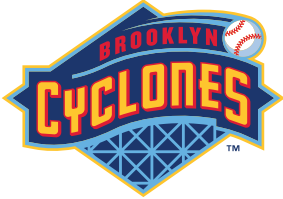

LAST GAME: The Cyclones dropped the rubber match of a three-game series with the Vermont Lake Monsters by the score of 7-3 on Saturday night in Burlington...Cyclones pitchers walked eight batters, including three from RHP **Tylor McGill** in his pro debut...The Cyclones were just 1-for-14 with RISP and left 13 runners on base.

NOT SO BULLISH: Over the last five games, the Cyclones bullpen has allowed 24 earned runs in 27.0 IP for an 8.00 ERA.

ALL IS RIGHT: The Cyclones are hitting .294 (116-394) with a .421 slugging percentage against righthanded pitching, but .217 (23-106) with a .302 slugging against lefthanded pitchers.

WHO'S HOT?: Brooklyn 1B **Chase Chambers** is hitting .500 (9-18) over the last five games and .410 (16-39) over the last 10 contests...Chambers has six multi-hit games in 11 starts this season.

GET AHEAD: The Cyclones have scored the first run of the game in 10 of 15 games this season...Brooklyn is 8-2 in those games.

COMING & GOING: C **Carlos Sanchez** was transferred to Columbia (A) of the South Atlantic League...C **Matthew Foley** returns to Brooklyn after being transferred to Kingsport (R) on Monday...1B **Dionis Paulino** and LHP **Seth Davis** were also transferred to Columbia (A) and St. Lucie (A+) respectively...C **Juan Uriarte** was added to the 60-Day Disabled List and is no longer with the club.

CORTES THE 'CLONE: The Mets 3rd-round selection in the 2018 MLB Draft, INF **Carlos Cortes**, has signed and been assigned to the Cyclones...Cortes, who plays the infield righthanded and outfield lefthanded, hit .265 (61-230) with 53 runs scored, nine doubles and 15 home runs for South Carolina this season.

vs. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones are 112-108 against the Staten Island Yankees all-time, including 2-1 during the 2018 season...Brooklyn has more wins against Staten Island than any other team in the NYPL...The Cyclones are 60-51 at MCU Park against the Yankees...Brooklyn has not won the season series over the Baby Bombers since 2014 when they went 8-6.

IT TAKES TWO: The Cyclones are currently tied with the Vermont Lake Monsters for the NYPL lead with 32 doubles so far this season...Brooklyn is also tied for second with seven triples, trailing only Williamsport's eight three-baggers.

POWER OUTAGE: After starting off the season with five home runs in their first seven games, the Cyclones have not hit a home run since the first inning of their game on June 21st at Connecticut...The team has gone 318 at-bats, coming into today, since Chase Chambers two-run shot in the top of the first on 6/21.

LEAVE 'EM HANGING: Brooklyn has left 122 runners on base this season, second-most in the NYPL behind State College who has stranded 130...As a team, Brooklyn is batting .296 (81-274) with runners on base...1B **Chase Chambers** is hitting a whopping .462 (12-26) with runners on base and .471 (8-17) with runners in scoring position.

FOURTH OF JULY: MCU Park and Coney Island will be the center of the "sports" universe on the Fourth of July...ESPN will broadcast the Nathan's Famous Hot Dog Eating Contest on the corner of Surf and Stillwell...Immediately following, MCU Park will host the American Cornhole League's Pro Invitational featuring some of the top Cornhole Players in the world...This will also be broadcast live on ESPN 2...In addition, yesterday MCU Park hosted the Spike Ball Summer Invitational...The event was taped and will be rebroadcasted on ESPN 2 on the 4th of July.

CROWDER COLLEGE: Wilson played his collegiate ball at Crowder College in Missouri, leading his team to a NJCAA World Series in 2017...Posted a 3-1 record and 2.27 ERA that season for the Roughriders.

HIGH SCHOOL DRAFTEE: The Minnesota Twins selected Wilson in the 19th round of the 2015 draft out of Raymore-Peculiar High School in Peculiar, Missouri.

MORE ON RAYMORE: Wilson grew up in Raymore, Missouri, a town of more than 20,000 people...According to the city's 2015 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report, the Raymore-Peculiar School District employees the most people in town (344). Rounding out the top 10 employers in Raymore are Golden Corral (#9, 80 employees) and Minsky's Pizza (#10, 26).

LIKE LEO: Wilson's favorite movie is Shutter Island starring Leonardo DiCaprio, the actor Wilson believes would play him in a movie about his life.

- Over the three-game Vermont series, the Cyclones bullpen posted an 8.81 ERA, striking out 16 and walking 11 in 16.1 IP.
- Thursday night's 6.2 IP of relief marked the most innings for the Cyclones bullpen this season. The previous high was 6.1 IP on June 20 versus Hudson Valley.
- LHP Kevin Smith has fired three scoreless innings over his first two professional appearances, while RHP Mac Lozer struck out a season-high five batters across two innings Thursday at Vermont. Lozer has not allowed a run over 5.1 IP, covering five appearances.
