LAST NIGHT: The Lake Monsters made it two in a row against Brooklyn with a 9-3 win on Monday night in Burlington...RHP **Jose Butto** (1-2) allowed three runs, earned, on four hits and was tagged with the loss...OF **Ross Adolph** continued swinging his hot bat with a 3-for-5 effort, including a home run and two RBI.

THREE'S COMPANY: OF **Ross Adolph** currently leads the NYPL with 11 triples this season...The last player in the NYPL with more than 11 triples was Cyclones OF **Darrell Ceciliani**, who had a franchise-record 12 triples in 2010...Since 2001, when the Cyclones entered the New York-Penn League, the only other player with more triples than Adolph was **Reid Gorecki** (13) of the New Jersey Cardinals in 2002.

NO RISP, NO REWARD: Brooklyn is for 4-for-36 with RISP during the current series with the Lake Monsters...For the season, SS **Manny Rodriguez** is batting just .172 (11-64) with RISP with 32 strikeouts...As a team, Brooklyn has struck out 196 times in 715 at-bats (27.4%) with RISP.

POWER SURGE: Cyclones pitchers have allowed a New York-Penn League leading 39 home runs this season...Brooklyn allowed a franchise-record 44 home runs last season...The 39 home runs allowed rank third in franchise history (41 - 2004, 44 - 2017).

B SHARP: Cyclones infielder **Brian Sharp** currently has a 28-game on base streak dating to July 17th...It is the second-longest streak in the New York-Penn League this season...Sharp is batting .289 (28-97) with a .393 on-base percentage over that span.

EARLY RISER: OF **Ross Adolph** is batting .387 (29-75) in the first three innings of a game with five triples, six home runs and 19 RBI...From the fourth inning on, Adolph is batting .230 (31-135), including just .138 (9-65) from the 7th inning on.

vs. VERMONT: The Cyclones are 3-4 against Vermont this season, including a recent two-game sweep of the Oakland affiliate at MCU Park August 16-17...A total of 90 combined runs have been scored across the season series...Chase Chambers is hitting .345 (10-29) against Vermont, while Manny Rodriguez has nine hits in six games (9-27, .333)...Brooklyn's pitching staff has posted a 4.43 ERA.

ROSS IS BOSS: Since August 10, OF **Ross Adolph** is batting .355 (22-62) with 20 runs scored, 11 extra-base hits and 47 total bases, both of which are tops in the NYPL...Adolph has 47 total bases and the next closest batter has 34 total bases. (Ben Pelletier - Williamsport).

MEYER & ICE: Since July 25th C **Nick Meyer** is batting .131 (8-61) and is hitless 16 of 19 over the stretch...OF **Anthony Dirocie** is batting .194 (20-103) since July 20th with 31 k's in 29 games.

GET AHEAD: Brooklyn has scored first in 45 of 68 games this season and is 29-16 in these contests...The Cyclones have outscored their opponents 99-55 in the first two innings of games.

A CASE OF THE RUNS: Brooklyn currently leads the New York-Penn League with 334 runs scored this season...Cyclones pitchers rank second in the NYPL with just 214 runs allowed

ROAD WOES: The Cyclones are 3-9 on the road during the month of August with five of their nine losses coming in walk off fashion.

SECOND START: Tylor Megill makes his second professional start today and first since July 31 vs. Tri-City.

LAST TIME OUT: Allowed two earned runs over a career-high-tying four innings of five-hit ball in a relief appearance loss at Tri-City.

STRIKEOUTS GALORE: Megill has fanned 30 of the 97 batters he's faced which is good for a 31% strikeout rate and 11.74 per nine innings...Struck out a career-high eight batters on August 16 against Vermont at MCU Park in relief.

TEAM WEST COAST: Selected by the Mets in the 8th round of the 2018 draft out of the University of Arizona...Pitched for two seasons for the Wildcats, working as their closer in his final year on campus and leading the team with six saves.

BEFORE 'ZONA: Began his college career in his home state of California, pitching at Loyola Marymount...Made 16 appearances and seven starts, going 6-3 with a 3.95 ERA in 57.0 innings...Attended Cypress Community College in his second college season, working mostly as a starting pitcher...Went 11-3 with a 3.72 ERA in 16 starts and one relief appearance.

FAMILY MATTERS: His brother, Trevor, was drafted by the San Diego Padres and pitches for the San Antonio Missions, the Double-A affiliate in the Texas League...Tylor played with Trevor during his freshman season at Loyola Marymount.
