**LAST GAME:** The Cyclones rallied for a pair of runs in the 8th inning, with 2B **Carlos Cortes** plating the go-ahead run, as Brooklyn defeated Williamsport 5-3 on Saturday...LHP **Jason Vargas**, making a MLB rehab start, struck out 10 over 6.0 innings, scattering six hits and two runs but it was LHP **Kevin Smith** (3-0) who got the win in relief.

BORN ON THE 1st OF JULY: Since the calendar turned to July, Brooklyn has gone just 5-8 and scored just 35 runs in those 13 games...The Cyclones are hitting just .208 (79-379) over that span...Brooklyn has scored two runs or fewer in eight of 13 games for the month and one run in six of the games.

**WHO'S HOT?:** INF **Chandler Avant** is batting .412 (7-17) over his last five games...Cyclones pitchers have a 2.72 ERA (29 ER / 96.0 IP) over the last 11 games.

WHO'S NOT?: INF Jose Brizuela is 6-for-38 (.158) during July with a team-leading 10 strikeouts during that span...OF Wagner Lagrange is hitting .147 (5-34) during the month of July and has two hits since July 5th.

**SERIES WIN:** The Cyclones took two of three from the IronBirds in their last series for their first series win since the month of June...With a win today or tomorrow the Cyclones would win back-to-back series after losing their previous four sets.

**HIT THE SKIDS:** After starting the season 8-2, Brooklyn has gone 7-11 and has been outscored 85-63 in those games.

RASQUIN RECORD: Last night INF Walter Rasquin stole his second base since joining the Cyclones on a rehab assignment...The two swipes moved him past **Angel Pagan** for the most all-time with 34.

vs. WILLIAMSPORT: The Cyclones are 46-28 all-time against the Crosscutters including 26-14 at MCU Park...The Cyclones did not play Williamsport in 2017...From 2014-2016 Brooklyn went 8-1 against Williamsport...The Crosscutters have not won a game at MCU Park since July 5, 2012 when they defeated Brooklyn 5-4...The Cyclones have won the last eight games played at MCU Park.

HOME SWEET HOME: 1B Chase Chambers went 2-for-4 with an RBI last night...It was his first multi-hit game at MCU Park since his pro debut on June 18th vs. Hudson Valley...Chambers is batting .225 (9-40) at home and .396 (19-48) on the road.

**GETTING MIGGY WITH IT:** OF **Jose Medina** is batting .341 (14-41) at MCU Park and is batting .329 (24-73) against righthanded pitching...He is batting .241 (13-54) on the road and .136 (3-22) against lefties.

POWER SURGE: Cyclones pitchers have allowed a league leading 16 home runs, including three in Saturday's game...Brooklyn has allowed 10 of those home runs at MCU Park...There have been three seasons in franchise history where the Cyclones have allowed less than 10 home runs at home for the entire year.

**WAKANDA FORVER:** The Cyclones will be wearing special Black Panther Jerseys today as part of Marvel Super Hero Day...The jerseys will be raffled off in park and auctioned off at CyclonesAuthentics.com starting Monday.

**ROSTER MOVE:** RHP **Trent Johnson** was transferred back to the Cyclones after making one appearance with Columbia (A) of the SAL...The righthander allowed two runs, earned, on three hits with two walks and a strikeout over 2.0 IP in his lone outing on July 12th at Haggerstown.
