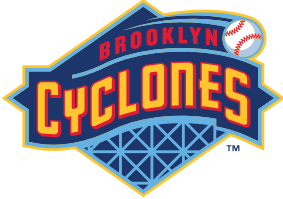

WHAT HAPPENED LAST NIGHT?: Brooklyn exploded for 12 runs in the first three innings to take a 12-1 lead, and never looked back as they defeated Aberdeen 13-6 on Thursday night...OF **Wagner Lagra** went 2-for-4 with a pair of runs scored and three RBI while DH **Walter Rasquin** added a 2-for-4 effort with three RBI and SS **Manny Rodriguez** hit his first pro HR and plated a pair as well.

NO GOOD IN GOODBYE: Brooklyn pitchers have allowed a New York-Penn League-leading 26 home runs this season...The 26 home runs allowed through 46 games are more than the Cyclones have allowed in five full seasons in franchise history...Cyclones pitchers have allowed 16 of the round-trippers here at MCU Park, just three shy of the record of 19 set in 2004 and tied in 2009.

WHAT'S g(LOVE) GOT TO DO WITH IT: The Cyclones are currently in a four way tie for the best fielding percentage in the New York-Penn League... Brooklyn, Hudson Valley, Staten Island and Williamsport are all tied with a .977 pct.

GIMME THREE STEPS: Brooklyn currently ranks second in the NYPL with 17 triples on the season... Lowell leads the way with 20...The 17 triples are the most by a Brooklyn team since 2014, when they hit 19...The team record for three-baggers is 37, set in 2010...They were led by OF **Darrell Ceciliani**, who hit a single-season-record 12 triples that year.

NEVER GONNA GIVE YOU UP: The Cyclones are 19-1 when leading after seven innings this season.

IT TAKES TWO: The Cyclones have outscored their opponents 63-39 (+24) over the first two innings of the game.

THE MAGIC NUMBER: Brooklyn is 20-5 in games when it scores four or more runs.

vs. ABERDEEN The Cyclones are 97-72 all-time against the Aberdeen IronBirds, including 3-4 against them this season...Brooklyn was swept during a three game set in Brooklyn in early July, but took two of three from Aberdeen at Ripken Stadium from July 11-13...INF **Chandler Avant** is batting .462 (6-13) against the 'Birds, and Brooklyn pitchers have struck out 64 batters in 62.0 innings against Aberdeen.

HE'S HEATING UP: INF **Carlos Cortes** is batting .306 (11-36) over his last nine games and since July 19th has hit safely in 10 of 12 games and reached base safely in 11 of 12 to raise his average from .175 to .261.

HE'S ON FIRE: INF **Walter Rasquin** began his time with Brooklyn going 7-for-36 (.194) over his first nine games but over his last nine games is batting .387 (12-31) including five multi-hit games.

BOOMSHAKALAKA: SS **Manny Rodriguez** hit his first professional home run last night, in his 100th at-bat as a pro...The 10th round pick from Cincinnati had 12 round trippers with the Bearcats this year.

SUMMER CAMP(os): RHP **Yeizo Campos** has been transferred to Brooklyn from Columbia (A) of the South Atlantic League...He will wear #11 and is active for tonight's game...In 14 games (five starts) with the Fireflies, he was 1-3 with a 3.33 ERA...In nine relief outings, he pitched to a 1.84 ERA over 29.1 innings on the mound.

SEINFELD NIGHT: On Saturday, the Cyclones will host their 5th Annual Seinfeld Night...The promotion, which was named MiLB's Promotion of the Year in 2014, has drawn fans from 40 states and 6 different countries over the years...This year, Brooklyn will become the Seinclones, with the first 2,000 fans getting a Keith Hernandez Talking Alarm Clock.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his first loss in a rain-shortened 1-0 loss at Mahoning Valley...Allowed one unearned run on five hits, striking out three...Tossed a season-low 69 pitches.

LEFT/RIGHT: With Brooklyn, has held left-handed batters to just a .203 average (12-59), but RHB are hitting .298 (28-94) off of him.

BEFORE BROOKLYN: Made two starts this season at higher levels before joining the Cyclones...Pitched with St. Lucie (A+) of the Florida State League on June 2nd vs. Fort Myers...Tossed 5.0 innings, allowed one run on one hit while striking out five....Took a no-decision in a game that Fort Myers won 3-1...Also made a spot start with Binghamton (AA) of the Eastern League on May 27th vs. Bowie...Was tagged with the loss, but allowed just one run on three hits over 4.0 innings with one walk and four strikeouts.

BASEBALL AMERICA: The publication named James New York's 30th-best prospect in their 2018 handbook.

LAST SEASON: Went 2-3 with a 4.18 ERA in 11 games, all starts, with the Kingsport Mets (R) of the Appy League...Allowed one earned run or less in six of 11 starts...Began the season with a 0.74 ERA through his first five starts, allowing just four runs, two earned, over 24.1 innings on the mound.

K TURN: Struck out 58 batters in 51.0 innings with the K-Mets last season...Including three games in which he struck out nine batters, which established and tied his career high.

- Removing the bullpen's five earned runs allowed July 18 at Tri-City, the relievers have combined for 21 ER in 91.0 IP (2.08 ERA) over 27 of the past 28 games.
- RHP Yeudy Colon has a team-low 0.48 ERA, having allowed one earned run over 18.2 IP. Colon snapped his team-long 14-inning scoreless streak Friday, the longest for a Cyclones reliever this season.
- RHP Ryley Gilliam has not allowed an earned run in seven innings over seven appearances as a professional.
- RHP Billy Oxford has recorded five victories (all in relief outings), tied with Cyclones RHP Jaison Vilera and MV's Luis Santos for most wins in the NYPL.
