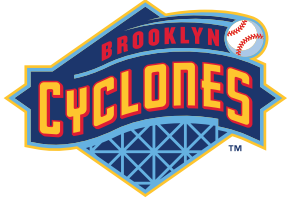

LAST GAME: Brooklyn awoke from their offensive slumber on Thursday night defeating Aberdeen by the score of 6-0...RHP **Jaison Vilera** (2-1) was dominant over his 7.0 shutout frames, allowing just three hits and a walk while striking out nine...3B **Brian Sharp** went 3-for-5 with an RBI and INF **Walter Rasquin** added a 3-for-5 effort with a pair of 2B.

BORN ON THE 1st OF JULY: Since the calendar turned to July, Brooklyn has gone just 3-8 and scored just 27 runs in these 11 games...The Cyclones are hitting just .212 (74-349) over the span... Brooklyn has scored two runs or fewer in eight of 11 games for the month and one run in six of the games.

POWER SURGE: The Cyclones have allowed 13 HR this season, tied for second most in the league, with eight coming in the past 10 games...The past six home runs, and seven of the previous eight, have allowed the opponent to tie or take the lead.

B SHARP: INF **Brian Sharp** has hit safely in seven of his last nine games with an at-bat and has reached base safely in 13 straight contests...The former Missouri Tiger has a .345 on-base percentage for the season despite starting his pro career with a 3-for-17.

WHO'S NOT?: INF **Jose Brizuela** is 5-for-35 (.143) during July with a team leading 10 strikeouts during the span...OF **Wagner Lagrange** is hitting .129 (4-31) during the month of July and has one hit since July 5th.

THE STRUGGLE IS REAL: Brooklyn is hitting .253 (19-75) with RISP during the month of July...Brooklyn went 6-for-16 with RISP on July 2nd in a game they won 7-4 against Staten Island...If you remove that game Brooklyn is batting .220 (13-59) with RISP during the month.

vs. ABERDEEN: The Cyclones are 95-72 all-time against the IronBirds including 50-32 at Ripken Stadium...The Cyclones went 2-10 against Aberdeen in 2017...The Cyclones were outscored 75-35... Brooklyn is 1-4 against Aberdeen this year...The 95 wins against Aberdeen rank second behind Staten Island for most wins against any franchise.

CAN'T BEAT THE BIRDS: Since the start of the 2017 season, Brooklyn is 3-14 against Aberdeen and has been outscored 95-48.

TO THE LEFT TO THE LEFT: Brooklyn is batting .236 (42-178) against lefthanded pitching this season...OF **Ross Adolph** is batting .333 (5-15) against southpaws while OF **Jose Medina** is batting .176 (3-17) against LHP.

HIT THE SKIDS: After starting the season 8-2, Brooklyn has gone 5-11 and has been outscored 80-55 in these games...The Cyclones won their first four series of the season but lost their last four.

RASQUIN RECORD: Last season, INF **Walter Rasquin** set a franchise record with 32 stolen bases in a single season...Rasquin joined the team on a rehab assignment on Monday...With his stolen base last night he tied OF **Angel Pagan** for the career stolen base record as well.

JASON VARGAS: LHP **Jason Vargas** will continue his MLB Rehab Assignment with the Cyclones on Saturday when they take on the Williamsport Crosscutters...Vargas pitched for Brooklyn on Monday vs. Staten Island and tossed 6.0 shutout frames, allowing just one hit and striking out nine.

LAST TIME OUT: Allowed a career-high nine hits over four innings in a no-decision at Staten Island...Struck out two and walked one, yielding a pair of runs in Brooklyn's 3-2 loss.

LEFT/RIGHT: With Brooklyn, has held left-handed batters to just a .194 average (7-36), but RHB are hitting .386 (22-57) off of him.

BEFORE BROOKLYN: Made two starts this season at higher levels before joining the Cyclones...Pitched with St. Lucie (A+) of the Florida State League on June 2nd vs. Fort Myers...Tossed 5.0 innings, allowed one run on one hit while striking out five....Took a no-decision in a game that Fort Myers won 3-1...Also made a spot start with Binghamton (AA) of the Eastern League on May 27th vs. Bowie...Was tagged with the loss, but allowed just one run on three hits over 4.0 innings with one walk and four strikeouts.

BASEBALL AMERICA: The publication named James New York's 30th-best prospect in their 2018 handbook.

LAST SEASON: Went 2-3 with a 4.18 ERA in 11 games, all starts, with the Kingsport Mets (R) of the Appy League...Allowed one earned run or less in six of 11 starts...Began the season with a 0.74 ERA through his first five starts, allowing just four runs, two earned, over 24.1 innings on the mound.

K TURN: Struck out 58 batters in 51.0 innings with the K-Mets last season...Including three games in which he struck out nine batters, which established and tied his career high.

SCHOOL DAYS: Was selected in the 14th round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of East Lake HS...Went 9-2 with a 1.29 ERA and 98 strikeouts in 71.0 innings during his senior year...Committed to FIU before signing with the Mets.

- RHP Yeudy Colon has a team-low 0.84 ERA, having allowed one run over 10.2 IP. Colon is in the midst of a 7.2 scoreless-innings streak.
