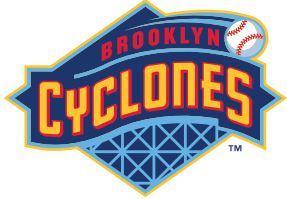

## BROOKLYN CYCLONES (14-13) vs. WILLIAMSPORT CROSSCUTTERS (11-15)

**LAST GAME:** The Cyclones scored two in the top of the ninth to come back and defeat the Aberdeen IronBirds by the score of 3-2 on Friday night...RHP **Adam Hill** (1-0) got the win in his pro debut after tossing a perfect inning of relief, and RHP **Ryley Gilliam** collected his first pro save...OF **Wagner Lagrange** had an RBI single in the ninth to tie the game, and the winning run scored on an error one batter later.

**BORN ON THE 1st OF JULY:** Since the calendar turned to July, Brooklyn has gone just 4-8 and scored just 30 runs in those 12 games...The Cyclones are hitting just .208 (79-379) over that span...Brooklyn has scored two runs or fewer in eight of 12 games for the month and one run in six of the games.

**WHO'S HOT?:** INF **Chandler Avant** is batting .412 (7-17) over his last five games...Cyclones pitchers have a 2.34 ERA (26 ER / 87 IP) over the last 10 games.

**WHO'S NOT?:** INF **Jose Brizuela** is 5-for-35 (.143) during July with a team-leading 10 strikeouts during that span...OF **Wagner Lagrange** is hitting .147 (5-34) during the month of July and has two hits since July 5th.

**THE STRUGGLE IS REAL:** Brooklyn is hitting .250 (20-80) with RISP during the month of July...Brooklyn went 6-for-16 with RISP on July 2nd in a game they won 7-4 against Staten Island...If you remove that game, Brooklyn is batting .219 (14-64) with RISP during the month.

**TO THE LEFT, TO THE LEFT:** Brooklyn is batting .225 (45-200) against lefthanded pitching this season...OF **Ross Adolph** is batting .333 (5-15) against southpaws, while OF **Jose Medina** is batting .150 (3-20) against LHP.

**vs. WILLIAMSPORT:** The Cyclones are 45-28 all-time against the Crosscutters including 25-14 at MCU Park...The Cyclones did not play Williamsport in 2017...From 2014-2016 Brooklyn went 8-1 against Williamsport...The Crosscutters have not won a game at MCU Park since July 5, 2012 when they defeated Brooklyn 5-4...The Cyclones have won the last seven games played at MCU Park.

**SERIES WIN:** The Cyclones defeated the IronBirds last night for their first series win in the month of July...The Cyclones had dropped their previous four series prior to last night's win.

**HIT THE SKIDS:** After starting the season 8-2, Brooklyn has gone 6-11 and has been outscored 82-58 in those games.

**RASQUIN RECORD:** Last season, INF **Walter Rasquin** set a franchise record with 32 stolen bases in a single season...Rasquin joined the team on a rehab assignment on Monday...With his stolen base on Thursday at Aberdeen, he tied OF **Angel Pagan** for the career stolen base record (33) as well.

**JASON VARGAS:** LHP **Jason Vargas** will continue his MLB Rehab Assignment with the Cyclones tonight...Vargas pitched for Brooklyn on Monday vs. Staten Island and tossed 6.0 shutout frames, allowing just one hit and striking out nine...Vargas is the 26th major leaguer to rehab with the Cyclones in franchise history.

**ROSTER MOVES:** C **Matt Foley** was granted his release...C **Hayden Senger** was transferred from the K-Mets after batting .400 (14-35) in 10 games, including four doubles, one home run and six RBI...Defensively, Senger threw out 4-of-7 would-be base stealers for a .571 percentage.

# 40 JASON VARGAS LHP

**Height:** 6-0 **Weight:** 210  
**Date of Birth:** February 2, 1983  
**Hometown:** Apple Valley, CA  
**How Obtained:** Signed as a free agent on February 18, 2018 to a two-year contract with a team option for a third year.

**REHAB ROAD:** New York Mets placed LHP Jason Vargas on the 10-day disabled list retroactive to June 20 with a strained right calf.

**FIRST REHAB START:** Struck out a season-high nine batters Monday at Staten Island, a high at any minor-league level, one off tying his career-high...Allowed a double and did not walk a batter in his first rehab start with Brooklyn.

**LAST TIME OUT IN MLB:** Suffered his sixth loss of the season on June 19 versus Colorado at Coors Field...Pitched 2.1 innings and gave up seven runs, earned, on nine hits including a season-high tying three homers...Did not walk or strike out a single batter...The 2.1 innings accounted for the shortest outing since giving up seven runs over 2.0 innings at Detroit on September 5, 2017 as a member of the Kansas City Royals...Last gave up three home runs in a game in his 2018 season debut at San Diego on April 28.

**ALL-STAR-WORTHY 2017:** At the All-Star Break last season, Vargas led the American League in both wins (12) and ERA (2.62), while ranking among the league leaders in WHIP (1.15, 11th) and walks per nine innings (2.12, eighth)...Won seven consecutive starts from May 27-June 30, 2017...Pitched a complete game shutout on June 2 vs. Cleveland, his 12th career complete game and seventh shutout...Was the first pitcher in the majors to reach 10 wins, doing so in his 14th start on June 18...Posted a sub-2.00 ERA in both April and June...Was 6-0 with a 1.98 ERA (nine earned runs/41.0 innings) in his six June starts with 23 strikeouts and nine walks.

**A CAREER ON THE MOVE:** Vargas was selected by the Florida Marlins in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft...Acquired by the Mets on November 20, 2006 and started two games in 2007...Acquired by Seattle in December 2008 as part of a three-team, 12-player trade...Traded from Seattle to Los Angeles-AL on December 19, 2012 in exchange for Kendrys Morales...Signed a four-year contract by the Kansas City Royals in November 2013.
