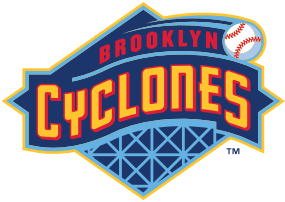

LAST GAME: The Spinners defeated Brooklyn by the score of 3-1 for their 11th straight victory...RHP **Kyle Wilson** (0-3) allowed three earned runs on six hits over 5.0 innings...Offensively, OF **Ross Adolph** went 2-for-5, and 2B **Carlos Cortes** added a 2-for-4 effort to pace the Brooklyn bats.

A CASE OF THE RUNS: The Cyclones have allowed 12 stolen bases in their last two games... The Cyclones rank 13th out of 14 teams in the New York-Penn League with a .226 (12-53) caught stealing percentage...The 41 stolen bases allowed rank second-most in the league behind Vermont (45)...C **Hayden Senger** is 1-for-8 in caught stealing and C **Nick Meyer** is 3-for-23.

WHO'S HOT?: OF **Jose Medina** is batting 7-17 (.412) with 2 HRs and 7 RBI over his last five games...OF **Wagner Lagrange** is hitting .375 (12-32) over his last nine games, and OF **Anthony Dirocie** is batting .348 (8-23) over his last seven games.

WHO'S NOT?: INF **Jose Brizuela** is 7-for-53 (.132) during July with 16 strikeouts during that span...1B **Chase Chambers** is hitting .213 (13-61) in July and comes into today 1-for-15 in his last four games.

POWER SURGE: Cyclones pitchers have allowed a league-leading 20 HR, including seven in their last seven games...Brooklyn has allowed 11 of their home runs at MCU Park...There have been three seasons in franchise history where the team has allowed fewer than 10 HR at home for the entire year.

THE DEFENSE RESTS: Brooklyn is currently tied for the NYPL lead with a .978 fielding percentage... Brooklyn has just 28 errors in 1252 total chances... However, the Cyclones committed a season-high four errors on Thursday...Lowell has committed 42 errors this season in 1286 chances.

vs. LOWELL: The Cyclones are 53-43 all-time against the Spinners, including 30-21 at MCU Park... Brooklyn has not won a season series against the Spinners since 2015 when it went 3-2...From 2006-2015, Brooklyn won the season series over Lowell in 8 of those 10 years...This year, the Cyclones and Spinner have split four games.

THE LONELIEST NUMBER: Brooklyn and Hudson Valley are the only teams in the NYPL to not be shut out this season...There have been nine games in which the Cyclones have scored only one run, including seven during the month of July.

HOME SICK: Brooklyn has scored two runs or less in nine of their last 13 home games dating to June 24th vs. Lowell.

GET AHEAD: Brooklyn is 15-7 in games when they score the first run of the game.

STAY AHEAD: The Cyclones are 12-1 when leading after seven innings this season.

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE: The Cyclones rank fifth in the NYPL with a +15 run differential...Hudson Valley leads the league at +47, Tri-City is second at +27, Staten Island ranks third with +20 and Mahoning Valley ranks fourth at +17...Staten Island is the only team in the league to allow less than 135 runs, having conceded just 99 runs on the year.

WHAT'S IN A NAME: Tomorrow, the Brooklyn Cyclones will become the Brooklyn Bagels as the team continues their yearly tradition of paying homage to some of Brooklyn's most notable culinary delights... In 2016, the team became the Coney Island Franks in honor of Nathan's 100th Anniversary...Last year, the team became the Brooklyn Slices to pay tribute to Brooklyn's pizza history.

LAST TIME OUT: Took a tough-luck loss to Williamsport Monday at MCU Park, allowing a career-high nine hits in his second quality start of the season in Brooklyn's 4-2 defeat in the series finale.

PULL NO PUNCHES: Batters have pulled 59% of the pitches put in play, hitting 21% to the opposite field, and 20% center.

DON'T WALK AWAY FROM ME: For his career, the Dominican has a 6.7% walk rate, having allowed just 47 walks in 168.1 career innings.

DOWN FROM ABOVE: Had made four starts this season prior to the start of the Cyclones season, pitching three times for Class-A Columbia and once with Advanced-A St. Lucie...Suffered the tough-luck loss for the Fireflies on June 11 at Lexington, allowing two runs on five hits with two walks and four strikeouts over four innings...Compiled a 1-1 record and a 3.55 ERA with Columbia...Pitched for Advanced-A St. Lucie on April 22, taking the loss...Allowed one run on two hits over four innings, strikout out four and walking three.

LAST SEASON: Went 2-6 with a 2.89 ERA over 13 games and nine starts covering four levels...Pltched for the GCL Mets, Kingsport, Brooklyn, and St. Lucie...Tossed a season-high 33.0 innings for the GCL Mets, going 2-3 with a 3.27 ERA over seven games and four starts.

HAVEN'T I SEE YOU BEFORE?: Campusano returns to MCU Park to begin the 2018 season, having pitched twice for Brooklyn in 2017... Faced Lowell (August 31) and Staten Island (September 6) at the end of the season...Compiled a 1.64 ERA, yielding two earned runs over 11.0 innings.

STILL COUNTS: Campusano fired a complete-game against Staten Island on September 6, 2017, tossing five innings in a rain-shortened contest...Though the Cyclones lost 2-1, the righthander collected his first-career complete game, striking out seven in the process.
