YESTERDAY: In a back-and-forth contest that featured several late-inning lead changes, the Cyclones broke a 3-3 tie with Ross Adolph's sac fly in the seventh for a 4-3 win and series victory over the Aberdeen Ironbirds in the finale of a three-game series at MCU Park...Carlos Cortes chipped in with an RBI double, while Ryley Gilliam secured his third pro save.

AGAINST THE TOP DOGS: Brooklyn meets the Hudson Valley Renegades for the first of a three-game set and the first of nine head-to-head contests this month... Entering Sunday, the Renegades have a 2.5-game lead over Brooklyn in the McNamara Division...The Cyclones have beaten Hudson Valley in two out of three already, with the series victory coming at MCU Park.

JUST JAISON: Today, league-ERA leader Jaison Vilera makes his ninth start of the season, sporting a 0.78 earned run average over the first eight starts...The Venezuelan righty has not allowed a run in 28.2 consecutive innings...Vilera's opening start came against Hudson Valley on June 18 in Brooklyn...He lasted just four innings, allowing one earned run on two hits and three walks with six strikeouts.

NEW ADDITION: LHP Andrew Mitchell, one of the Mets' draft selections from this year's draft pool, earned a promotion from Kingsport (R) and joined the Cyclones today...In 10 games with the K-Mets, the 14th-rounder from Auburn posted a 0.75 ERA, striking out 16 and walking three over 12.0 innings.

BEING BILLY: RHP Billy Oxford lowered his ERA to 1.86 with 2.1 scoreless innings of relief last night for the Cyclones...For his career, Oxford has a 2.56 earned run average, which has been lowered thanks to his 29 innings of six-earned-run ball in 16 games with Brooklyn this season.

BIG FLIES, BIG WOES: Brooklyn pitchers have allowed a New York-Penn League-leading 28 home runs this

vs. HUDSON VALLEY The Cyclones are 94-80 all-time against Hudson Valley despite going 0-9 against the Renegades in 2017...Brooklyn took two of three from the Renegades earlier in the season, winning 9-7 and 7-5, before an 8-7 loss in 10 innings...The Cyclones as a team hit .330 in the series (37-112), getting big leadership from Jose Brizuela...Though Brizuela has been promoted to Columbia (A), he hit .417 (5-12) with two home runs en route to the series victory.

season...The 28 home runs allowed through 48 games are more than the Cyclones have allowed in five full seasons in franchise history...Cyclones pitchers have allowed 18 of the round-trippers here at MCU Park, just one shy of the record of 19 set in 2004 and tied in 2009.

GETTING CLOSER: With three wins over the past four nights and losses in five straight by Hudson Valley, the Cyclones have closed the gap from 5.5 games to 2.5 games for the McNamara Division lead...The Renegades and Cyclones will meet nine times before the end of August.

THESE TRIPLES ARE MAKING ME THIRSTY: Brooklyn currently ranks tied for second in the NYPL with 17 triples with Auburn...Lowell leads the way with 20...The 17 triples are the most by a Brooklyn team since 2014, when they hit 19...The team record for three-baggers is 37, set in 2010...They were led by OF Darrell Ceciliani, who hit a single-season-record 12 triples that year.

HOW ABOUT THE NAME SEVEN?: The Cyclones are 20-1 when leading after seven innings this season.

DOUBLE-DIP: The Cyclones have outscored their opponents 65-39 (+26) over the first two innings of the game.


AFTER FOUR, "IT'S IN THE VAULT": Brooklyn is 21-6 in games when it scores four or more runs.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his fourth consecutive victory, firing seven-scoreless innings in a 7-1 victory at West Virginia... Extended his scoreless streak to 28.2 innings over five starts.

ERA LEADER: Vilera has the lowest ERA in the NYPL, posting a 0.78 ERA...Has not allowed an earned run since July 5, going 28.2 consecutive scoreless innings.

STAY HUMBLE, SIT DOWN: Vilera ranks among NYPL leaders in wins (T1st, 5), opp. batting average (1st, .150), strikeouts/nine among starters (2nd, 11.08/9), WHIP (T2nd, 0.83), strikeouts (3rd, 56), and fewest baserunners/9 among starters (2nd, 8.22).

SUFFOCATING: Has allowed one hit with runners in scoring position...Opposing batters are 1-for 25 (.040).

KEEP IT IN THE PARK: Has only conceded four home runs in 165.0 career innings.

LAST SEASON: Went 3-1 with a 1.88 ERA over 11 appearances and eight starts for the GCL Mets, earning the 2017 GCL Mets Sterling Award...Was also named a GCL Postseason All-Star.

GCL DOMINANCE: Vilera led the GCL in strikeouts (56), innings pitched (62.1), strikeouts per nine innings among starters (7.74), and fewest baserunners per nine innings (9.0).

.Also ranked second in WHIP (0.96) and batting average against (.195).

• Removing the bullpen’s five earned runs allowed July 18 at Tri-City, the relievers have combined for 21 ER in 97.2 IP (1.94 ERA) over 29 of the past 30 games.

• RHP Yeudy Colon has a team-low 0.48 ERA, having allowed one earned run over 18.2 IP. Colon snapped his team-long 14-inning scoreless streak last Friday at West Virginia, the longest for a Cyclones reliever this season.

• RHP Ryley Gilliam has not allowed an earned run in eight innings over eight appearances as a professional.

• RHP Billy Oxford has recorded five victories (all in relief outings), tied with Cyclones RHP Jaison Vilera and three others for most wins in the NYPL.
