERA...Had a league-best 0.78 ERA heading into his start at Hudson Valley before allowing four earned runs over 4.1 IP.

TRIPLE CROWN: Currently the 21-year-old righthander leads the NYPL in ERA (1.59) and strikeouts (66) and is second in the league with five wins...He is trying to become just the second pitcher since 2001 to win the pitching triple crown, joining former Cyclone RHP **Marcos Molina** who accomplished the feat in 2014.

STAY HUMBLE, SIT DOWN: Vilera ranks among NYPL leaders in ERA (1st, 1.30), strikeouts (1st, 63), winning percentage (1st, .833), opponents average (1st, .177), wins (2nd, five), WHIP (1st, 0.90), strikeouts per nine (1st, 9.53), and fewest baserunners (1st, 8.81).

SUFFOCATING: Has allowed three hits with runners in scoring position...Opposing batters are 6-for-43 (.140).

KEEP IT IN THE PARK: Has only conceded four home runs in 181.0 career innings.
