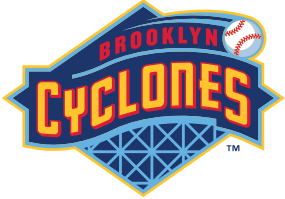

LAST GAME: The Cyclones took the opener of the three-game set in Troy, NY by the score of 5-0 on Tuesday night...RHP **Jaison Vilera** (3-1) tossed 7.0 shutout frames, allowing just two hits and a walk, while striking out nine...OF **Wagner Lagrange** went 4-for-5 with an RBI and OF **Ross Adolph** added a 3-for-5 effort with a double and run scored.

WHO'S HOT?: OF **Wagner Lagrange** is batting .500 (9-18) over his last five games...1B **Chase Chambers** is batting .375 (6-16) over his last four contests.

WHO'S NOT?: INF **Jose Brizuela** is 6-for-47 (.128) during July with 15 strikeouts during that span...SS **Manny Rodriguez** is batting .114 (4-35) during the month of July.

ROAD SWEET ROAD: 1B **Chase Chambers** is batting .396 (19-48) in 11 road games and .229 (11-48) in 15 home games...2B **Carlos Cortes** is hitting .357 (5-14) on the road and .087 (2-23) at home.

SERIES WIN: After winning the first two games of their Williamsport set, the Cyclones have won back-to-back series since losing their first four sets in July.

BORN ON THE 1st OF JULY: Since the calendar turned to July, Brooklyn has gone 7-9 and scored just 48 runs in those 16 games...The Cyclones are hitting .229 (118-515) over that span, but Cyclones pitchers have a 2.62 ERA and 1.09 WHIP...Brooklyn has scored two runs or fewer in nine of 16 games for the month and one run in six of the games.

GETTING MIGGY WITH IT: OF **Jose Medina** is batting .341 (15-44) at MCU Park and is batting .313 (25-80) against righthanded pitching...He is batting .224 (13-58) on the road and .136 (3-22) against lefties.

vs. TRI-CITY: The Cyclones are 47-41 all-time against the ValleyCats including 23-23 at Bruno Stadium...Brooklyn has not won a season series against the ValleyCats since 2010 when they went 4-2...The Cyclones are 17-29 against the 'Cats since 2011...Brooklyn is just 3-13 at Bruno Stadium since 2014.

SHUT IT DOWN: Last night was Brooklyn's fifth shutout win of the year, which ranks second behind Hudson Valley (7) for most in the NYPL...The Cyclones and Hudson Valley are also the only two teams in the NYPL that have not been shut out this season.

POWER SURGE: Cyclones pitchers have allowed a league-leading 16 home runs, including three on Saturday...Tri-City leads the NYPL with 21 home runs on the year...Brooklyn has allowed 10 of their home runs at MCU Park...There have been three seasons in franchise history where the Cyclones allowed fewer than 10 home runs at home for the entire year.

THE DEFENSE RESTS: Brooklyn currently leads the NYPL with a .980 fielding percentage...Brooklyn has just 23 errors in 1136 total chances...Tri-City has committed 41 errors this season in 1116 chances.

GET AHEAD: Brooklyn is 14-6 in games when they score the first run of the game.

STAY AHEAD: The Cyclones are 11-1 when leading after seven innings this season.

THIS WEEKEND: Friday night is 90s night featuring Legends of the Hidden Temple. Saturday we celebrate "The Sandlot" with guest Patrick Renna and Sunday the Cyclones become the Brooklyn Bagels.

LAST TIME OUT: Turned in his second quality start of the season, allowing two unearned runs over six innings with one walk and two strikeouts.

LEFT/RIGHT: With Brooklyn, has held left-handed batters to just a .208 average (10-38), but RHB are hitting .333 (22-66) off of him.

BEFORE BROOKLYN: Made two starts this season at higher levels before joining the Cyclones...Pitched with St. Lucie (A+) of the Florida State League on June 2nd vs. Fort Myers...Tossed 5.0 innings, allowed one run on one hit while striking out five....Took a no-decision in a game that Fort Myers won 3-1...Also made a spot start with Binghamton (AA) of the Eastern League on May 27th vs. Bowie...Was tagged with the loss, but allowed just one run on three hits over 4.0 innings with one walk and four strikeouts.

BASEBALL AMERICA: The publication named James New York's 30th-best prospect in their 2018 handbook.

LAST SEASON: Went 2-3 with a 4.18 ERA in 11 games, all starts, with the Kingsport Mets (R) of the Appy League...Allowed one earned run or less in six of 11 starts...Began the season with a 0.74 ERA through his first five starts, allowing just four runs, two earned, over 24.1 innings on the mound.

K TURN: Struck out 58 batters in 51.0 innings with the K-Mets last season...Including three games in which he struck out nine batters, which established and tied his career high.
