**LAST GAME:** Brooklyn took a 6th-inning lead but could not hang on to complete the sweep over Tri-City, falling 7-3 at the ValleyCats in the series finale on Thursday night...2B **Carlos Cortes** went 2-for-4 with his first professional home run and 2 RBI...LHP **Kevin Smith** made his second pro start, working two scoreless innings to lower his ERA to 0.64...RHP **Mac Lozer** (0-2) took the loss after allowing four runs in the 7th inning.

**HAVEN'T WE MET?:** Brooklyn hosts Lowell for the second time in 2018...The Cyclones took two of three games from the Spinners on June 24-26, capping a span of four straight series wins to open the season...RHP **Jaison Vilera** threw six scoreless innings for a 1-0 win in the opener, and the Cyclones walked off to win 4-3 in the rubber match.

**WHO'S HOT?:** OF **Wagner Lagrange** is batting .480 (12-25) over his seven-game hitting streak...OF **Jose Medina** is batting 7-17 (.412) with 2 HRs and 7 RBI over his last five games.

**WHO'S NOT?:** INF **Jose Brizuela** is 6-for-50 (.120) during July with 16 strikeouts during that span...SS **Manny Rodriguez** is batting .163 (7-43) with 14 strikeouts during the month of July.

**GETTING MIGGY WITH IT:** In Wednesday's 11-5 win over Tri-City, OF **Jose Medina** became the first Cyclone to hit two home runs in a game since **Brandon Brosher** on July 11, 2016 at Aberdeen...It was Medina's first career multi-homer game...Only two Cyclones have ever hit three home runs in a game: OF **Caleb Stewart** (7/29/05 at Hudson Valley) and OF **Noel Devarez** (7/01/01 vs. New Jersey).

**FIRST THINGS FIRST:** Brooklyn has scored in the first inning of each of their last four wins and has outscored their opponents 50-27 over the first two innings of games this season.

**vs. LOWELL:** The Cyclones are 53-42 all-time against the Spinners, including 30-20 at MCU Park... Brooklyn has not won a season series against the Spinners since 2015 when it went 3-2...From 2006-2015, Brooklyn won the season series over Lowell in 8 of those 10 years...This year, the Cyclones have already taken two of three games from the Spinners in a home set that stretched from June 24-26.

**POWER SURGE:** Cyclones pitchers have allowed a league-leading 19 HR, including six in their last six games...Brooklyn has allowed 10 of their home runs at MCU Park...There have been three seasons in franchise history where the team has allowed fewer than 10 HR at home for the entire year.

**LUCKY LEFTIES:** As a team, Brooklyn is batting .239 (58-243) against southpaw pitchers...The Cyclones have a 4-2 record when the opposing starter is a left-hander.

**THE DEFENSE RESTS:** Brooklyn is currently 2nd in the NYPL with a .977 fielding percentage...Brooklyn has just 28 errors in 1210 total chances...However, the Cyclones committed a season-high four errors last night...Lowell has committed 42 errors this season in 1248 chances.

**GET AHEAD:** Brooklyn is 15-7 in games when they score the first run of the game.

**STAY AHEAD:** The Cyclones are 12-1 when leading after seven innings this season.

**THIS WEEKEND:** Tonight is 90s Night featuring Legends of the Hidden Temple, and the first 2,000 fans in attendance will receive a Brooklyn Bling Chain... Saturday, we celebrate "The Sandlot" with guest Patrick Renna ("The Great Hambino")...On Sunday, the Cyclones will become the Brooklyn Bagels as we celebrate Baseball & Brunch at the ballpark.

**LAST START:** Despite allowing two runs (one earned) over 4.1 innings, Wilson walked a career-high four batters in a no-decision against Williamsport in the Cyclones' 6-2 victory.

**LAST SEASON:** Spent his first professional season with the GCL Mets, going 1-1 with a 1.50 ERA in seven appearances...Made two starts and five relief appearances, striking out 19 batters in 18.0 innings.

**CROWDER COLLEGE:** Wilson played his collegiate ball at Crowder College in Missouri, leading his team to a NJCAA World Series in 2017...Posted a 3-1 record and 2.27 ERA that season for the Roughriders.

**HIGH SCHOOL DRAFTEE:** The Minnesota Twins selected Wilson in the 19th round of the 2015 draft out of Raymore-Peculiar High School before maintaining his college commitment.

**MORE ON RAYMORE:** Wilson grew up in Raymore, Missouri, a town of more than 20,000 people...According to the city's 2015 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report, the Raymore-Peculiar School District employees the most people in town (344). Rounding out the top 10 employers in Raymore are Golden Corral (#9, 80 employees) and Minsky's Pizza (#10, 26).

**LIKE LEO:** Wilson's favorite movie is Shutter Island starring Leonardo DiCaprio, the actor Wilson believes would play him in a movie about his life.
