## BROOKLYN JEFES (26-25)

### vs. CONNECTICUT TIGERS (23-24)

**YESTERDAY:** For the third consecutive night, the Hudson Valley Renegades earned a walk-off win against the Cyclones to sweep the series with a 5-4 win Tuesday night...Trailing 4-2, Brooklyn tied the game on a Hudson Valley error and **Brian Sharp's** sac fly...Brooklyn hit .280 in the series, scoring 14 runs over the three games.

**LOS BROOKLYN JEFES:** The Cyclones transform into "Los Jefes" for this three-game set against Connecticut, taking part in Minor League Baseball's Copa La Diversion..."Jefes" translates directly to "Bosses"...Wednesday, Brooklyn celebrated Mexican Heritage Night, Thursday, Dominican Heritage Night, and Friday, Puerto Rican Hurricane Relief Night.

**8TH WONDER:** There have been 1,329 games in Cyclones history, Monday night's walk-off loss marked just the 21st time that Brooklyn has been leading after eight innings, and lost the game...It is the third time this season that Brooklyn has lost a game when leading after eight with all three losses coming at the hands of the Renegades.

**BIG FLIES, BIG WOES:** Brooklyn pitchers have allowed a NYPL-leading 30 home runs this season...The 30 home runs allowed through 51 games are more than the Cyclones have allowed in five full seasons in franchise history, and are the most by a Cyclones team since 2010 when the team surrendered 31 long balls...The all-time record for home runs allowed is 41, set in 2004.

**SIX MAKE ALL-STAR TEAM:** Six Cyclones, including three position players and three pitchers, have made the 2018 NY-Penn League All-Star Game: IF **Carlos Cortes**, OF **Ross Adolph**, OF **Wagner Lagrange**, RHP **Jaison Vilera**, RHP **Billy Oxford**, and RHP **Yeudy Colon**...The game will take place at State College's Medlar Field at Lubrano Park on Tuesday, August 14 at 7:05 p.m.

**vs. CONNECTICUT** The Cyclones are 26-25 all-time against the Connecticut Tigers, the affiliate of the Detroit Tigers...Brooklyn swept the Tigers in a three-game set June 21-23 at Dodd Stadium earlier this season...The Cyclones hit .283 (32-113) with a home run from Chase Chambers...the pitching staff posted a 1.67 ERA, yielding five earned runs in 27 innings for the first sweep of the season.

**IN THE NICK OF TIME:** C **Nick Meyer** ranks third in the NYPL with a .308 caught stealing percentage...Meyer has thrown out 12-39 would-be base stealers...Meyer is one of only four catchers in the league with double digit caught-stealing: **Rafael Marchan** (WPT) - 16, **Jose Rivas** (VMT)- 13, and **Chris Betts** (HV) - 10.

**DIDN'T I HEAR ABOUT A BALK?:** **Yeudy Colon's** ninth-inning balk on Sunday at Hudson Valley is the second such game-ending balk by a Brooklyn pitcher in recent memory...July 15, 2015, **Carlos Valdez** balked in the winning run at Staten Island in even more peculiar fashion...With runners on the corners in a 2-2 tie in the 10th inning, Valdez balked in the middle of an intentional walk of **Drew Bridges**.

**KNOCK THREE TIMES:** Brooklyn currently ranks third in the NYPL with 19 triples...OF **Ross Adolph** has a team-leading seven...Auburn (22) and Lowell (21) lead the way...The 19 triples are tied for the most by a Brooklyn team since 2014...The team record for three-baggers is 37, set in 2010...They were led by OF **Darrell Ceciliani**, who hit a single-season-record 12 triples that year.

**ROAD MASHERS:** **Chase Chambers** and **Carlos Cortes** each blasted home runs Sunday...The pair has combined to hit all five of their homers on the road...BKLYN has eight homers at home & 11 away.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Fell two outs shy of earning his first win since June, allowing four runs on seven hits over 4.1 innings in the Cyclones' blowout 13-6 win over Aberdeen on Thursday...Walked one and struck out two in his first start in August.

**ON TOP IN JUNE:** Posted a 2.19 ERA in June, winning two of three starts...Struck out 11 in 12.1 innings, yielding just eight hits for an opponents batting average of .182...collected wins against Staten Island and Connecticut.

**JUST NOT HIS JULY:** Lost four of his five July starts (and five of his last seven overall), recording a 6.43 ERA over the month...Allowed 15 earned runs on 28 hits in 21.0 innings for an opponents' batting average of .329.

**PULL NO PUNCHES:** Batters have pulled 54.6% of the pitches put in play, hitting 23.5% to the opposite field and 21.9% center...Opposing batters have hit 25.0% of balls in play as line drives, the highest of Campusano's career.

**DON'T WALK AWAY FROM ME:** For his career, the Dominican-born righthander has a 7.2% walk rate, having allowed just 55 walks of 759 total batters faced in 181.0 career innings...Did walk a career-high five batters in his July 28 start at West Virginia.

**DOWN FROM ABOVE:** Made four starts this season prior to the start of the Cyclones season, pitching three times for Class-A Columbia and once with Advanced-A St. Lucie...Compiled a 1-1 record and a 3.55 ERA with Columbia...Pitched for Advanced-A St. Lucie on April 22, taking the loss...Allowed one run on two hits over four innings, strikout out four and walking three.

**LAST SEASON:** Went 2-6 with a 2.89 ERA over 13 games and nine starts covering four levels...Pltched for the GCL Mets, Kingsport, Brooklyn, and St. Lucie...Tossed a season-high 33.0 innings for the GCL Mets, going 2-3 with a 3.27 ERA over seven games and four starts.
