## BROOKLYN CYCLONES (25-22) vs. ABERDEEN IRONBIRDS (19-26)

**THE FIX-UP:** Down 4-2 into the eighth inning, the Cyclones rallied to tie the game before falling 5-4 in 10 innings to the Aberdeen Ironbirds in the middle game of a three-game set...3B **Brian Sharp** and DH **Walter Rasquin** combined for RBI hits in the eighth before a wild pitch by reliever **Yeudy Colon** allowed the go-ahead run to cross in the 10th... Brooklyn lost its second extra-innings contest of the season, both of which were at MCU Park.

**"THAT'S THE PILOT":** After his flight from Columbia (A) was delayed Thursday night, RHP **Yeizo Campos** will have his 2018 debut with Brooklyn tonight against Aberdeen...Campos comes down from Columbia (A)...In 14 games (five starts) with the Fireflies, he was 1-3 with a 3.33 ERA...In nine relief outings, he pitched to a 1.84 ERA over 29.1 innings on the mound.

**I WAS IN THE POOL:** LHP **Andrew Mitchell**, one of the Mets' draft selections from this year's draft pool, earned a promotion from Kingsport (R) and joined the Cyclones today...In 10 games with the K-Mets, the 14th-rounder from Auburn posted a 0.75 ERA, striking out 16 and walking three over 12.0 innings.

**THE "BILLY":** RHP **Billy Oxford** lowered his ERA to 1.86 with 2.1 scoreless innings of relief last night for the Cyclones...For his career, Oxford has a 2.56 earned run average, which has been lowered thanks to his 29 innings of six-earned-run ball in 16 games with Brooklyn this season.

**A PRETTY BIG MATZO BALL:** Brooklyn pitchers have allowed a New York-Penn League-leading 27 home runs this season...The 27 home runs allowed through 47 games are more than the Cyclones have allowed in five full seasons in franchise history...Cyclones pitchers have allowed 17 of the round-trippers here at MCU Park, just three shy of the record of 19 set in 2004 and tied in 2009.

**vs. ABERDEEN** The Cyclones are 97-73 all-time against the Aberdeen IronBirds, including 3-5 against them this season...Brooklyn was swept during a three game set in Brooklyn in early July, but took two of three from Aberdeen at Ripken Stadium from July 11-13...INF **Chandler Avant** is batting .429 (6-14) against the 'Birds, and Brooklyn pitchers have struck out 69 batters in 71.0 innings against Aberdeen.

**SIDELER:** With two wins over the past three nights and losses in three straight by Hudson Valley, the Cyclones have closed the gap from 5.5 games to 3.5 games for the McNamara Division lead...The Regades and Cyclones will meet nine times before the end of August.

**THESE TRIPLES ARE MAKING ME THIRSTY:** Brooklyn currently ranks tied for second in the NYPL with 17 triples with Auburn...Lowell leads the way with 20...The 17 triples are the most by a Brooklyn team since 2014, when they hit 19...The team record for three-baggers is 37, set in 2010...They were led by OF **Darrell Ceciliani**, who hit a single-season-record 12 triples that year.

**HOW ABOUT THE NAME SEVEN?:** The Cyclones are 19-1 when leading after seven innings this season.

**DOUBLE-DIP:** The Cyclones have outscored their opponents 65-39 (+26) over the first two innings of the game.

**AFTER FOUR, "IT'S IN THE VAULT":** Brooklyn is 20-6 in games when it scores four or more runs.

**SEINCLONES:** Tonight, Seinfeld Night Part V is celebrated at MCU Park, including appearances from Kenny Bania, aka Steve Hytner, and Jean Paul, aka Jeremiah Birkett.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Struck out a career-high nine batters over 4.2 innings of relief work for the Columbia Fireflies (A) but was tagged for the loss in a 2-1 defeat to Augusta on Friday, July 27...Allowed two unearned runs on four hits and a career-high-tying four walks.

**DOWN FROM ABOVE:** Has spent the entire season with Class-A Columbia, going 1-3 with a save and a 3.33 ERA over 14 appearances (5 starts)...Allowed 19 earned runs over 51.1 innings...Struck out 50 batters to just 15 walks for a 3.3:1 K/BB ratio.

**A FAMILIAR FACE:** Made one appearance with Brooklyn last year, making a long relief appearance in a June 22 game at Vermont... Threw 3.2 innings, allowing two runs on six hits with six strikeouts...It was his first career outing in the U.S., having started the season on the GCL Mets roster but not yet made an appearance.

**SHUTDOWN START:** Opened the 2018 season by throwing a career-high 13.1 consecutive innings of scoreless baseball over a hot streak that stretched into his sixth appearance...After his first five outings (all relief), owned a 0.67 WHIP and a .135 batting average against.

**STARTER/RELIEVER:** Has split time in the rotation and in the bullpen this season, compiling much better numbers out of the 'pen... In nine relief outings, is 0-2 with a 1.84 ERA and a 1.09 WHIP, having allowed just six earned runs over 29.1 innings with 29 strikeouts...In five starts, is 1-1 with a 5.32 ERA and a 1.50 WHIP, conceding 13 earned runs in 22 innings with 21 strikeouts.

- Removing the bullpen's five earned runs allowed July 18 at Tri-City, the relievers have combined for 21 ER in 95.1 IP (1.98 ERA) over 28 of the past 29 games.
- RHP Yeudy Colon has a team-low 0.48 ERA, having allowed one earned run over 18.2 IP. Colon snapped his team-long 14-inning scoreless streak Friday, the longest for a Cyclones reliever this season.
- RHP Ryley Gilliam has not allowed an earned run in seven innings over seven appearances as a professional.
- RHP Billy Oxford has recorded five victories (all in relief outings), tied with Cyclones RHP Jaison Vilera and three others for most wins in the NYPL.
