



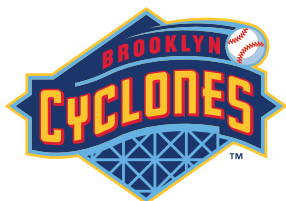

LAST GAME: Brooklyn starter **Christian James** (2-0) surrendered three runs in the first inning but was stingy over the next five frames as Brooklyn defeated Tri-City 11-5 on Wednesday night...OF **Jose Medina** led the offense with a 2-for-4 effort with three runs scored, two home runs and four RBI...OF **Anthony Dirocie** added a 2-for-4 effort with three RBI as well.

WHO'S HOT?: OF **Wagner Lagrange** is batting .500 (11-22) over his last six games...OF **Ross Adolph** is hitting .333 (8-24) over his last six games and OF **Jose Medina** has nine RBI over his last eight games.

WHO'S NOT?: INF **Jose Brizuela** is 6-for-50 (.120) during July with 16 strikeouts during that span...SS **Manny Rodriguez** is batting .150 (6-40) during the month of July and 2B **Carlos Cortes** is just .130 (3-23) since July 8th.

WALK IT OUT: 2B **Carlos Cortes** has at least one walk in each of his last five games with an at-bat...Cortes has seven walks over this five game span and has as many walks (7) as he does hits (7) on the season.

GETTING MIGGY WITH IT: OF **Jose Medina** became the first Cyclone since **Brandon Brosher** on July 11, 2016 at Aberdeen to hit two home runs in a game...Only two Cyclones have ever hit three home runs in a game OF **Caleb Stewart** (7/29/05 at Hudson Valley) and OF **Noel Devarez** (7/01/01 vs. New Jersey).

POWER SURGE: Cyclones pitchers have allowed a league-leading 18 HR, including five in their last five games...Brooklyn has allowed 10 of their home runs at MCU Park...There have been three seasons in franchise history where the team has allowed fewer than 10 HR at home for the entire year.

vs. TRI-CITY: The Cyclones are 48-41 all-time against the ValleyCats including 24-23 at Bruno Stadium...Brooklyn has not won a season series against the ValleyCats since 2010 when they went 4-2...The Cyclones are 18-29 against the 'Cats since 2011...Brooklyn is just 4-13 at Bruno Stadium since 2014.

DO YOU BELIEVE IN MIRACLES?: With Brooklyn taking the first two games of the series, it marks the first time since 2010 that the Cyclones have won a series at Joseph L. Bruno Stadium...The Cyclones had been just 5-19 in Troy since 2010...Prior to that stretch, the Cyclones had never lost a series in Troy from 2002-2010, going 17-4 in those games.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Brooklyn has scored in the first inning of each of their last four wins and has outscored their opponents 49-27 over the first two innings of games this season.

THE DEFENSE RESTS: Brooklyn currently leads the NYPL with a .980 fielding percentage...Brooklyn has just 24 errors in 1174 total changes...Tri-City has committed 42 errors this season in 1154 chances.

GET AHEAD: Brooklyn is 15-6 in games when they score the first run of the game.

STAY AHEAD: The Cyclones are 12-1 when leading after seven innings this season.

THIS WEEKEND: Friday night is 90s night featuring Legends of the Hidden Temple and the first 2,000 fans in attendance will receive a Brooklyn Bling Chain...Saturday we celebrate "The Sandlot" with guest Patrick Renna ("The Great Hambino") and Sunday the Cyclones become the Brooklyn Bagels as we celebrate Baseball & Brunch at the ballpark.
