## BROOKLYN CYCLONES (38-32) vs. HUDSON VALLEY RENEGADES (41-29)

**LAST NIGHT:** The Cyclones scored first and never trailed, defeating the Renegades 4-2 on Wednesday night at MCU Park...OF **Anthony Dirocie** launched a two-run home run, his second with Brooklyn, to cap a three-run second inning...OF **Wagner Lagrange** went 2-3 with a 2B, a 3B, and two runs...Four relievers (Oxford, Smith, Mitchell, and Zabaleta) combined for 5.1 scoreless innings.

**THREE'S COMPANY:** OF **Ross Adolph** currently leads the NYPL with 11 triples this season...The last player in the NYPL with more than 11 triples was Cyclones OF **Darrell Ceciliani**, who had a franchise-record 12 triples in 2010...Since 2001, when Brooklyn entered the NYPL, the only other player with more triples than Adolph was **Reid Gorecki** (13) of the New Jersey Cardinals in 2002.

**POWER SURGE:** Cyclones pitchers have allowed a New York-Penn League leading 39 home runs this season...Brooklyn allowed a franchise-record 44 home runs last season...The 39 home runs allowed rank third in franchise history (41 - 2004, 44 - 2017).

**A HOME RUN A DAY:** The Cyclones have hit a home run in four straight games for the first time this season...OF **Anthony Dirocie** hit a two-run HR last night for Brooklyn's sixth dinger in four games...OF **Ross Adolph** led off Sunday's and Monday's games at Vermont with a home run.

**B SHARP:** Cyclones infielder **Brian Sharp** currently has a 29-game on base streak dating to July 17th...It is the second-longest streak in the New York-Penn League this season...Sharp is batting .287 (29-101) with a .393 on-base percentage over that span.

**EARLY RISER:** OF **Ross Adolph** is batting .367 (29-79) in the first three innings of a game with five triples, six home runs and 19 RBI...From the fourth inning on, Adolph is batting .223 (31-139), including just .136 (9-66) from the 7th inning on.

**vs. HUDSON VALLEY:** The Cyclones and Renegades have split the season series 5-5...All five losses for Brooklyn have come in the Renegades' last turn at-bat, including four walk-off losses at Dutchess Stadium...Brooklyn has outscored Hudson Valley 67-49 in their ten games...INF **Carlos Cortes** is batting .400 (12-30) against the 'Gades...OF **Ross Adolph** has seven extra-base hits in ten games against Hudson Valley.

**TO ERR IS HUMAN:** Brooklyn did not commit an error last night for the first time in four games...During the series with the Lake Monsters, the Cyclones committed 11 errors in three games, including two games with a season-high four errors...Prior to the that series in Vermont, Brooklyn had been charged with 51 errors in 66 games.

**ROSS IS BOSS:** Since August 10, OF **Ross Adolph** is batting .314 (22-70) with 21 runs, 11 extra-base hits, and 47 total bases...The next closest batter over that span has 37 total bases (Adam Hall, Aberdeen).

**IN THE NICK OF TIME:** Cyclones catcher **Nick Meyer** ranks third in the NYPL with a .310 (18-58) caught stealing percentage...As a team, Brooklyn is third in the NYPL with a .314 (32-102) caught stealing rate.

**GET AHEAD:** Brooklyn has scored first in 47 of 70 games this season and is 31-16 in those contests...The Cyclones have outscored their opponents 104-55 in the first two innings of games.

**HOME COOKING:** Brooklyn is 11-2 at MCU Park since the start of August, outscoring teams 82-39.

**A CASE OF THE RUNS:** Brooklyn currently leads the New York-Penn League with 346 runs scored this season...Hudson Valley currently ranks third with 317 runs scored...Cyclones pitchers rank second in the NYPL with just 270 runs allowed.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Tossed the best start of his pro career, working a career-high eight shutout innings in Brooklyn's 12-1 win over Connecticut on Friday...Allowed just two hits for the second straight game and did not concede a walk for the third time this season... Struck out four batters in his third-straight quality start.

**LEADERBOARD:** James' 1.76 ERA ranks second on the NYPL leaderboard, behind only fellow Cyclone Jaison Vilera's 1.72 ERA...Has allowed two earned runs or fewer in 11 of 12 starts.

**AWESOME AUGUST:** Owns a 2-0 record with a 1.01 ERA and 0.83 WHIP in August...Has allowed just three earned runs over 26.2 innings with 16 strikeouts in four August starts...Opposing batters are hitting just .167 (15-for-90) against him this month.

**BEFORE BROOKLYN:** Made two starts this season at higher levels before joining the Cyclones...Pitched with St. Lucie (A+) on June 2nd vs. Fort Myers...Tossed 5.0 innings, allowed one run on one hit while striking out five....Took a no-decision in a game that Fort Myers won 3-1...Also made a spot start with Binghamton (AA) on May 27th vs. Bowie...Was tagged with the loss, but allowed just one run on three hits over 4.0 innings with one walk and four strikeouts.

**BASEBALL AMERICA:** The publication named James New York's 30th-best prospect in their 2018 handbook.

**LAST SEASON:** Went 2-3 with a 4.18 ERA in 11 starts, with the Kingsport Mets (R) of the Appy League...Allowed one earned run or less in six of 11 starts...Began the season with a 0.74 ERA through his first five starts, allowing just four runs (two earned) over 24.1 innings.

**SCHOOL DAYS:** Was selected in the 14th round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of East Lake HS...Went 9-2 with a 1.29 ERA and 98 strikeouts in 71.0 innings during his senior year...Committed to FIU before signing with the Mets.
